




Everyone can be guided by the Holy Ghost, but revelation for the Church will always be given through the prophet, just like God spoke with Joseph Smith.




Jesus led the early Church through Joseph Smith.




“Anxiously Engaged in a Good Cause”

“All Flesh Is in Mine Hand”




These early Saints used their agency to join Zion's camp and march from Ohio to Missouri because the Lord asked them to.

“That Which Cometh from Above Is Sacred”




Doctrine and Covenants 63 contains warnings against trying to build our faith on signs, such as miraculous healings, rather than on spiritual confirmation of truth.

“The Lord Requireth the Heart and a Willing Mind”




Like the early Saints, The Lord requires








Baptism for the dead creates “a


Regardless of our current family situation, we can make choices now that will prepare us to receive the blessings of an eternal family in the future.






