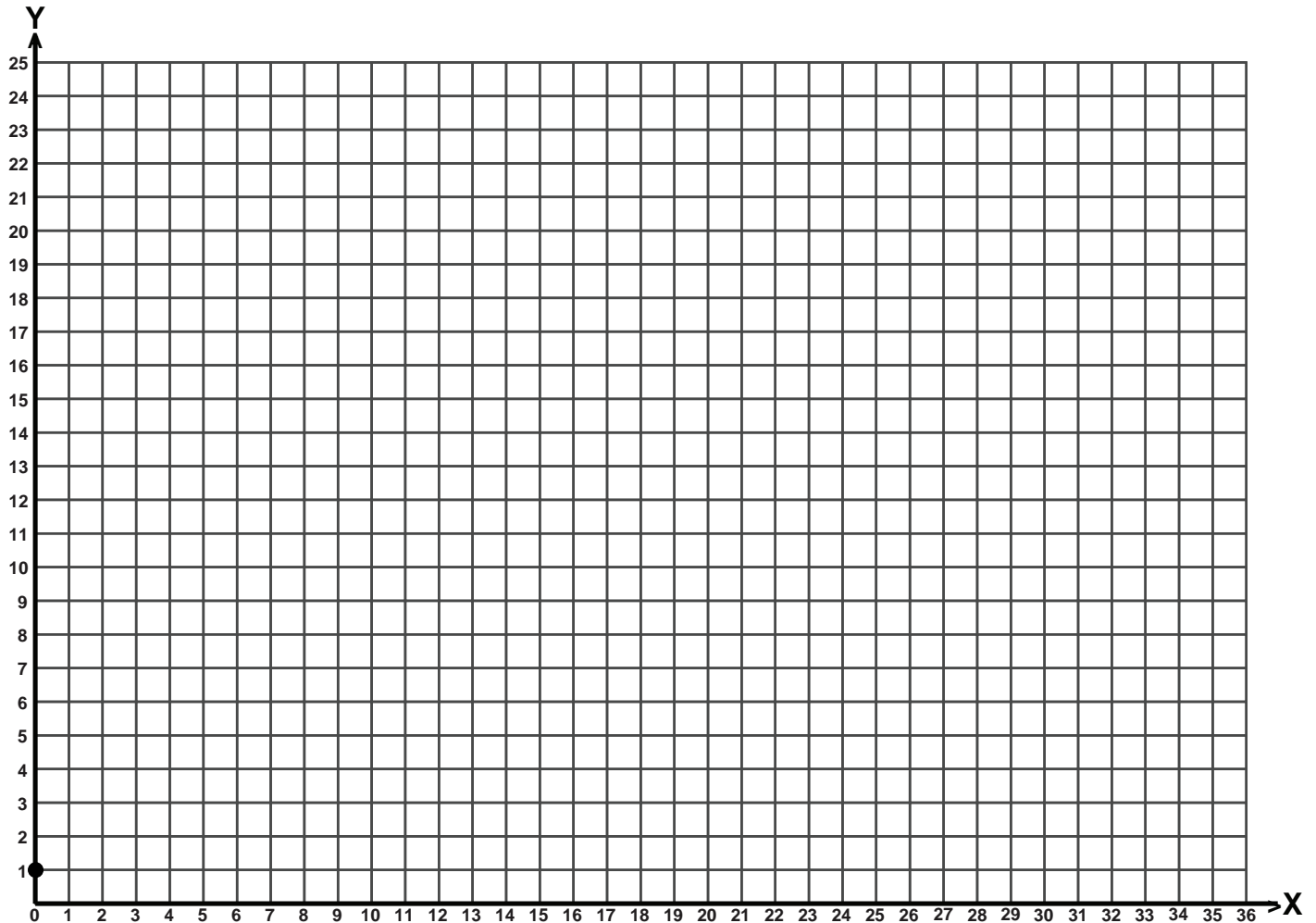
## Doctrine and Covenants 128:18

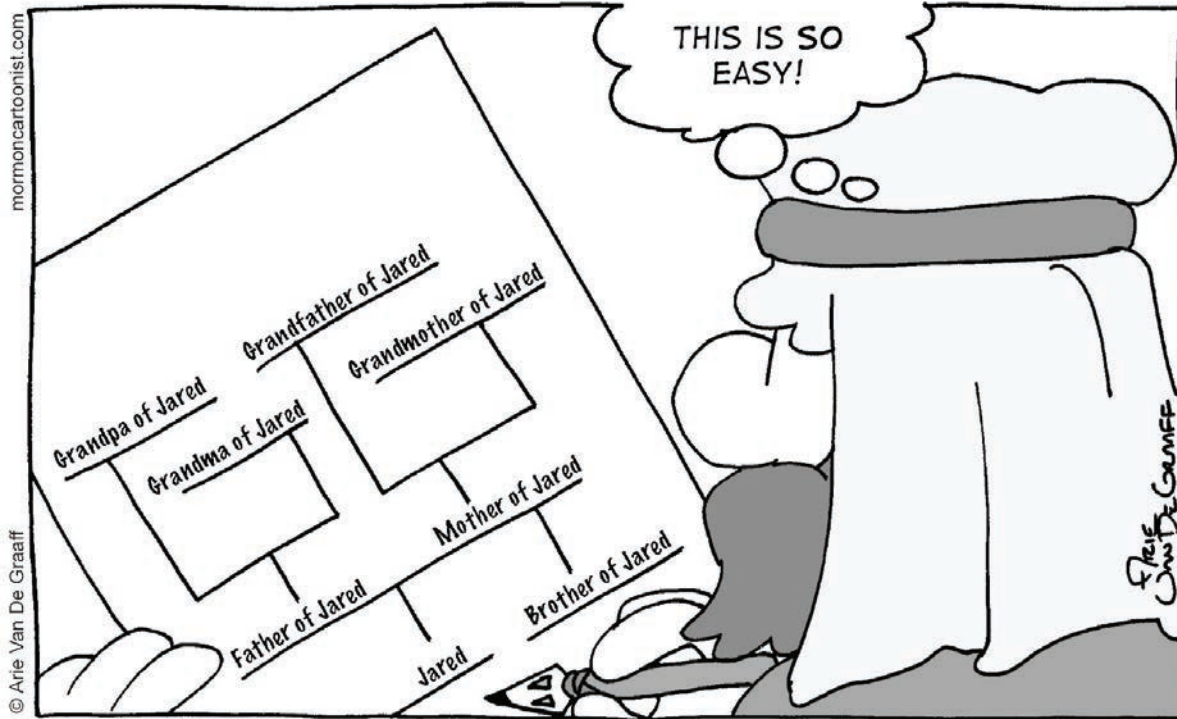
