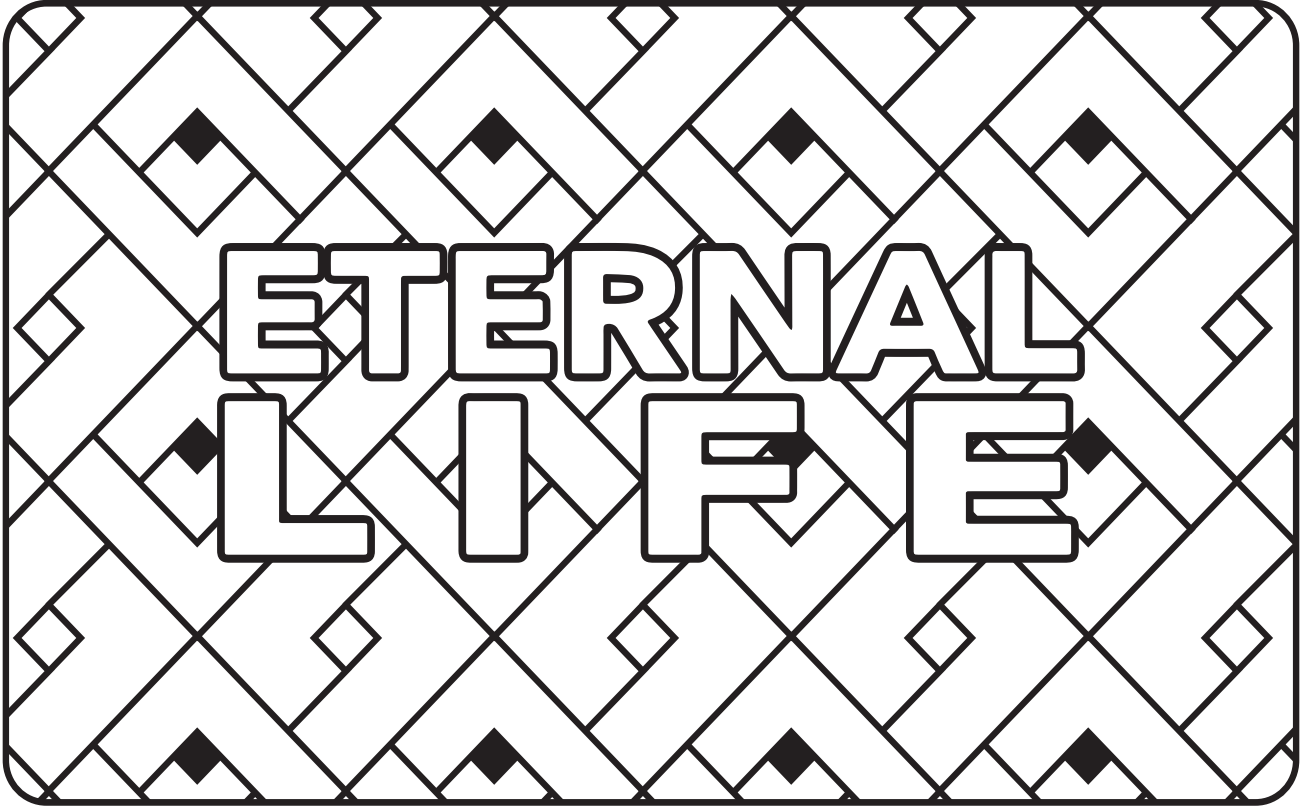

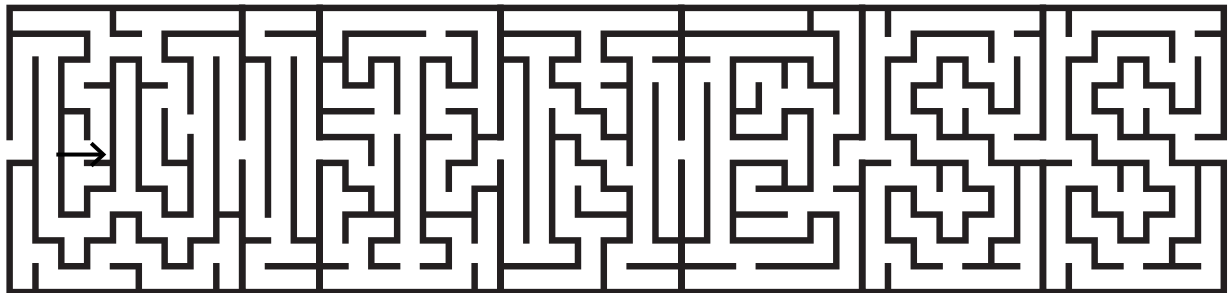

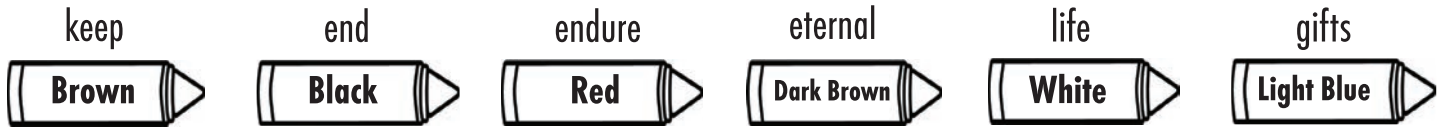


Mystery Picture
