

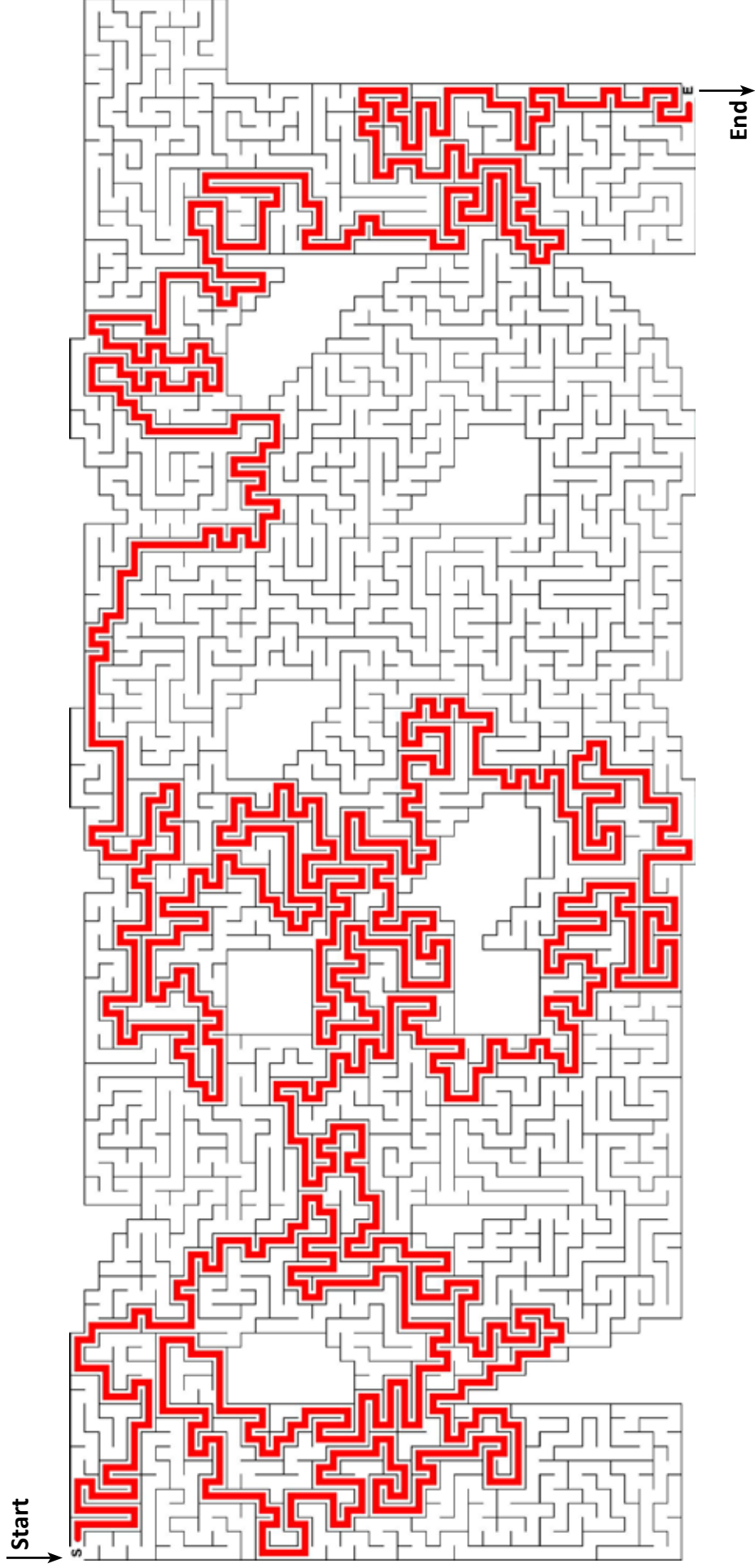

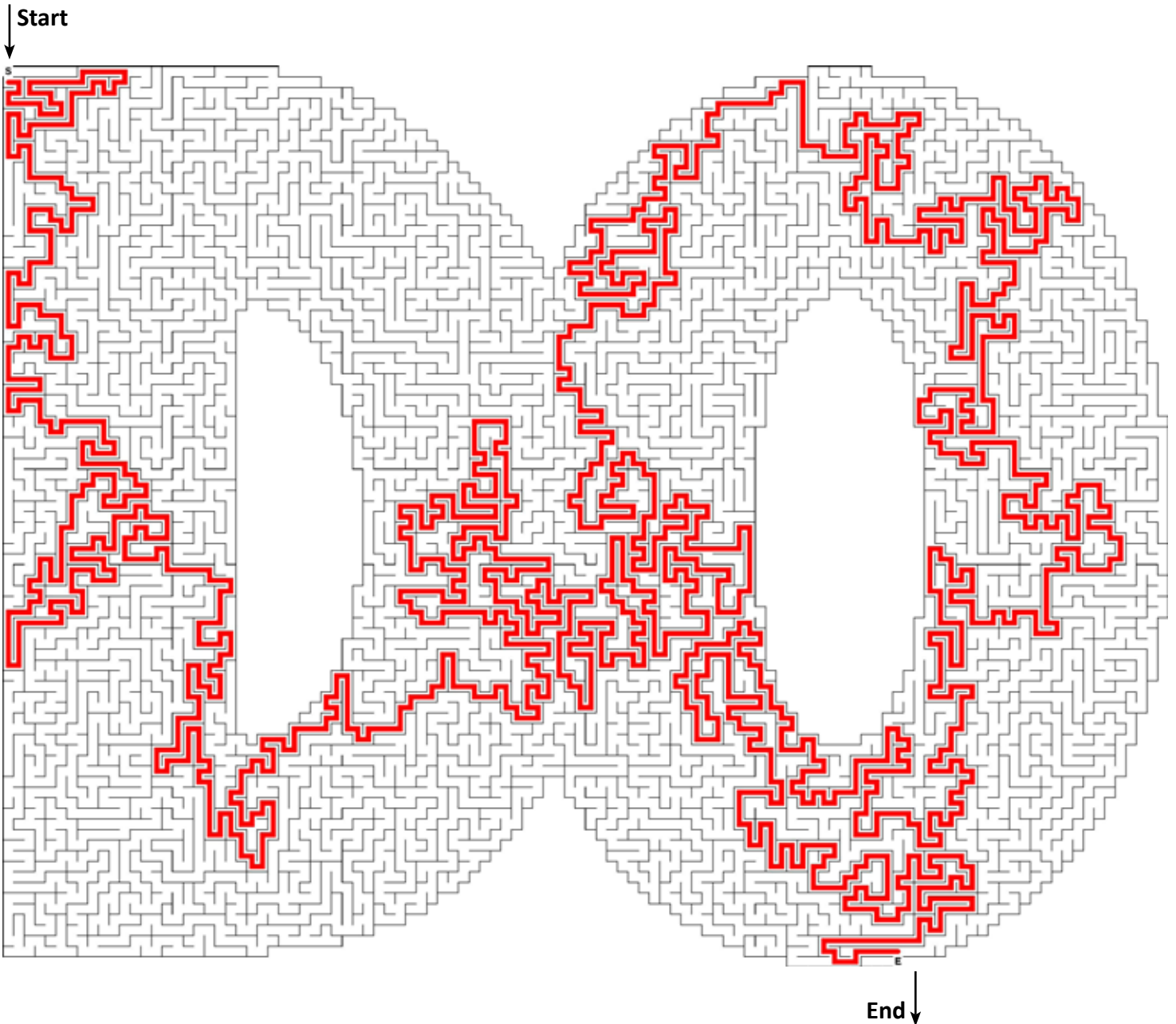

When Abraham’s life was in danger, he called on God and was **rescued**.



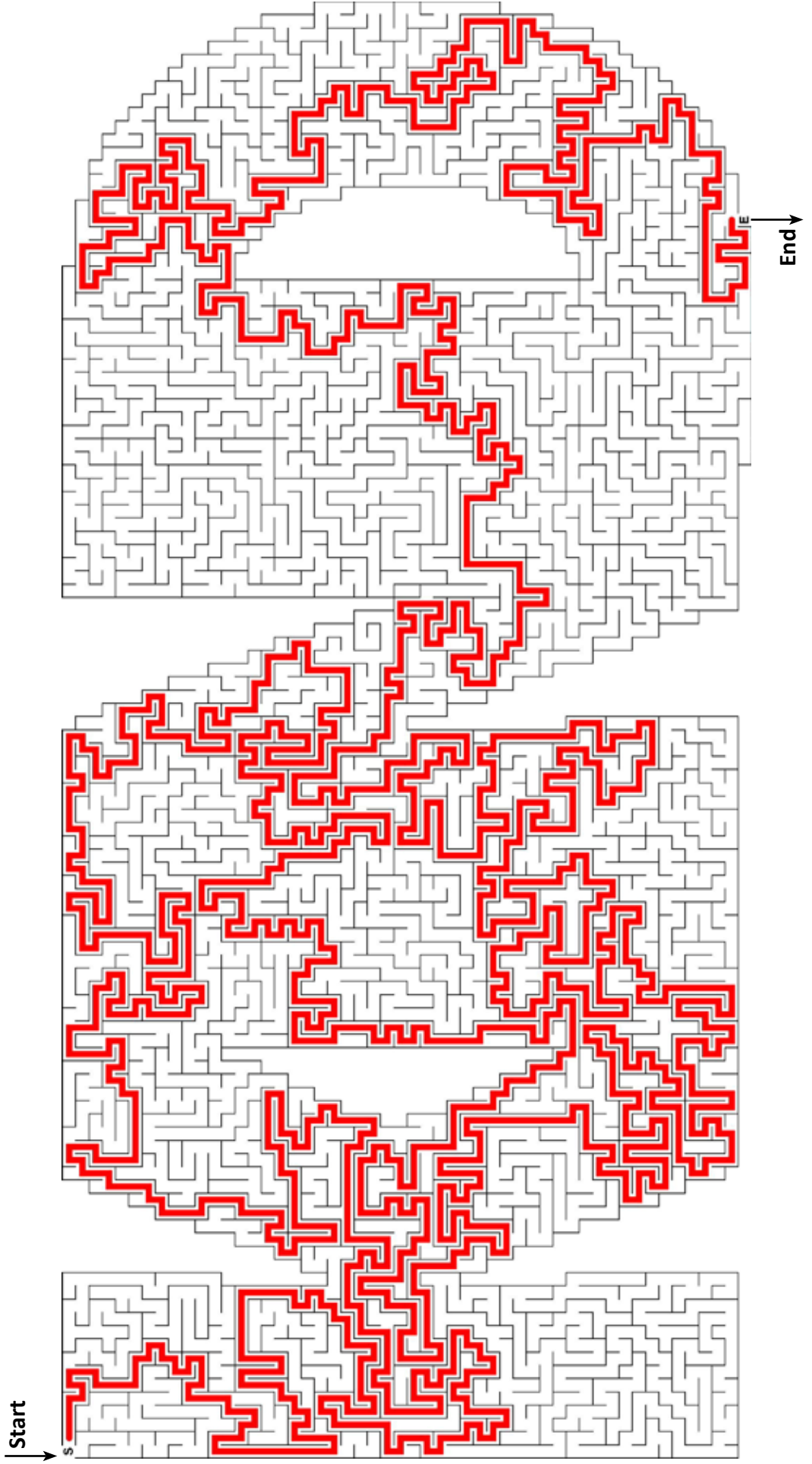

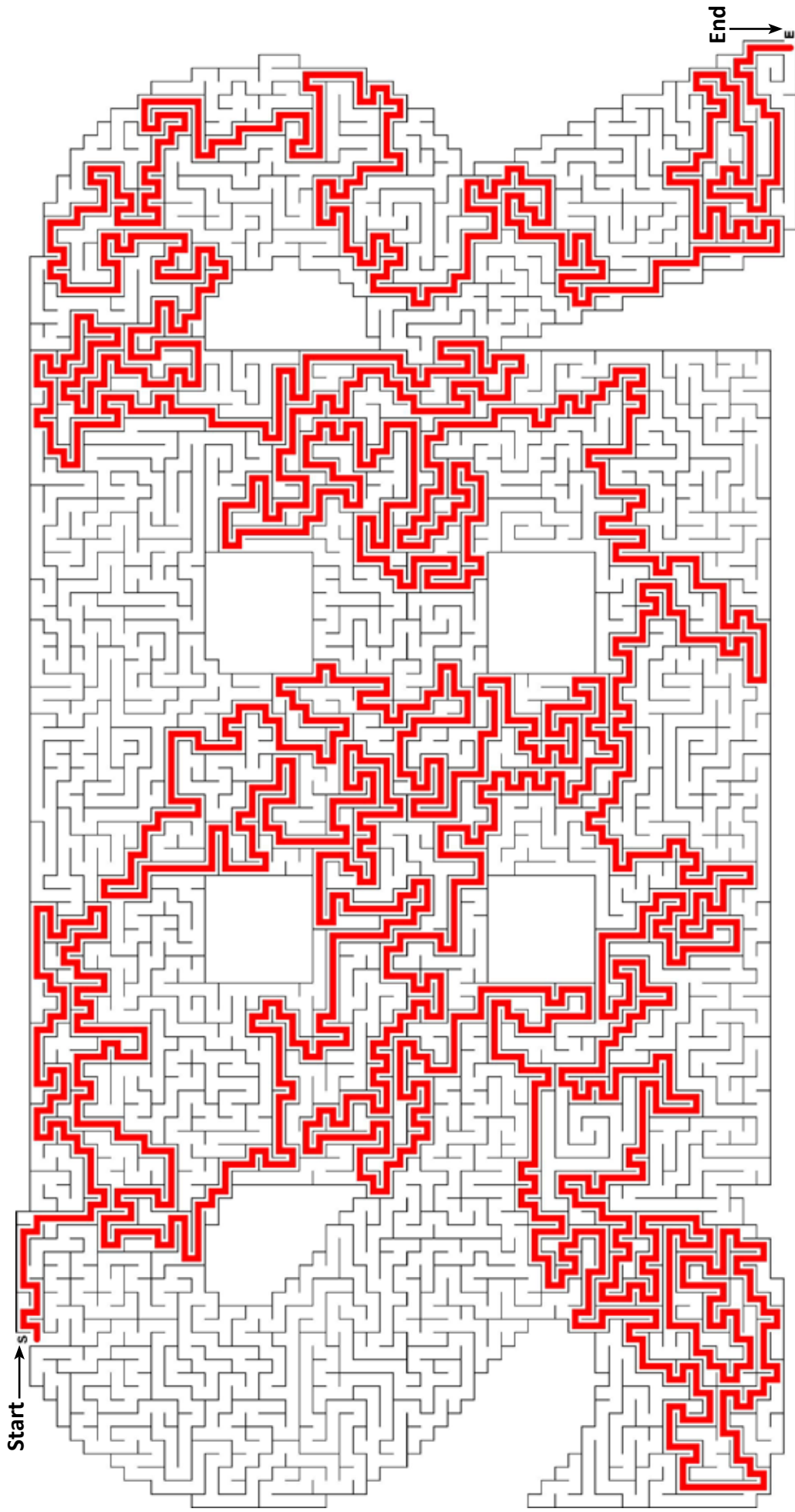

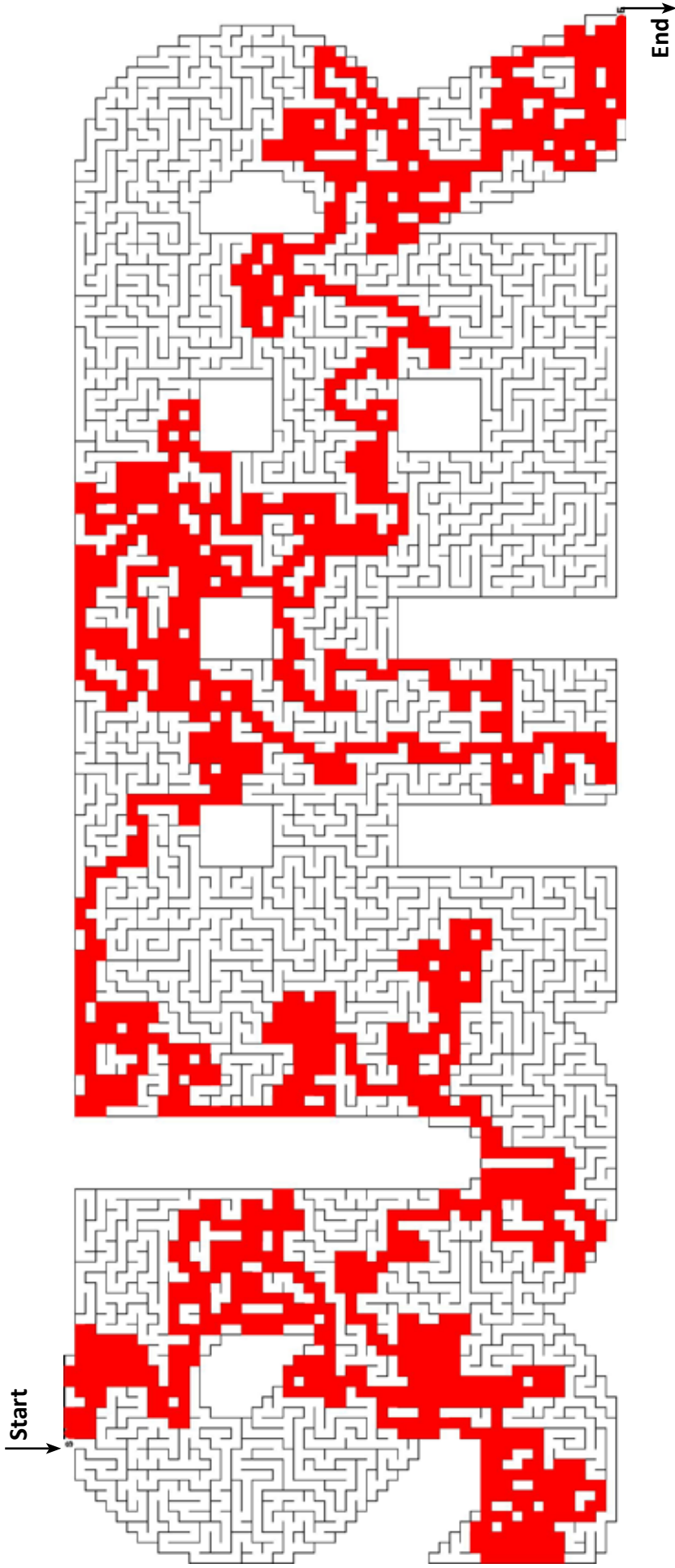

Jesus **suffered** for me because he loves me.



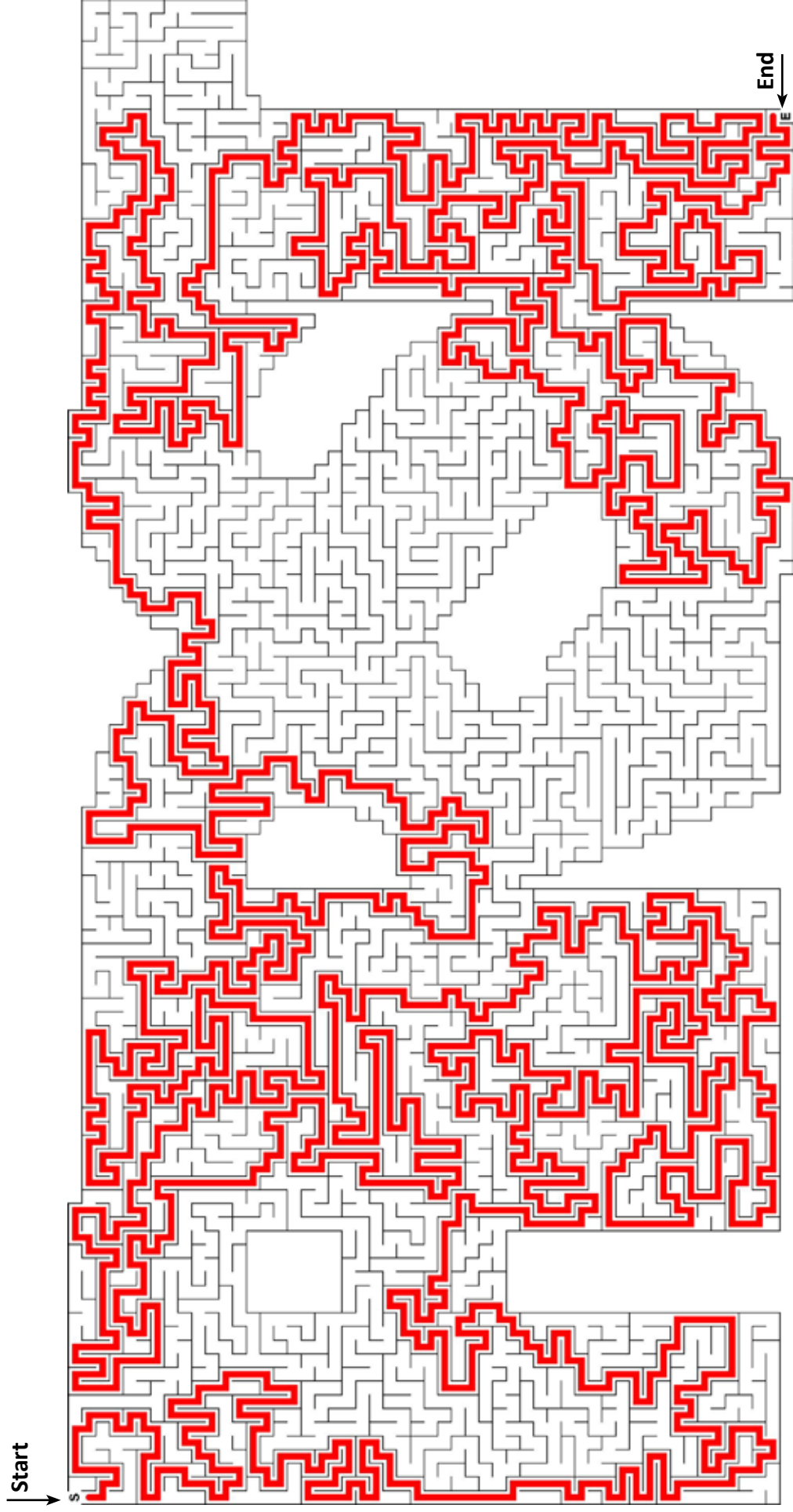

One message from the account in Exodus 32 is the importance of keeping the **first** two of the Ten Commandments—do not worship anyone or anything other than the Lord.



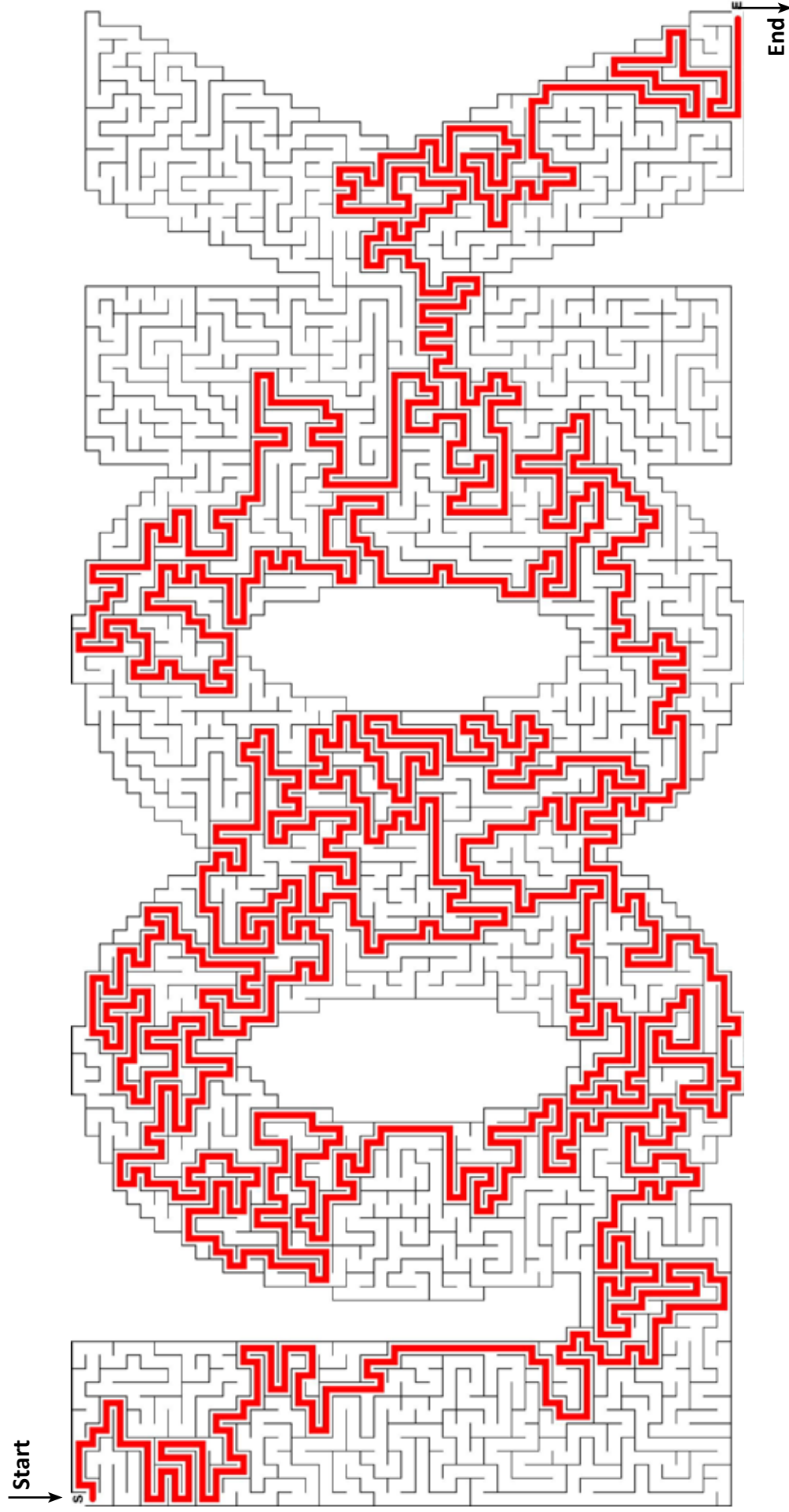

Many Israelites died because they did not have faith that the Lord would heal them if they looked at the brass serpent (see Alma 33:18–20).





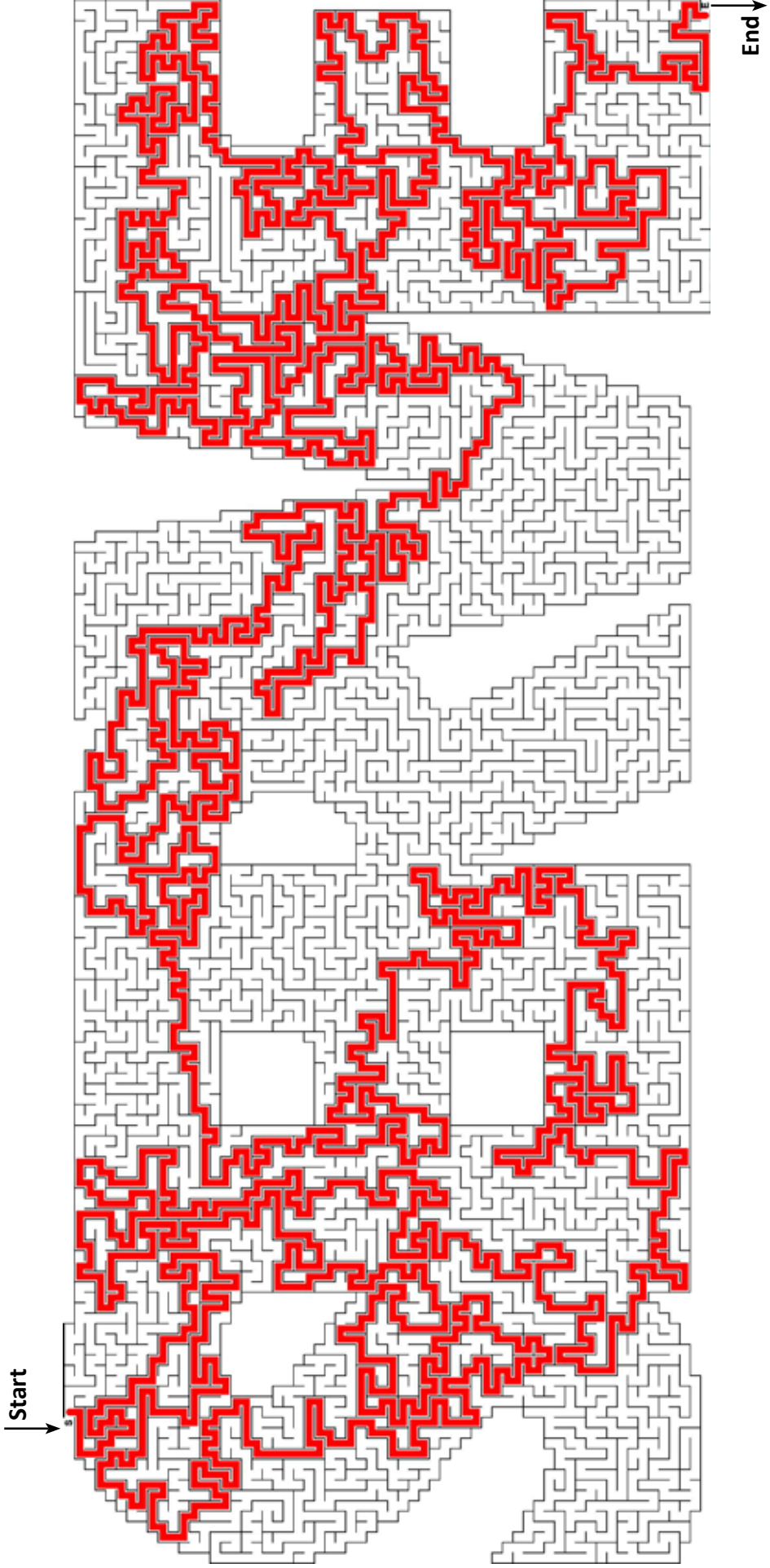

Among Joshua’s final words to the Israelites was a plea to “choose ... this day whom ye will serve.” (Joshua 24:15)



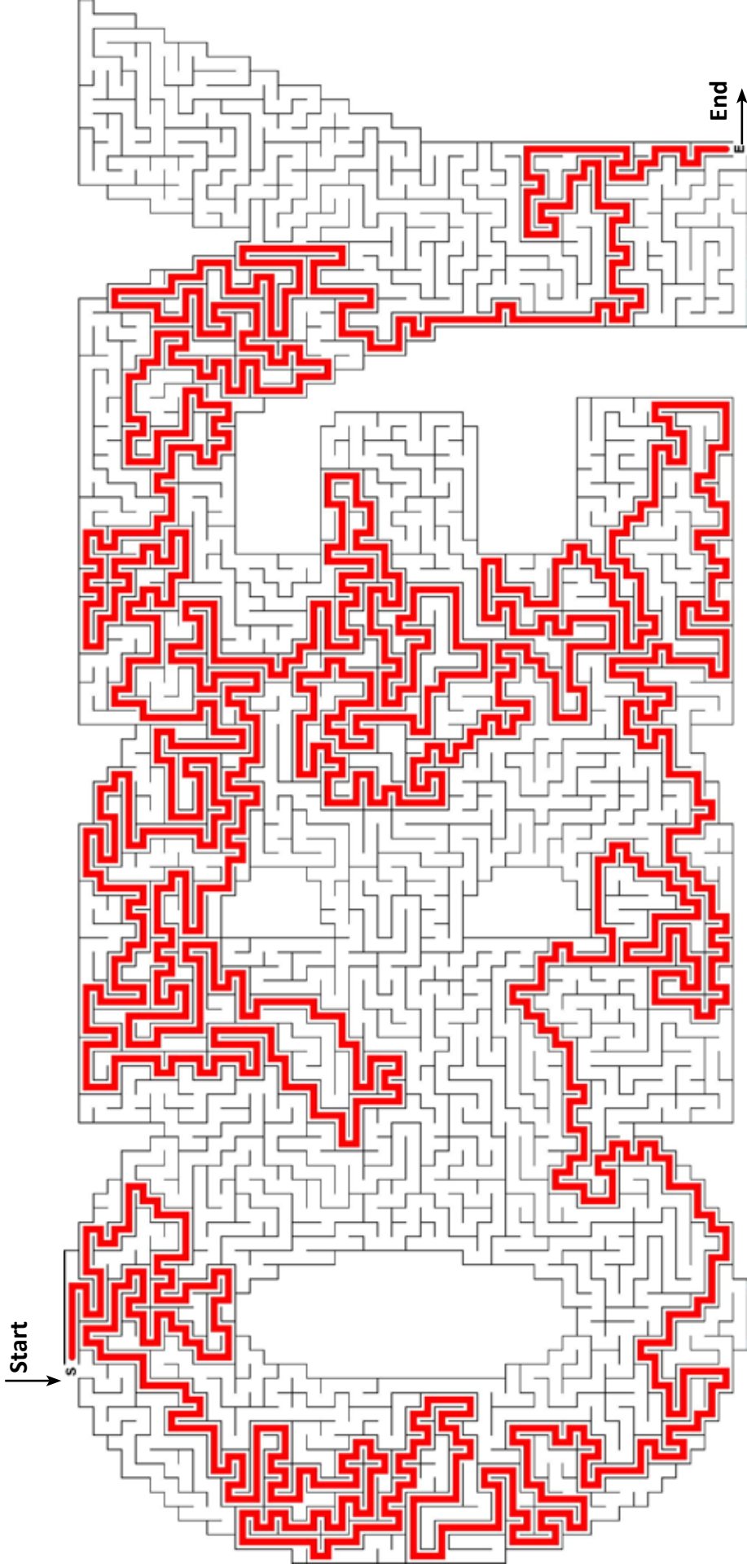

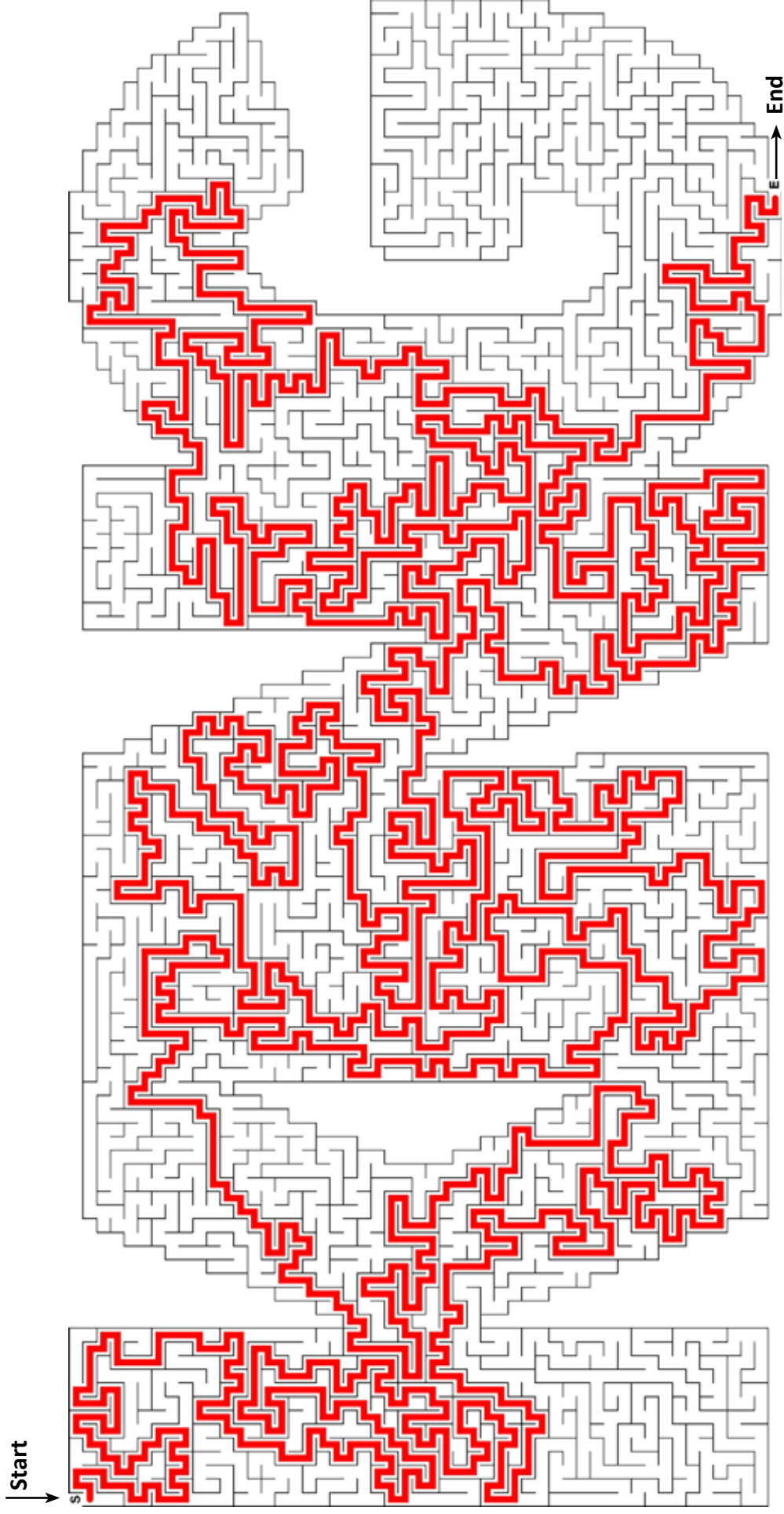

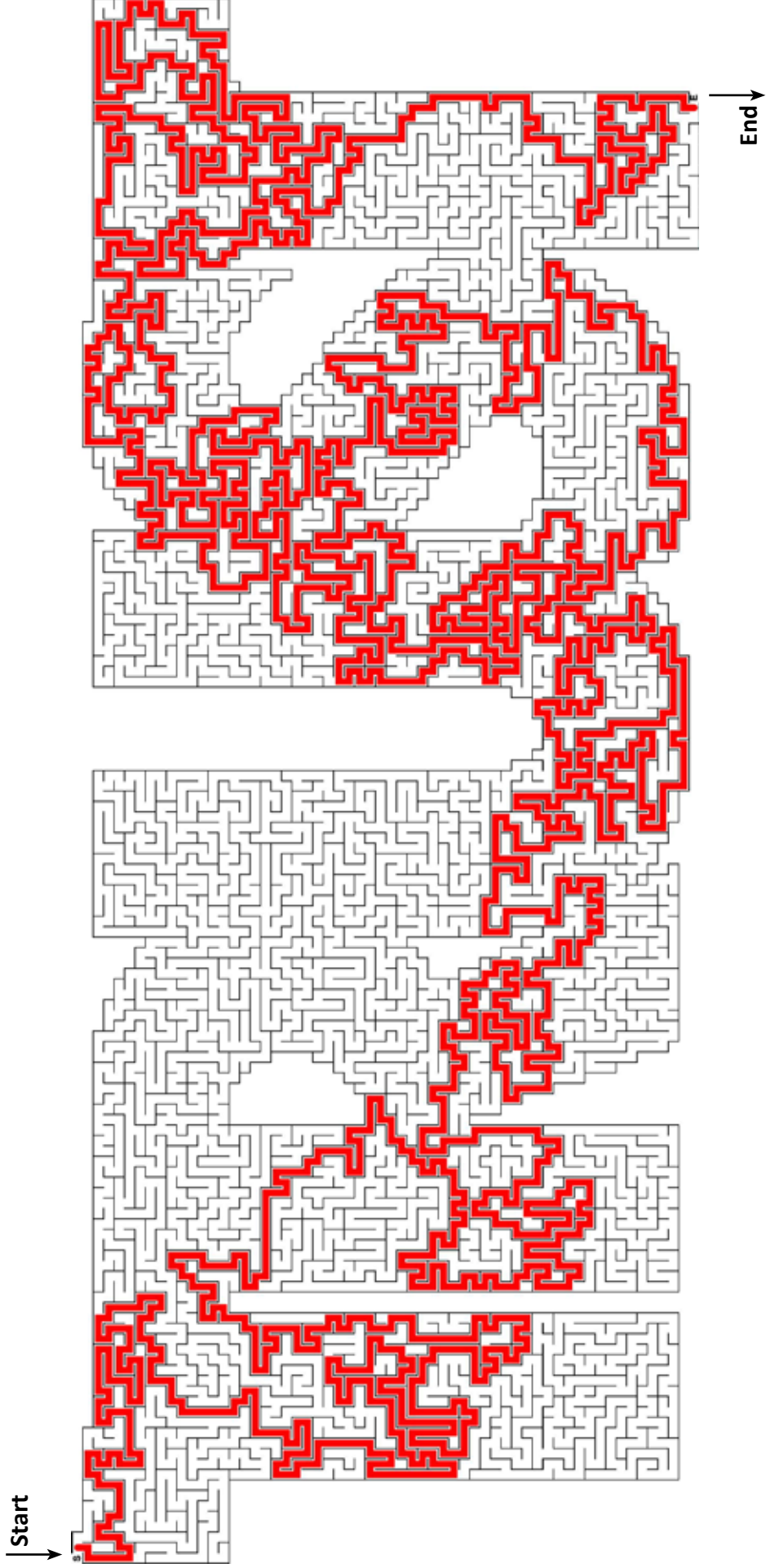

When the Assyrians threatened Jerusalem, the righteous King Hezekiah turned to the Lord in faith and trust.



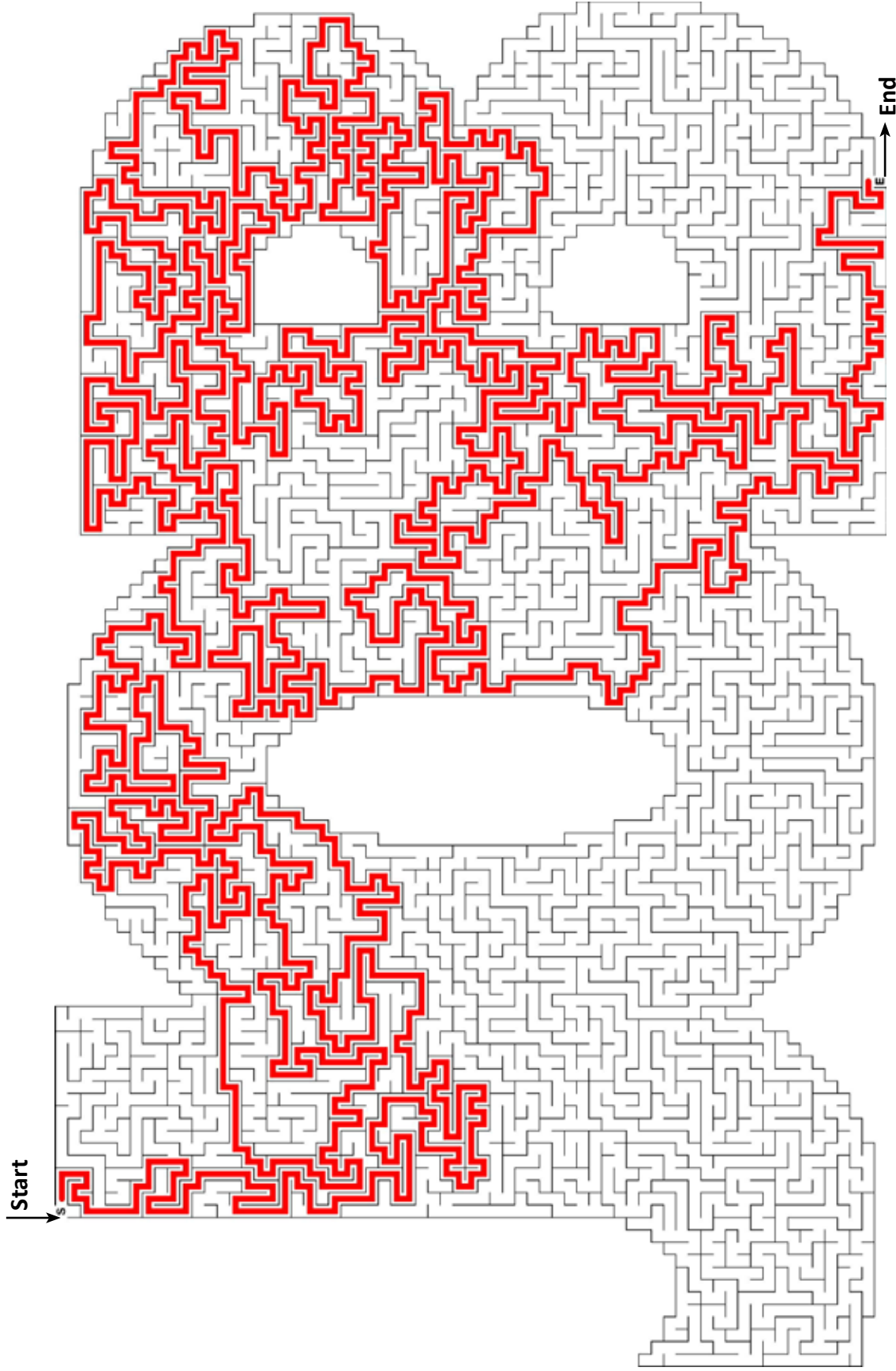

Everyone has difficult days, and some people have trials that last a long time. Job’s faith in God sustained him through his trials.



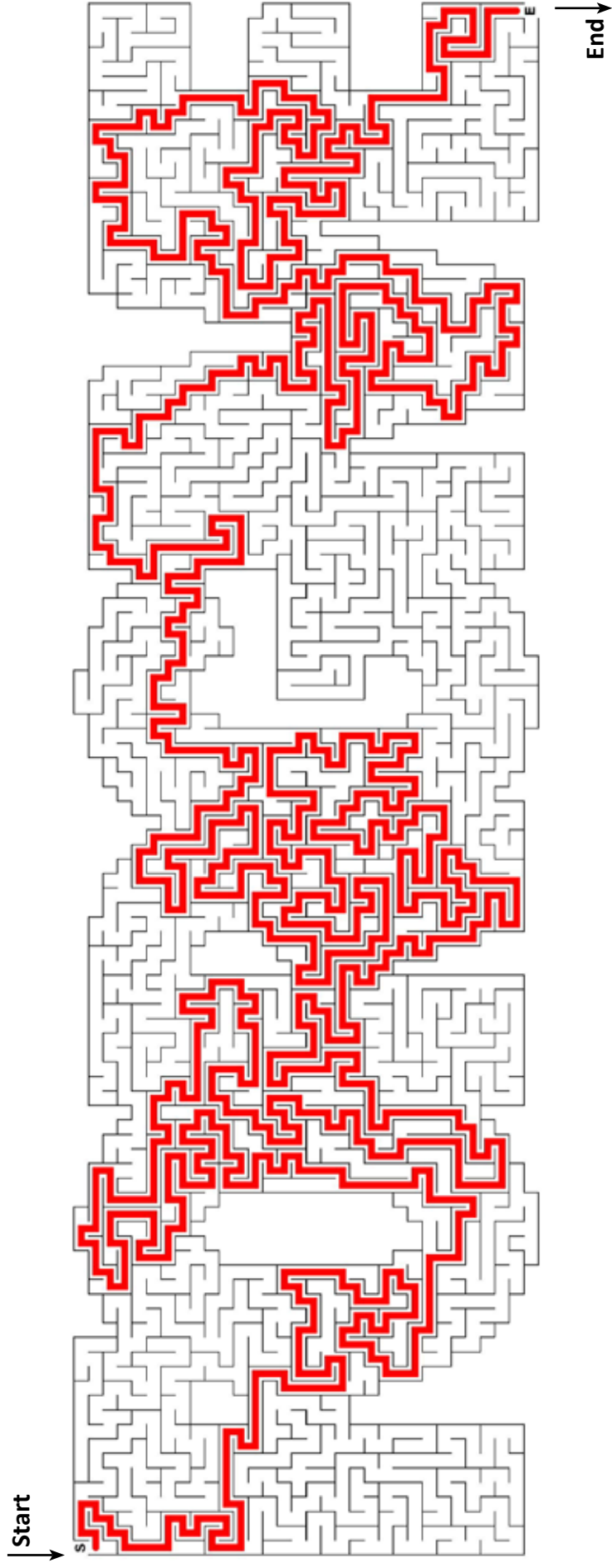

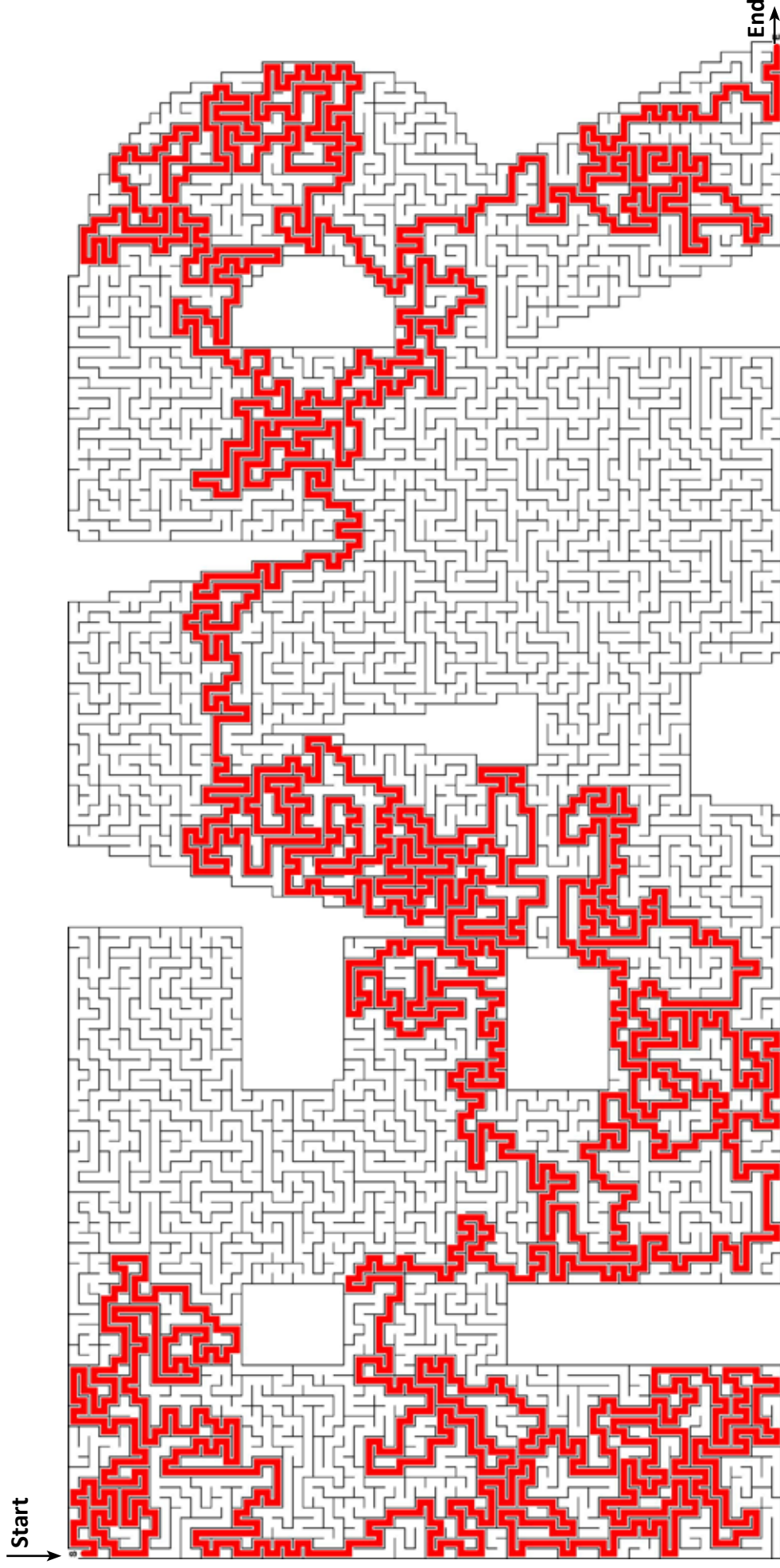

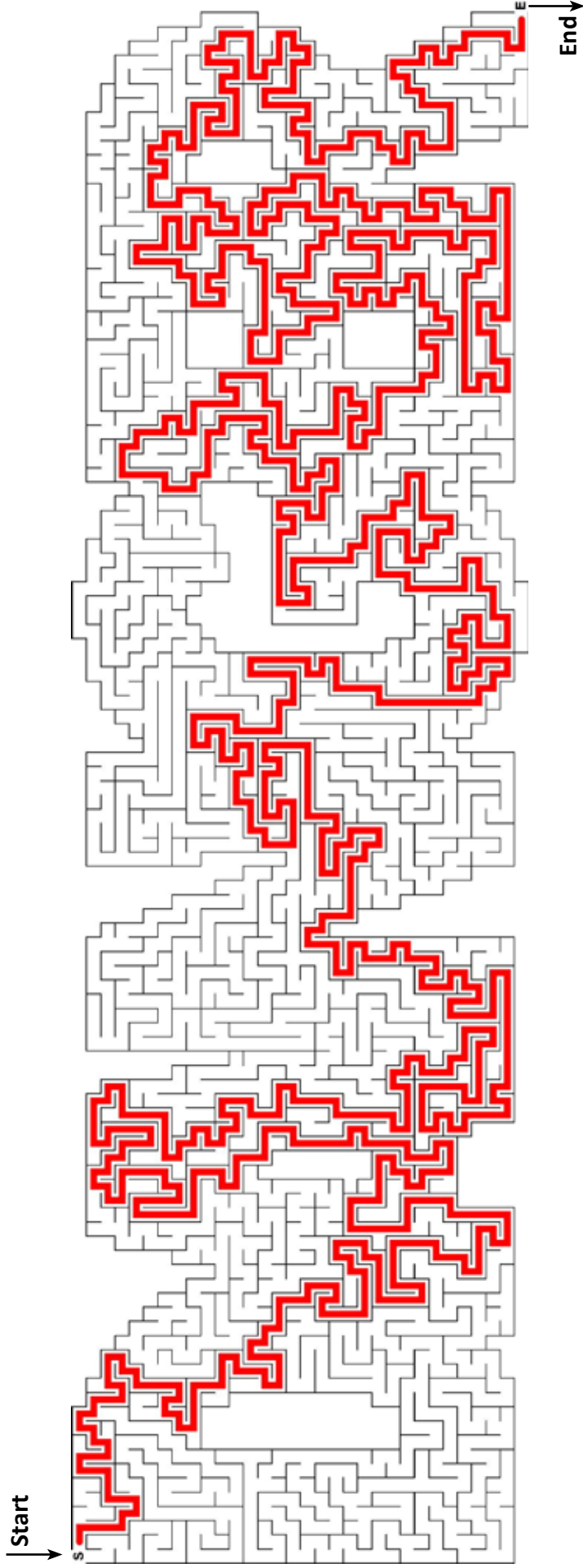

Isaiah’s warnings about the dangers of apostasy can help the me resolve to stay true to the Lord and follow His prophets.





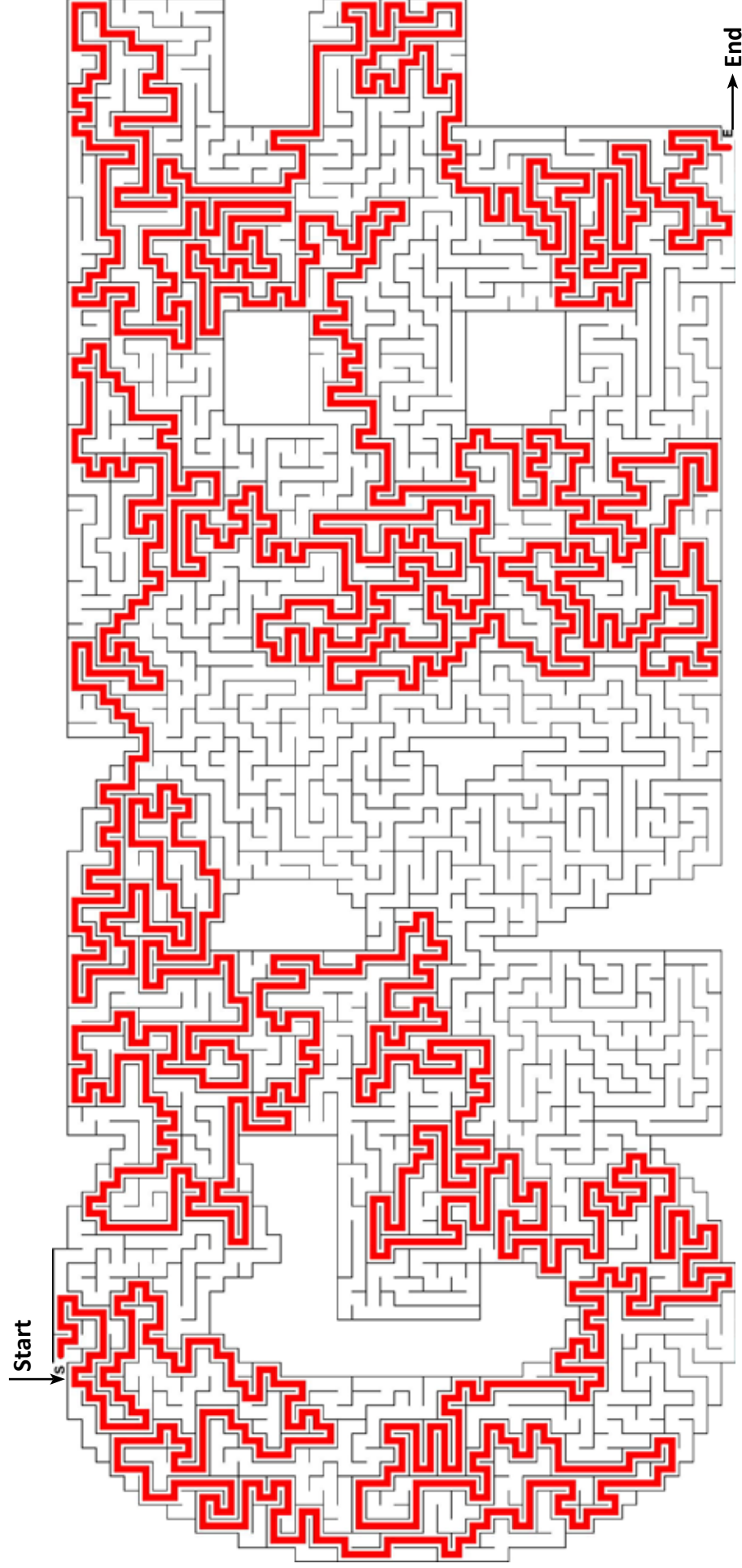

He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with **grief**: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.



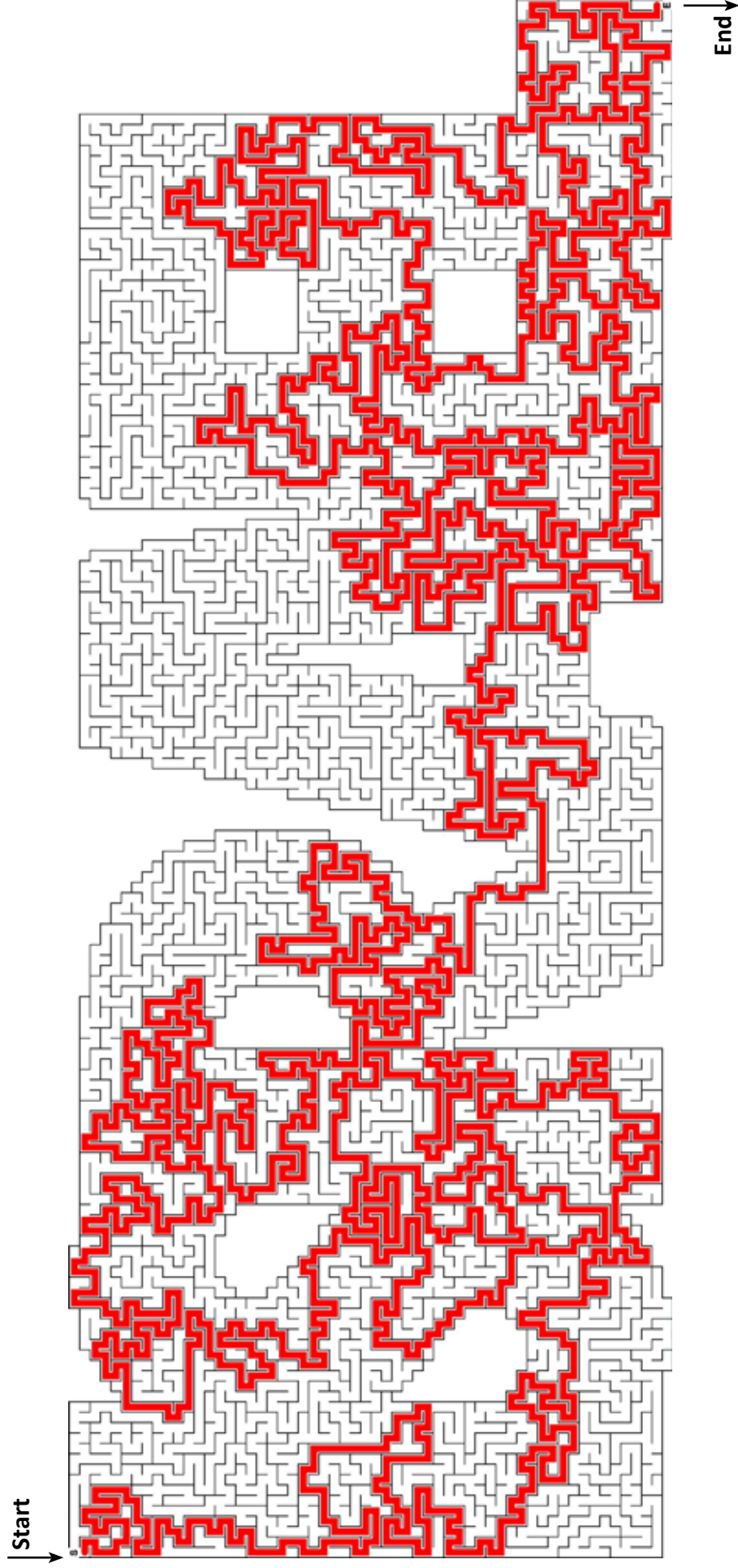

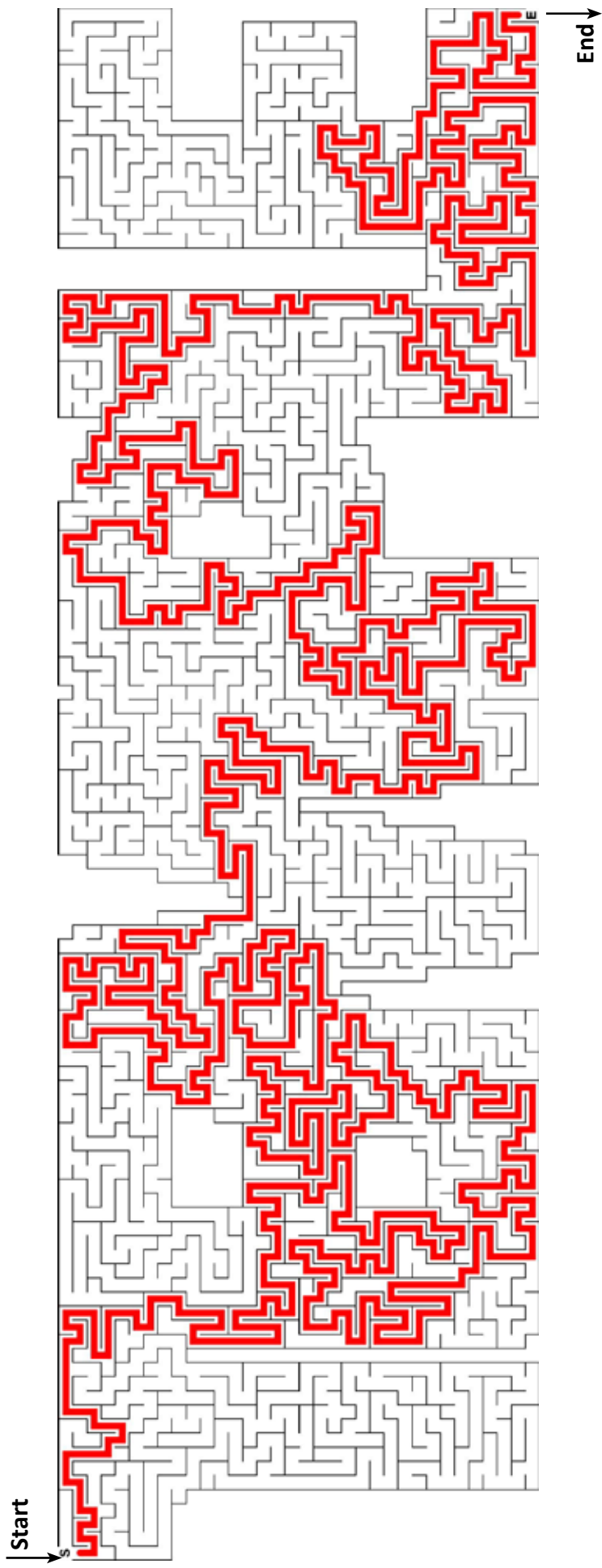

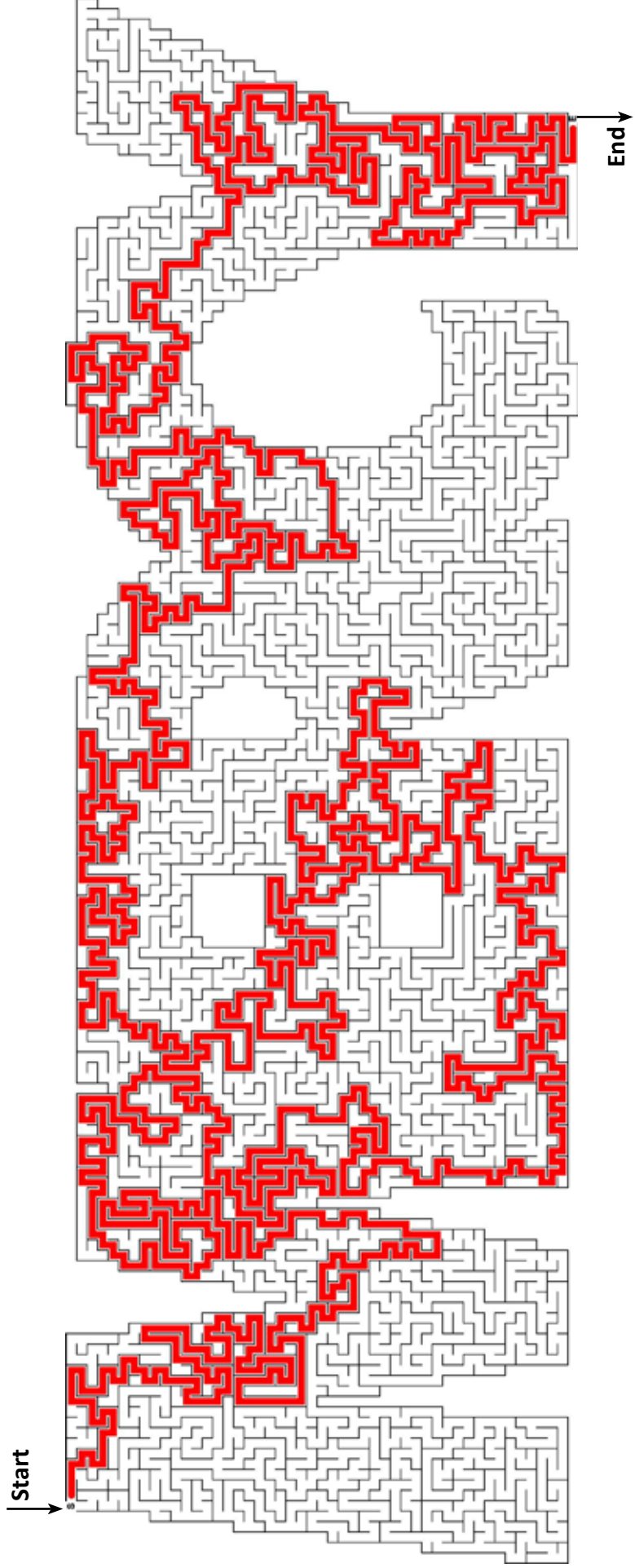
