

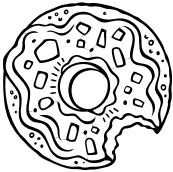

Write down the first letter of each picture in the box beneath it to find the hidden word. Not sure what the picture is? Turn to the last 2 pages of this book for the key to the code.

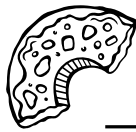
							

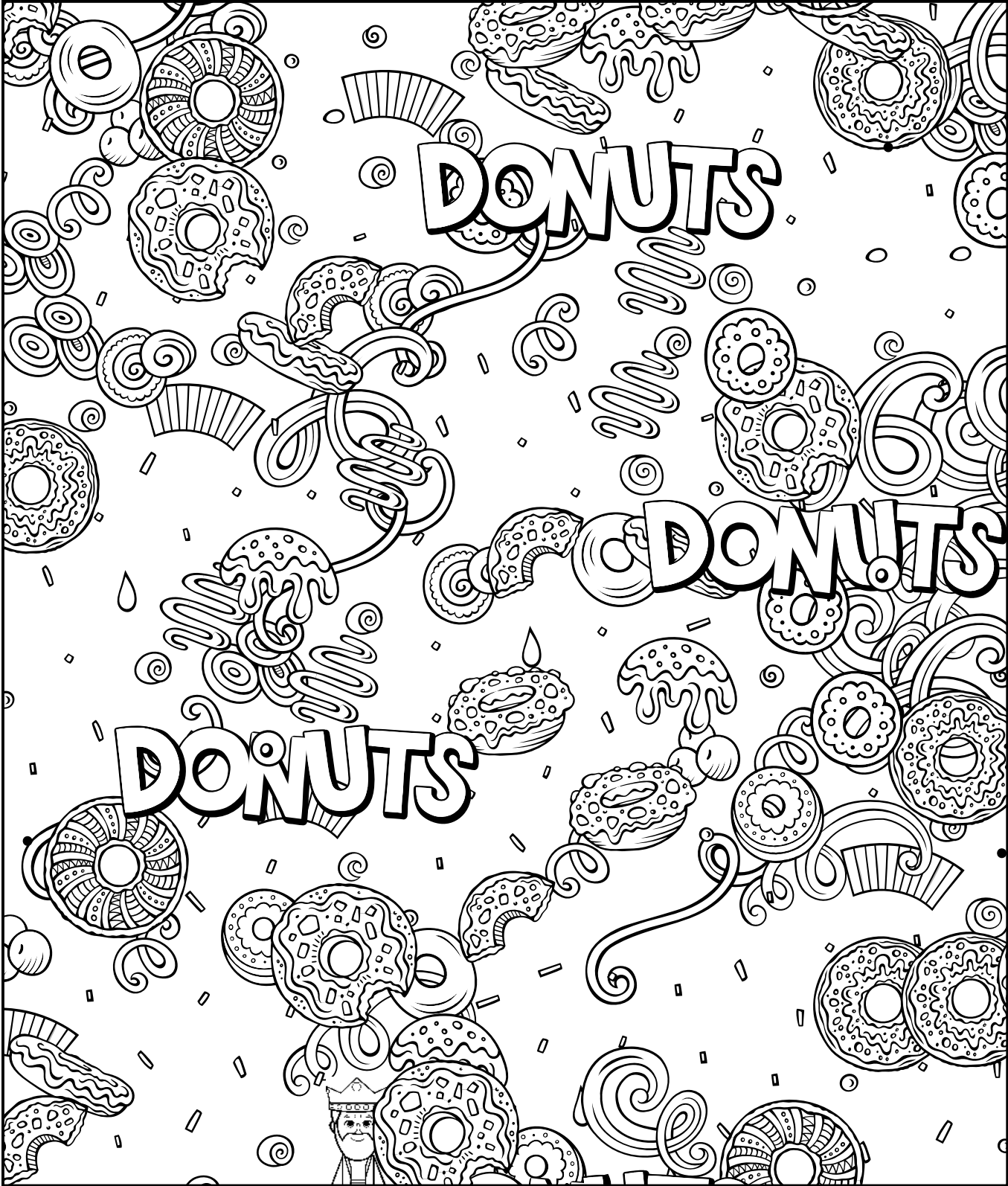
