The earth was created for Heavenly Father's children to enjoy. Look at these four pictures of different areas of the earth. Circle the five similar things in all the pictures.



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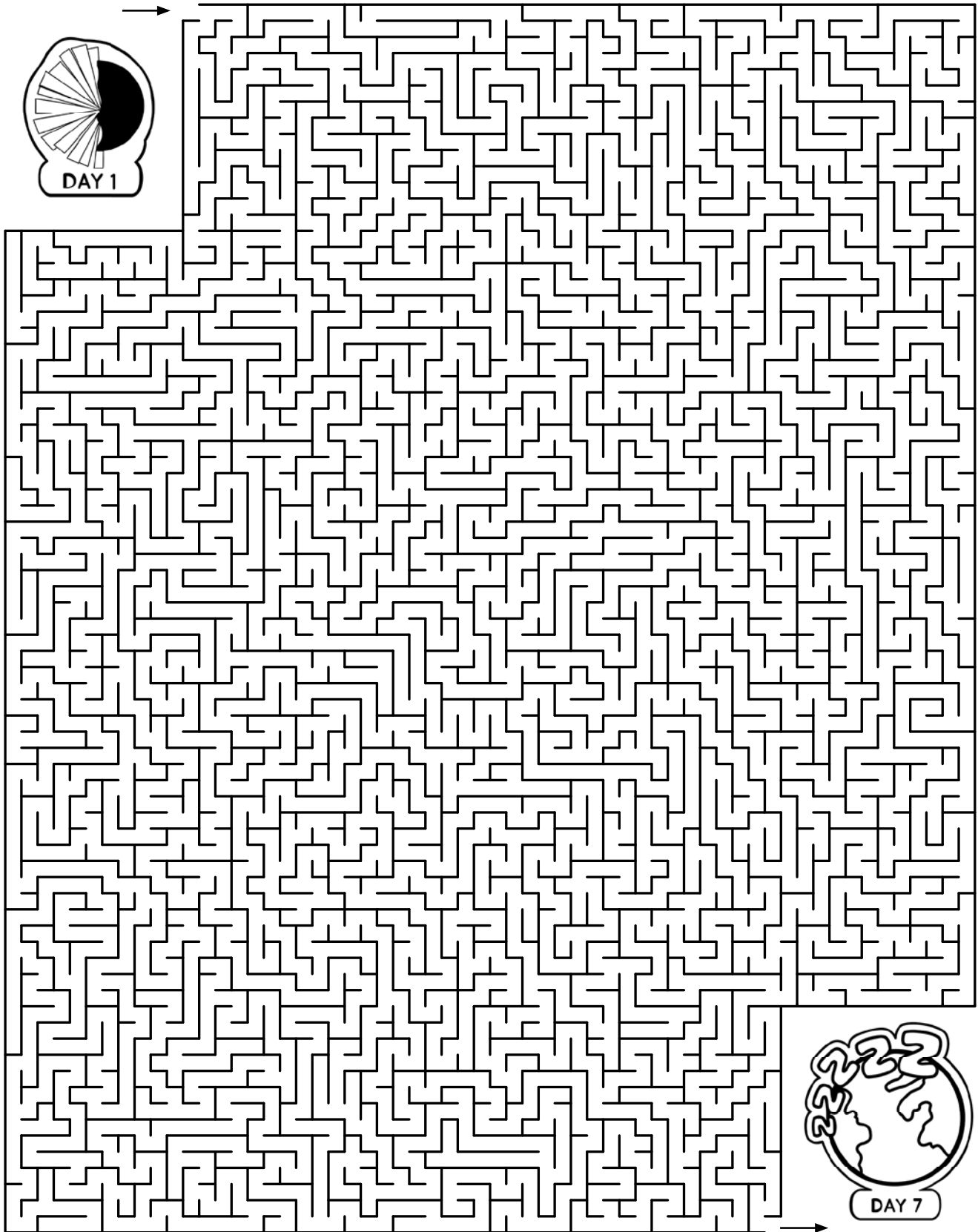

Help the earth go from day 1 of the creation to day 7.



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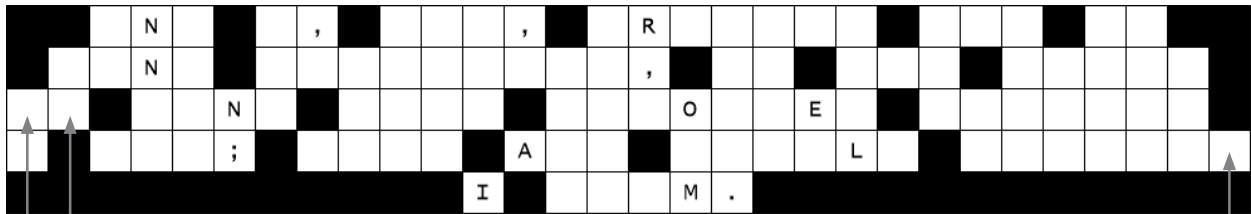
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### Fallen Phrase
