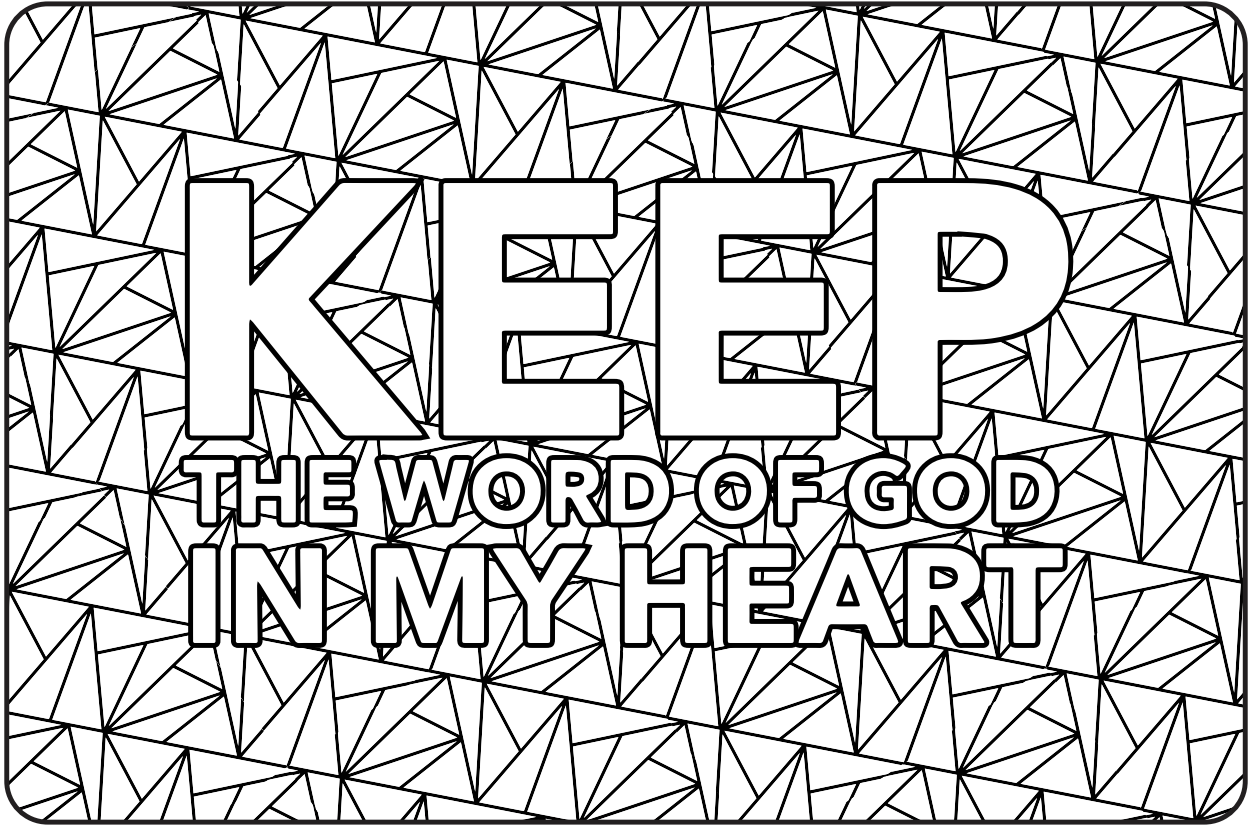

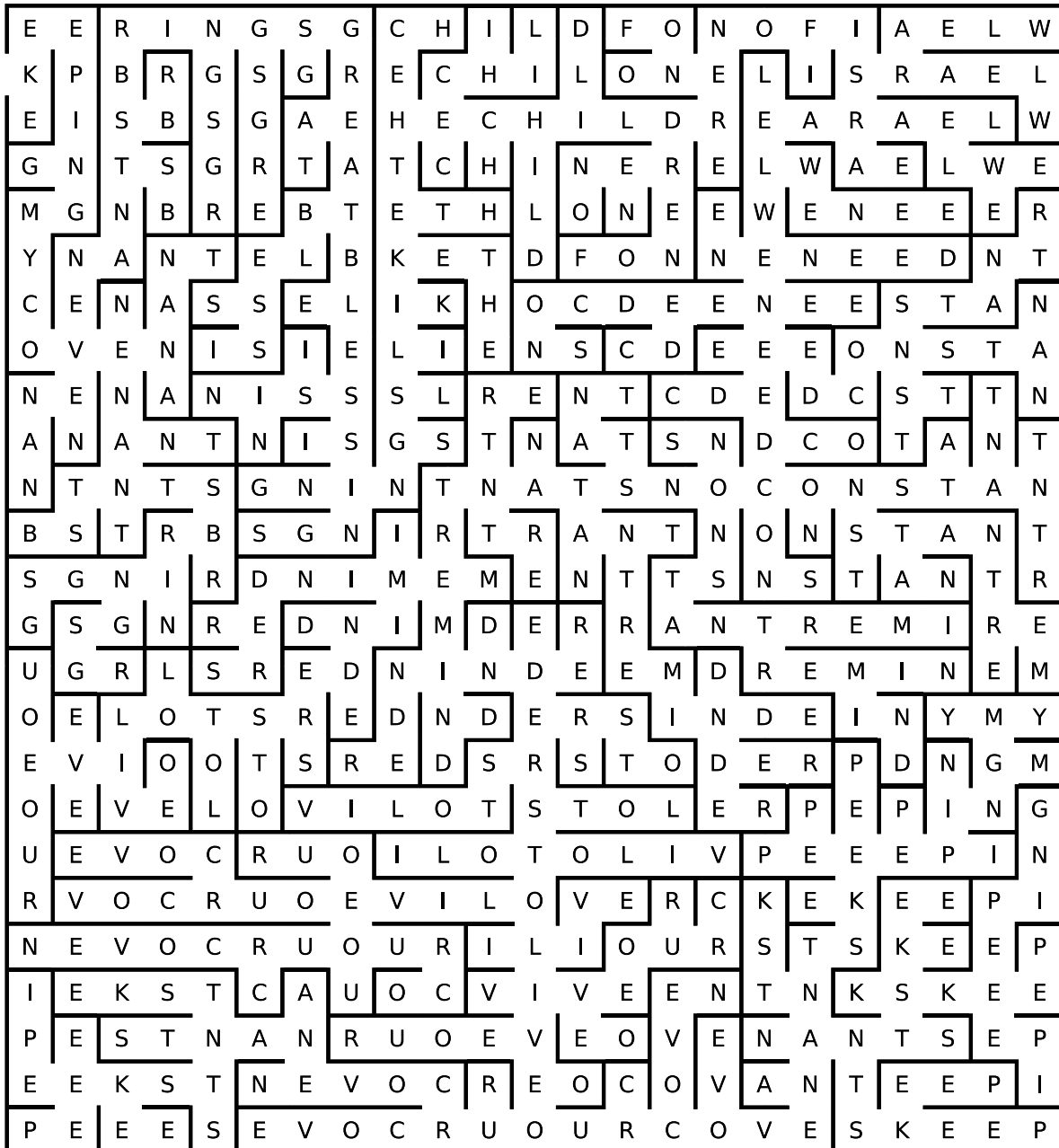

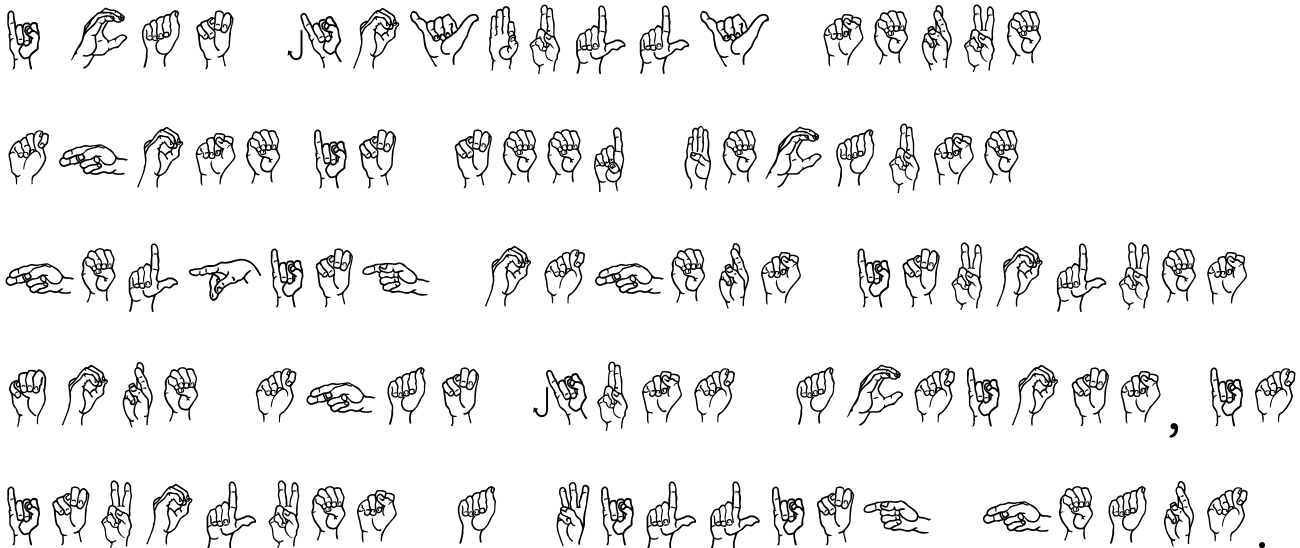
#### Deuteronomy 15:7,10-11

If there be **among** you a poor man of one of thy brethren within any of thy **gates** in thy land which the Lord thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not **harden** thine **heart**, nor **shut** thine hand from thy poor brother: Thou shalt surely give him, and thine heart shall not be **grieved** when thou **givest** unto him: because that for this thing the Lord thy God shall **bless** thee in all thy **works**, and in all that thou putteth thine hand unto. 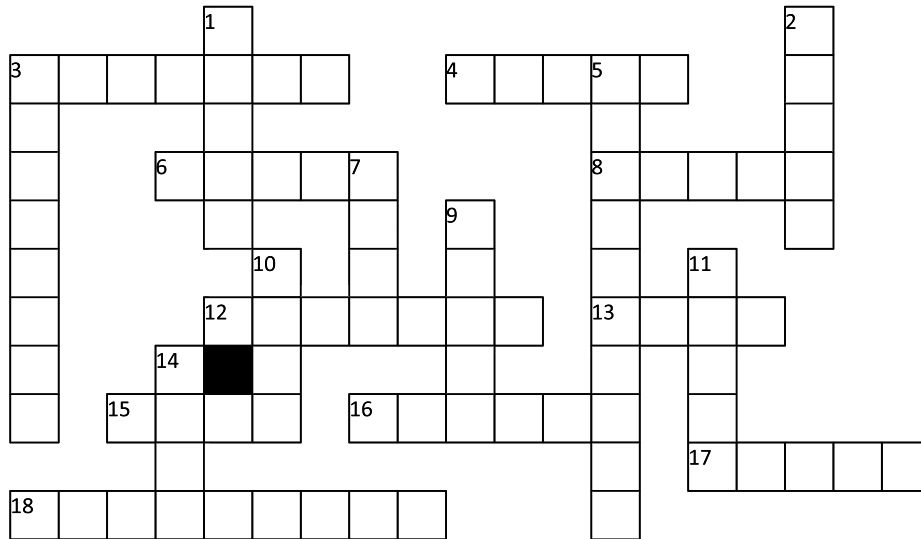
