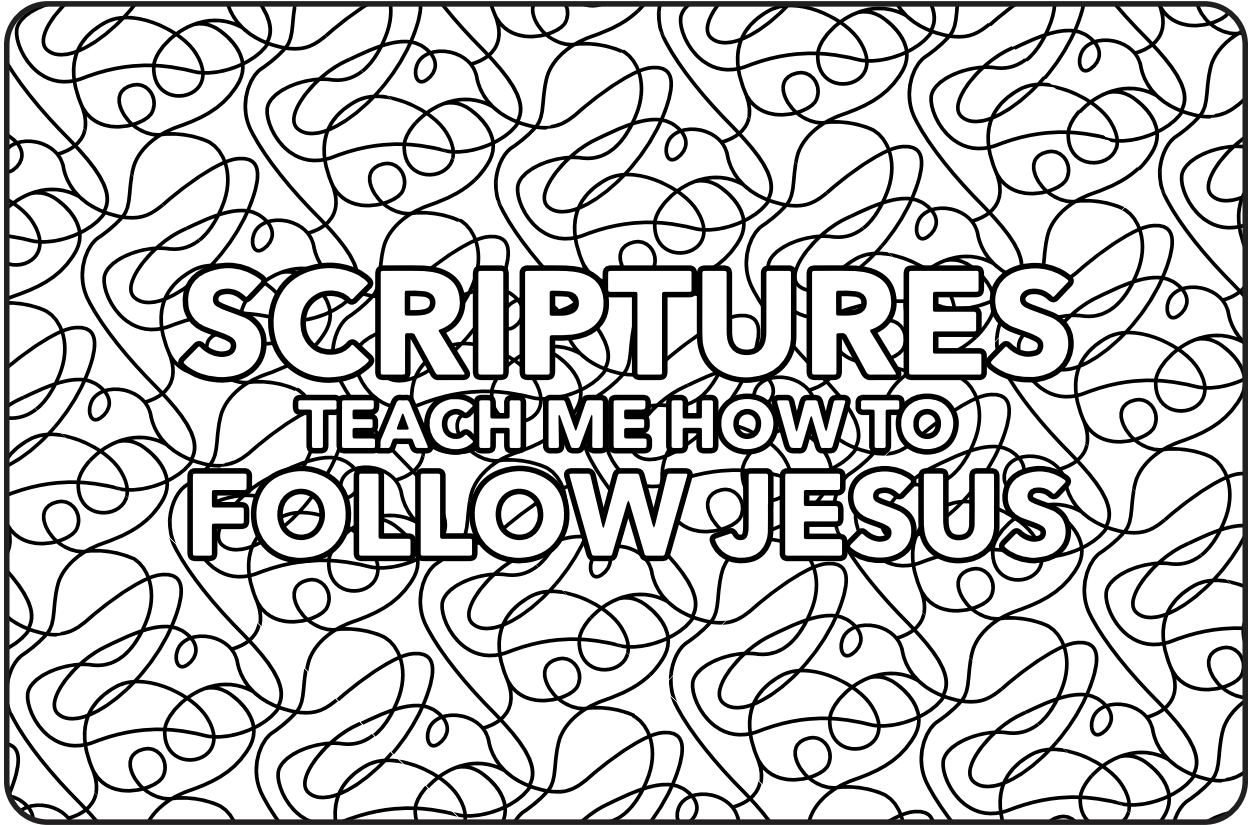

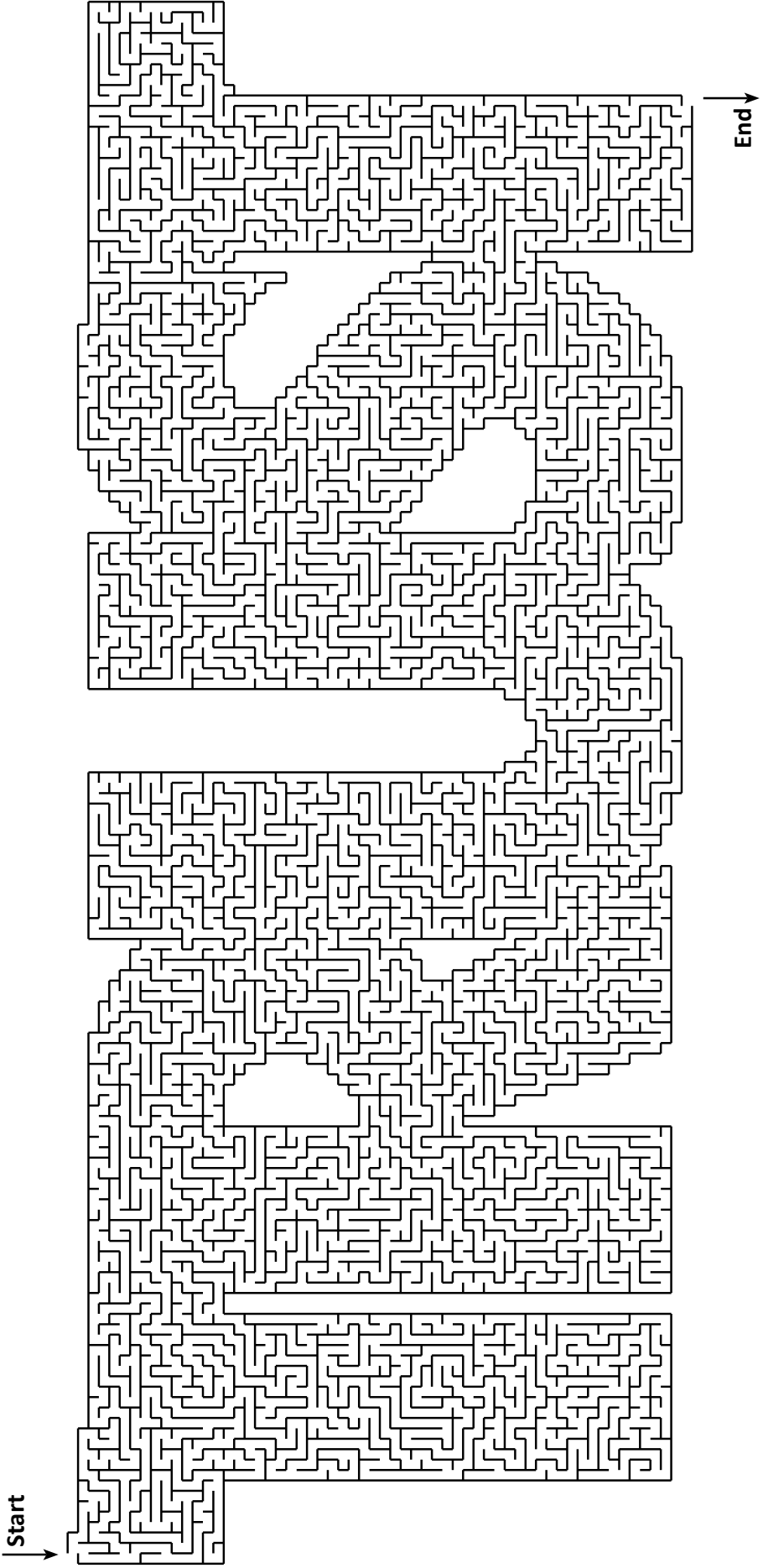

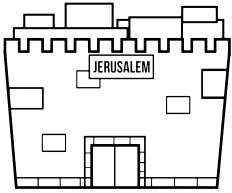


# Baptism Tic-Tac-Toe

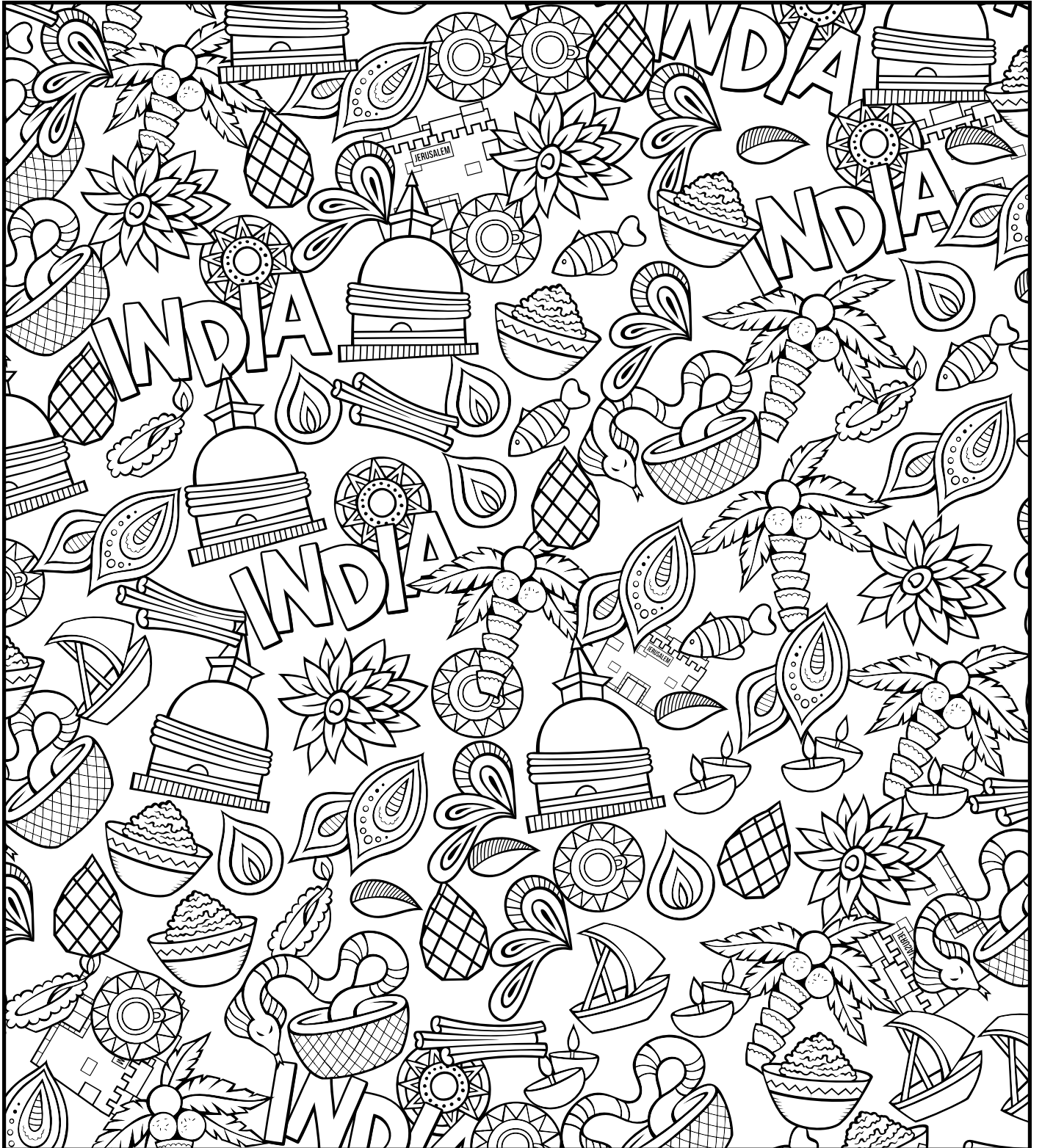

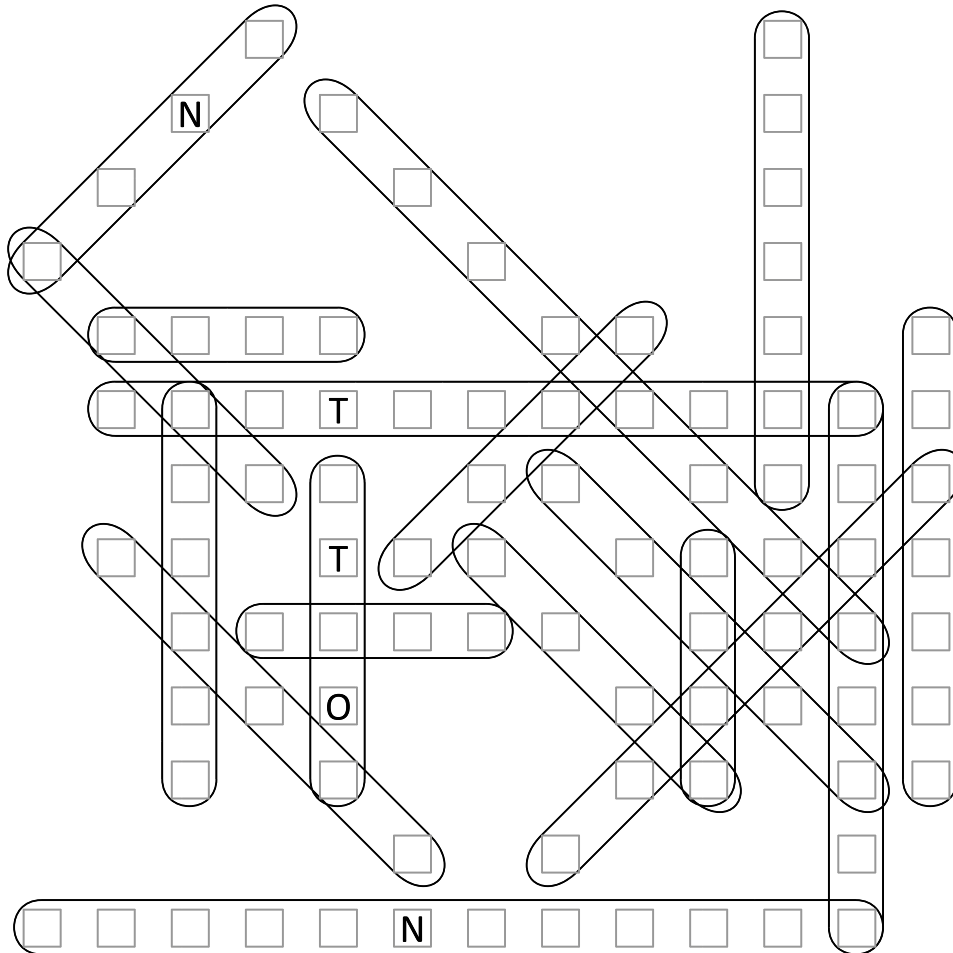
