Instructions: Find the bold words from the scripture in the word search puzzle. Each word could be hidden forwards, backwards, up, down, or diagonally.


## 2 Kings 19:14-16, 19


Instructions: Translate the sign language letters below into English to discover the hidden message. Write the alphabet letter beneath each hand sign. Use the key at the back of the book to help you.



# Baptism Tic-Tac-Toe By Arie Van De Graaff




