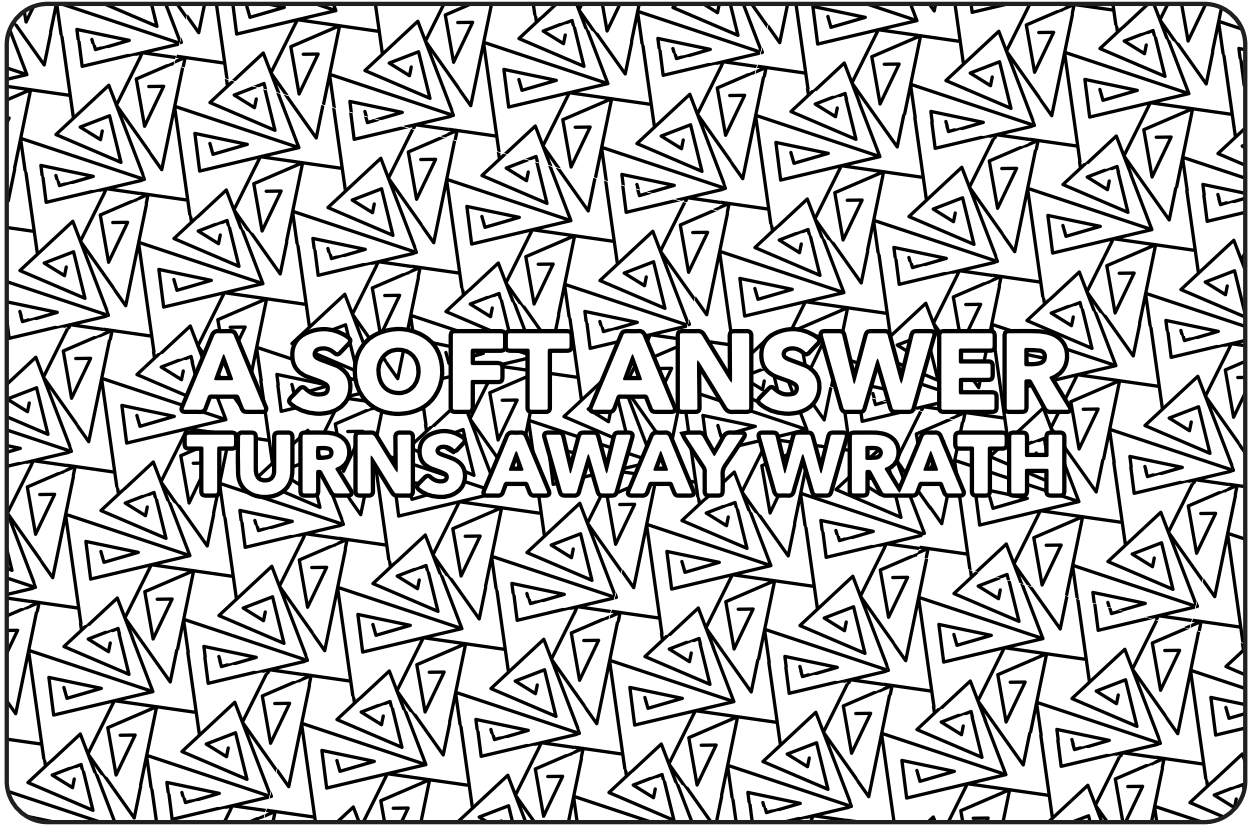

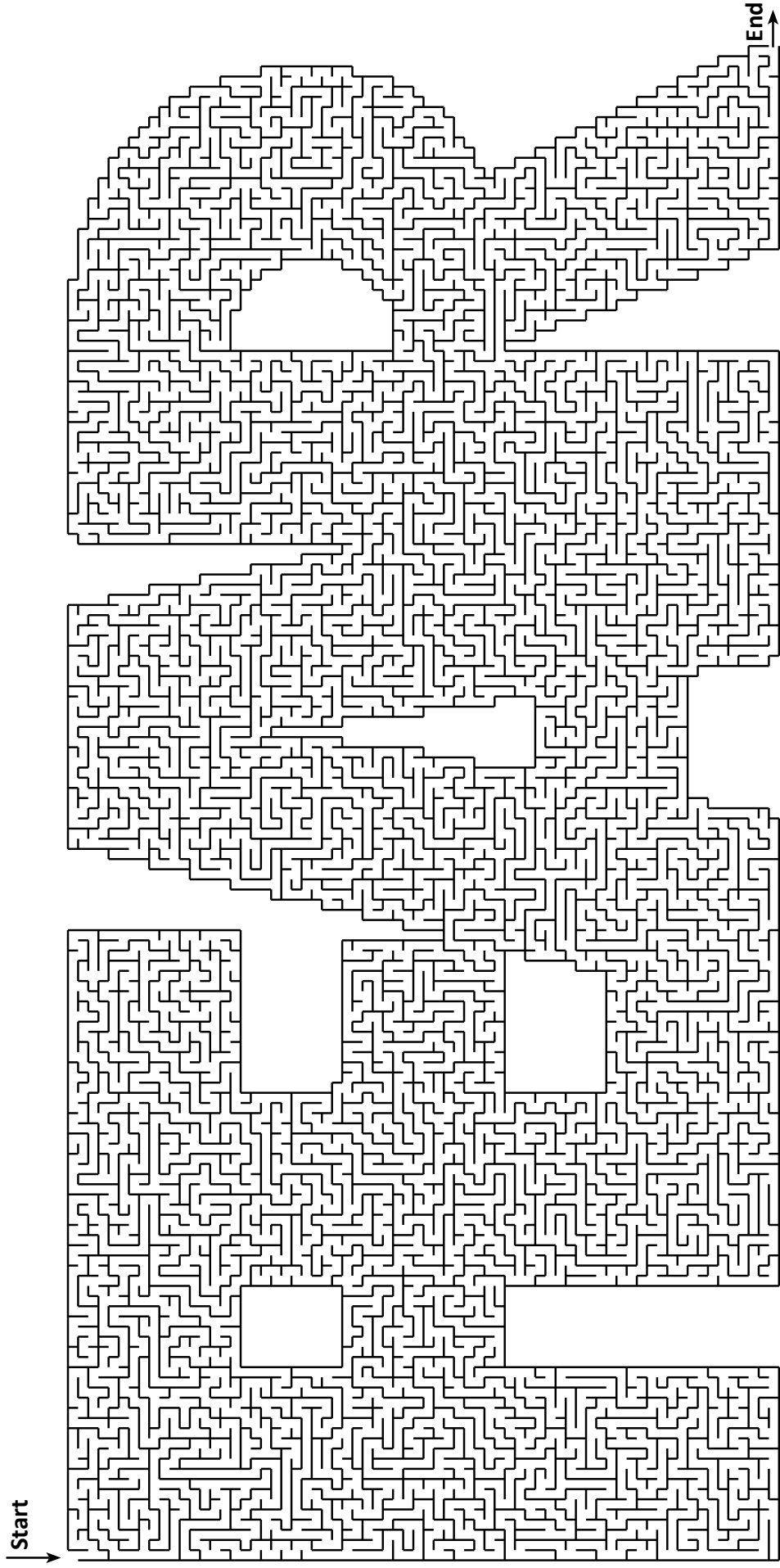

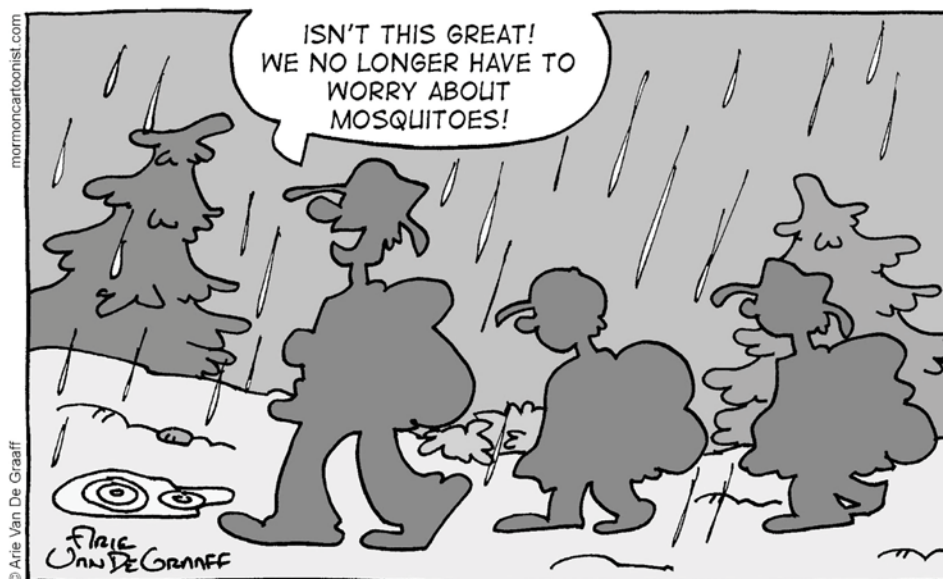
Letter Sudoku

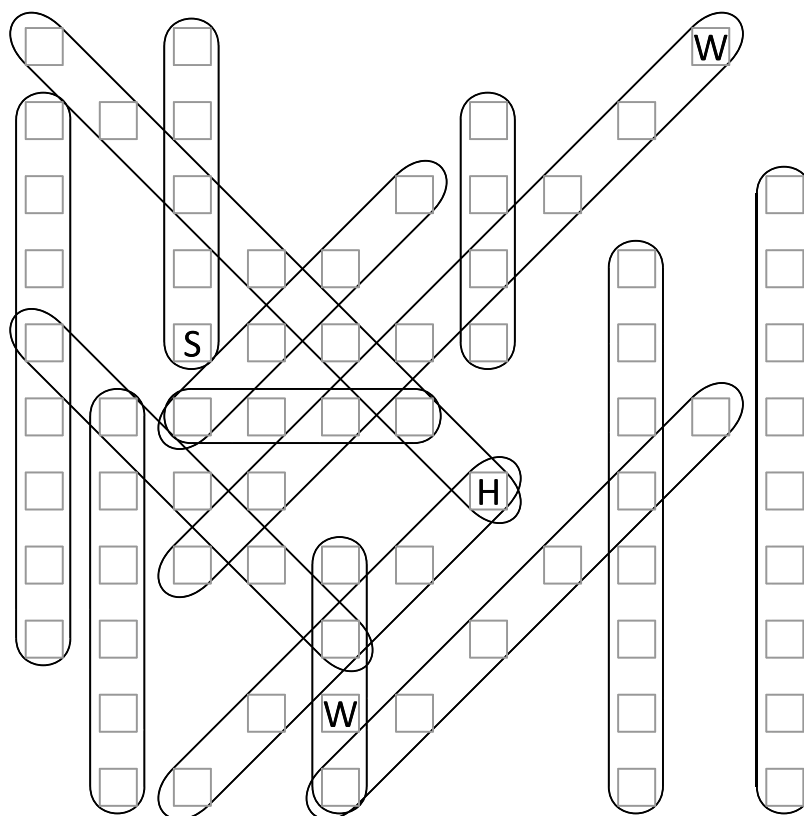
