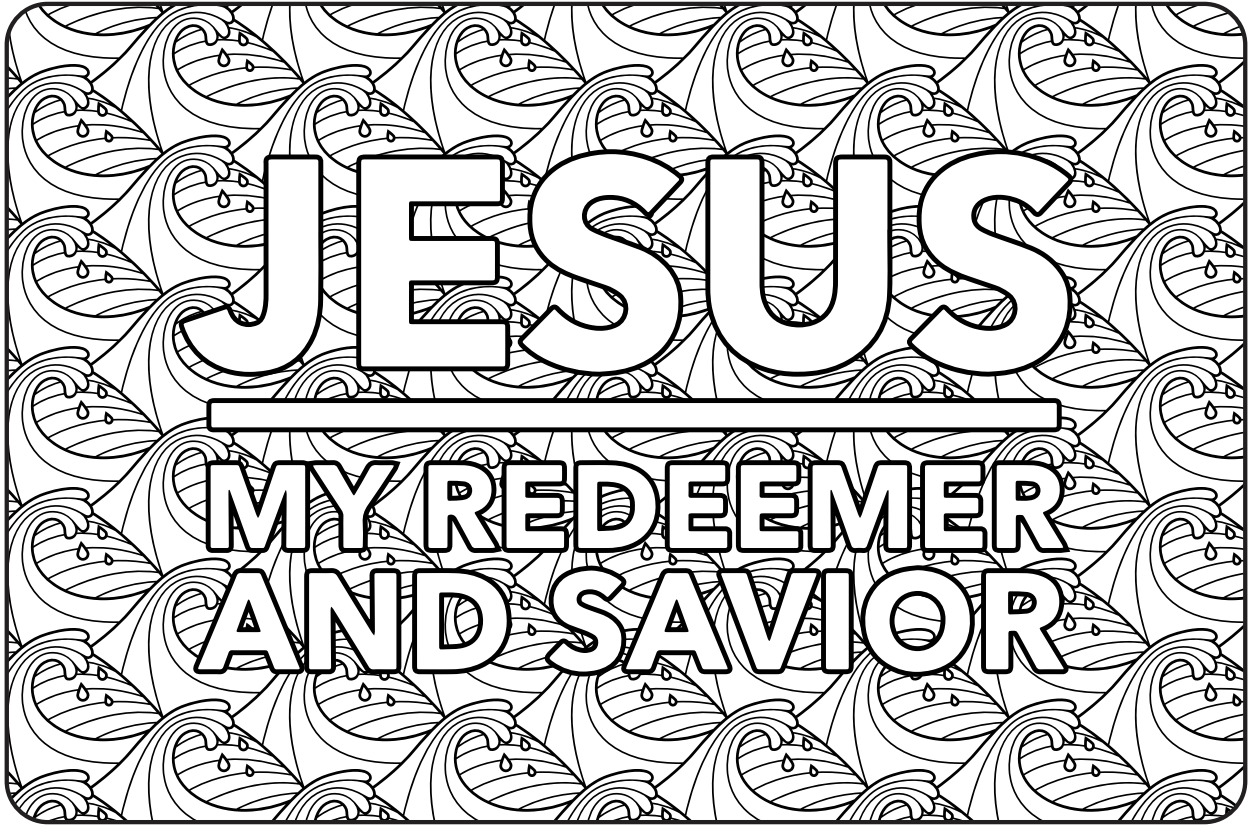

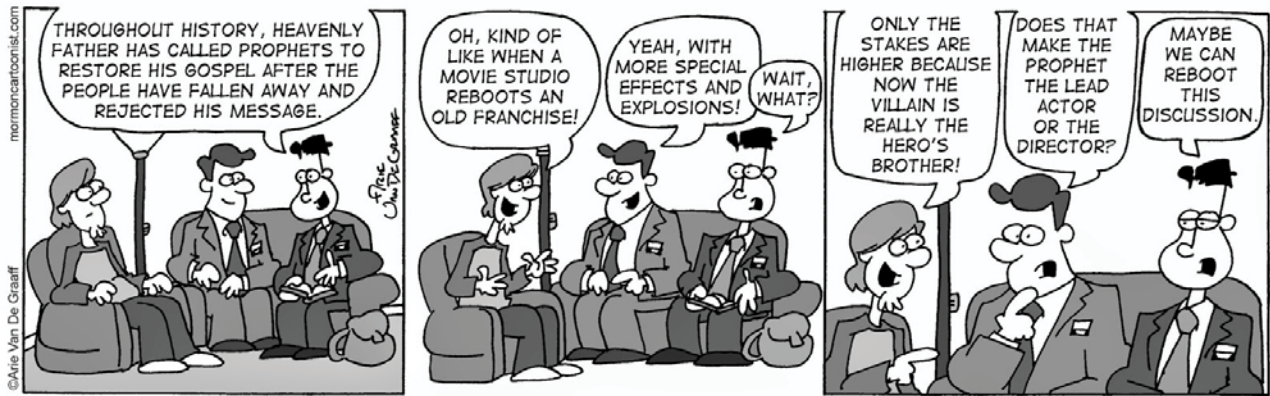
## Letter Sudoku

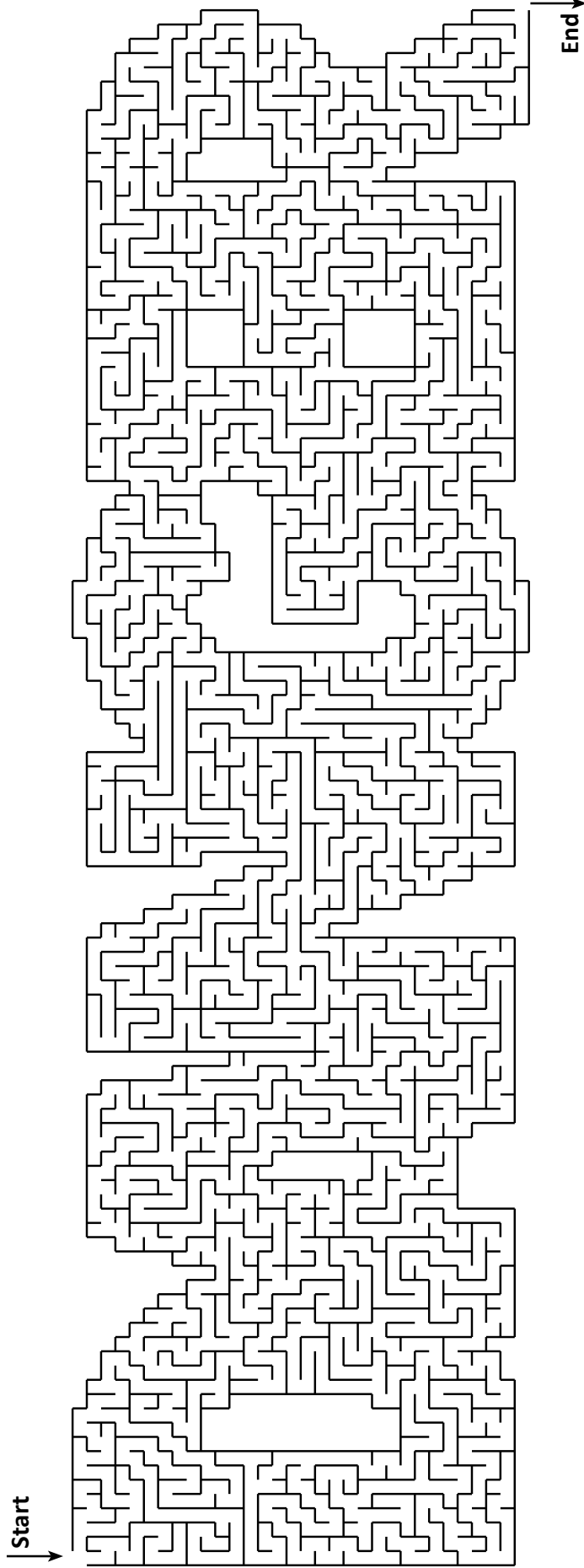

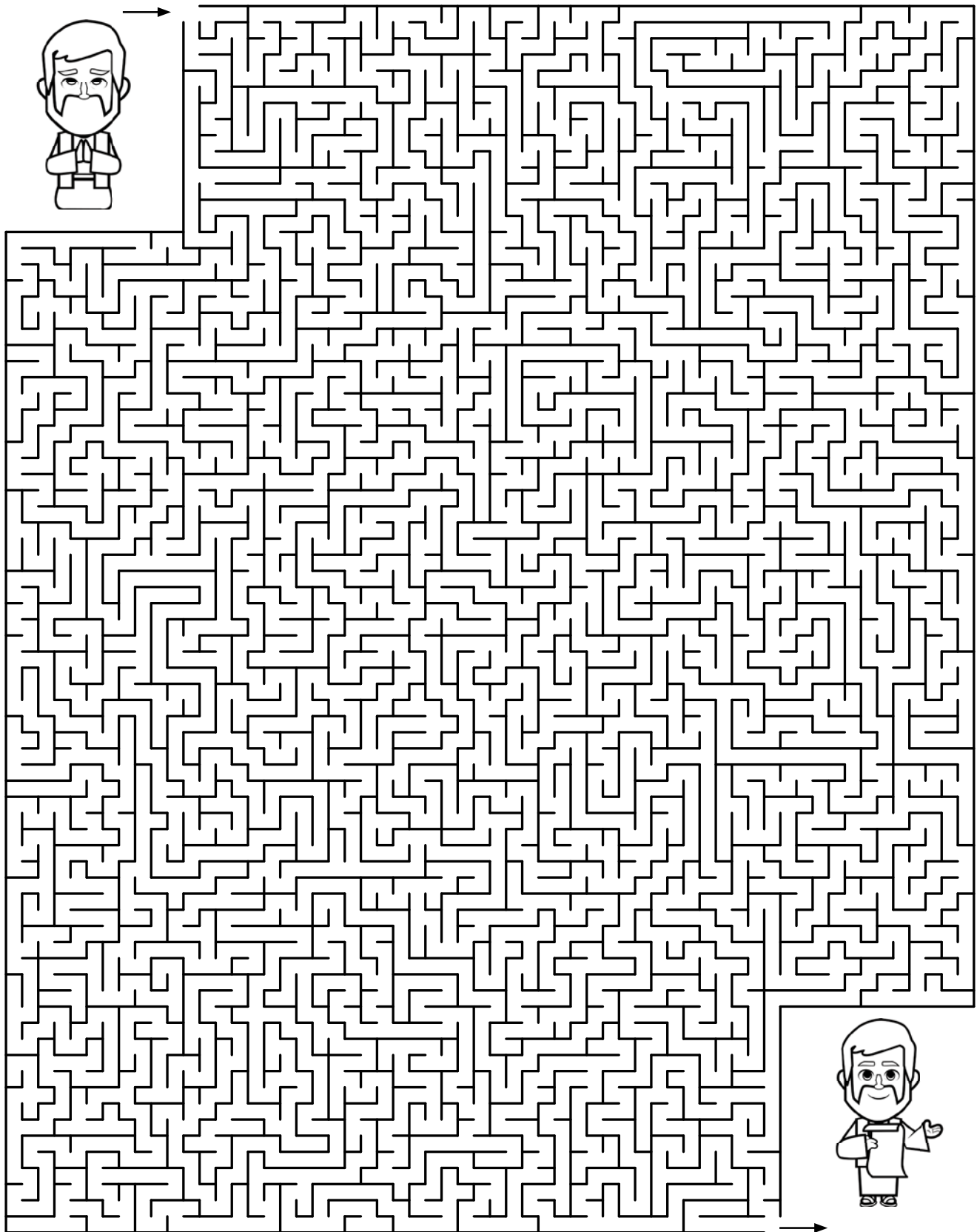

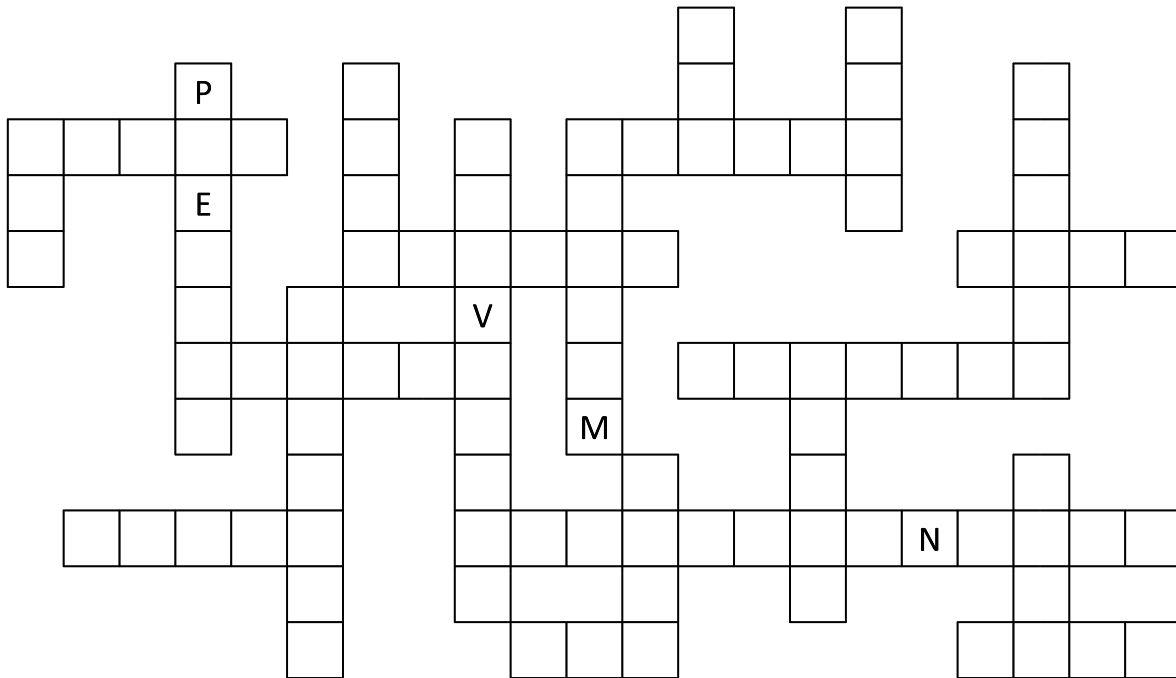
