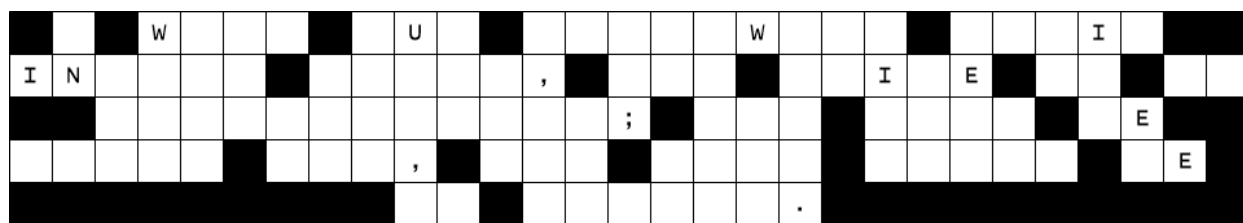
Jeremiah 32:38–41

Fallen Phrase

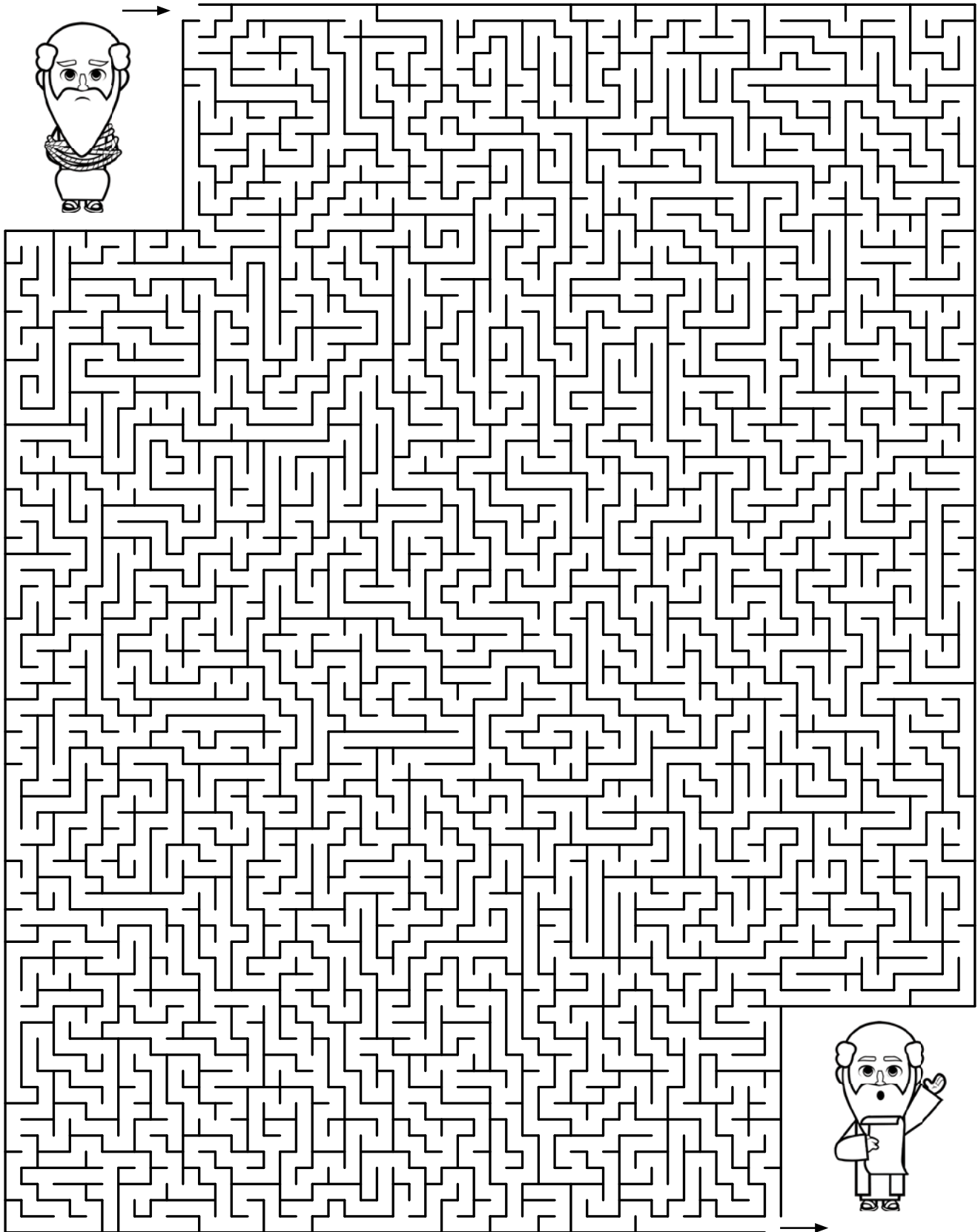
