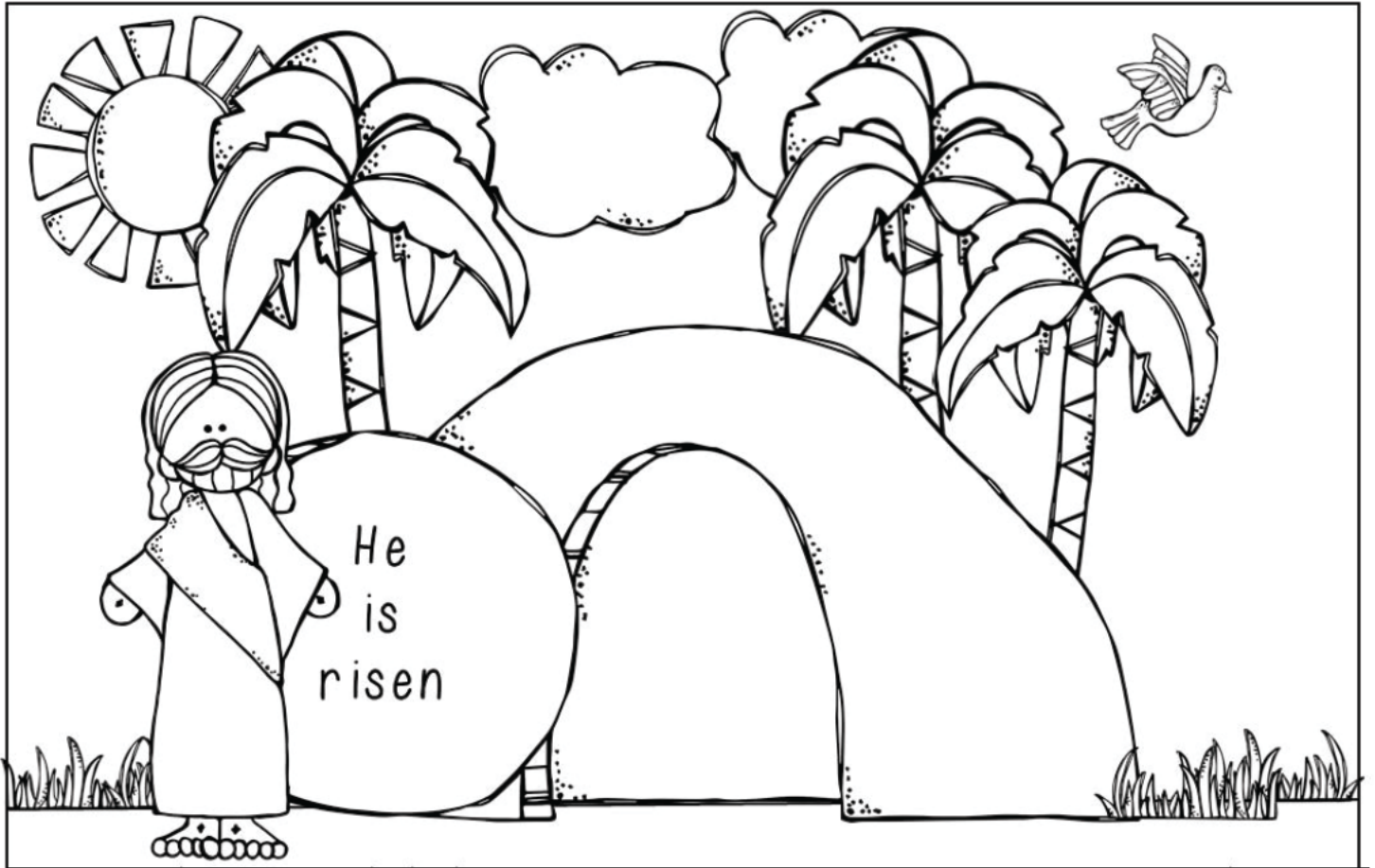

### Word Squares

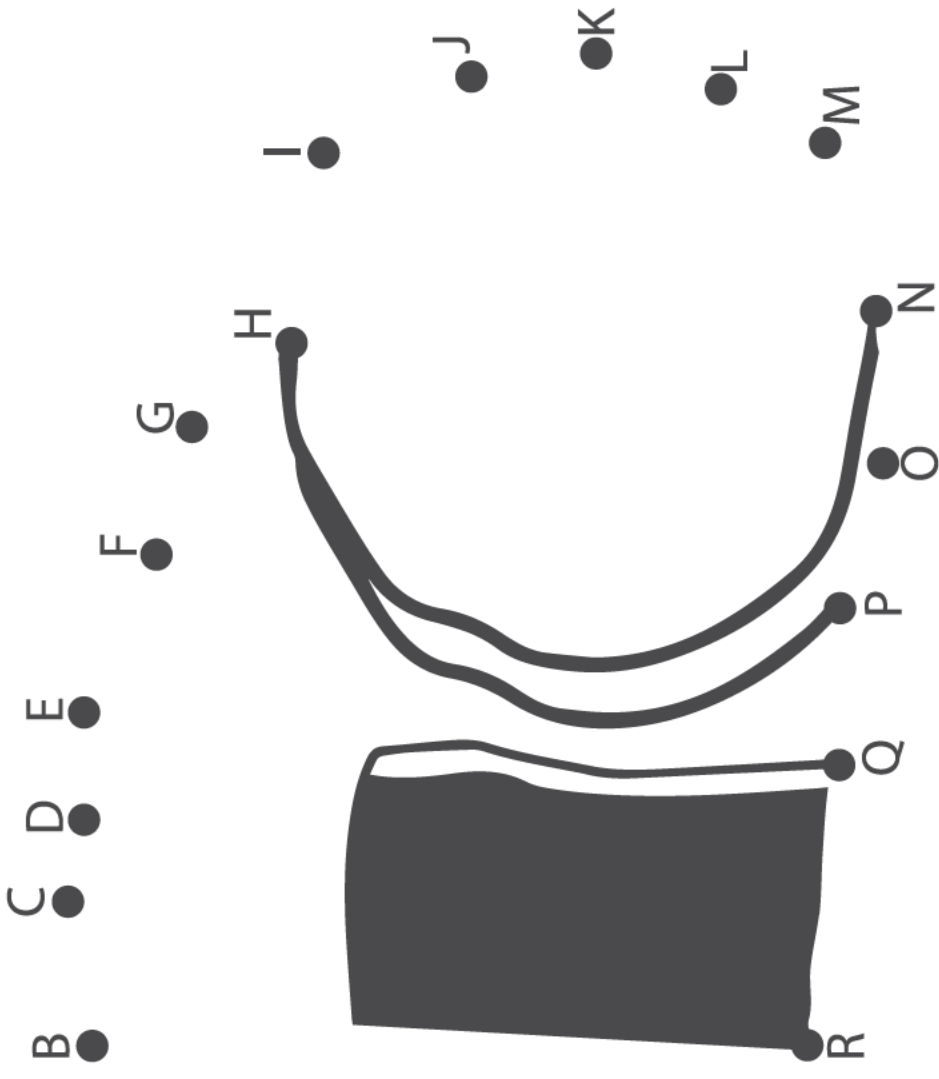
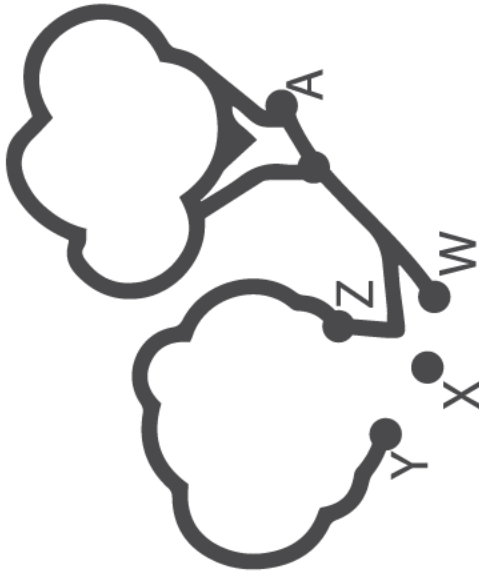
