Write down the first letter of each picture in the box beneath it to find the hidden word. Not sure what the picture is? Turn to the last 2 pages of this book for the key to the code.

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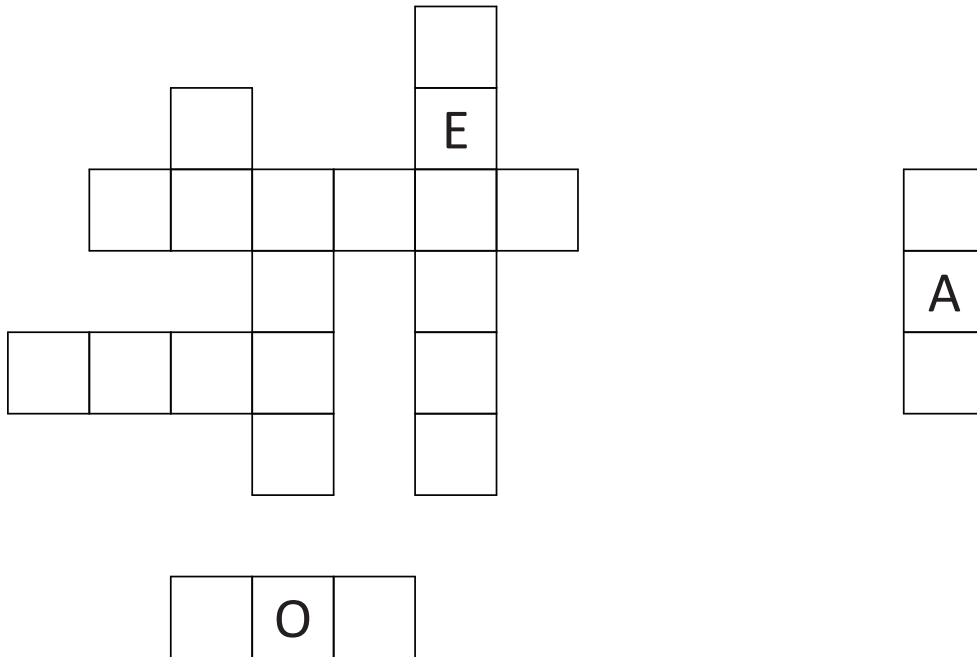
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Instructions: Fill in the blank puzzle grid using the word bank that has the bolded words from the scripture below. Place the words in the correct place on the grid.
