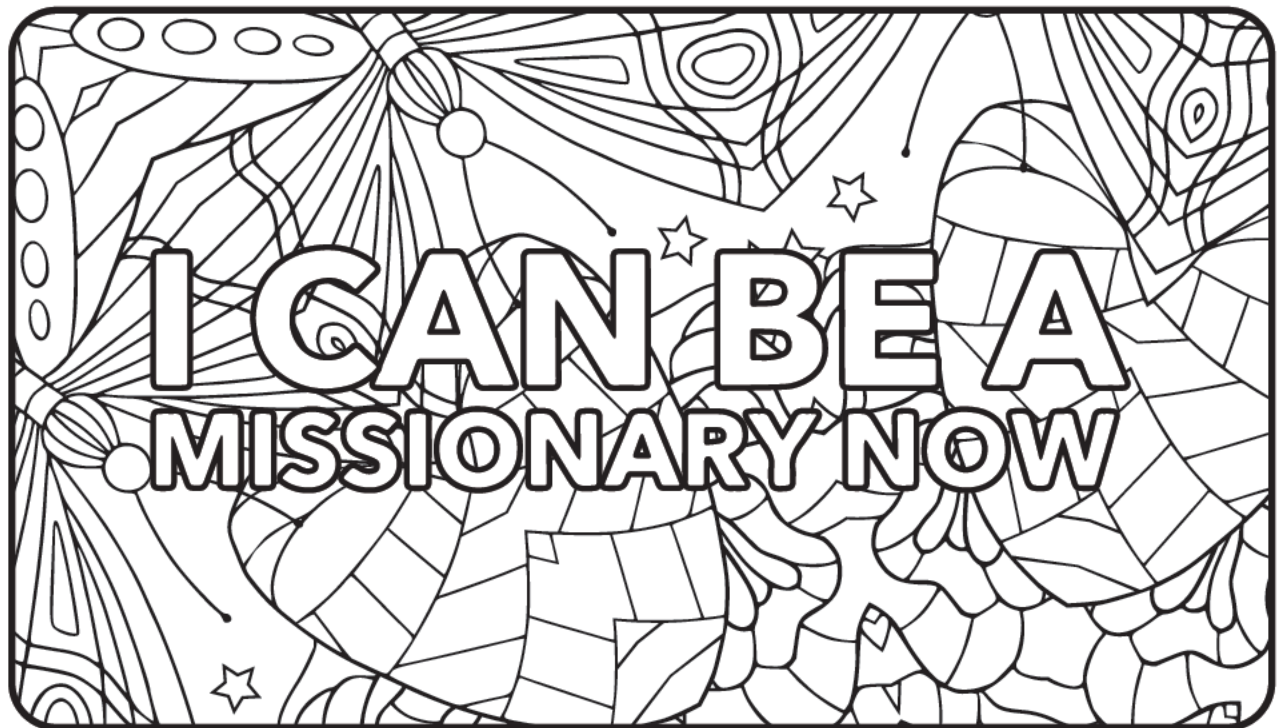
Word Angles

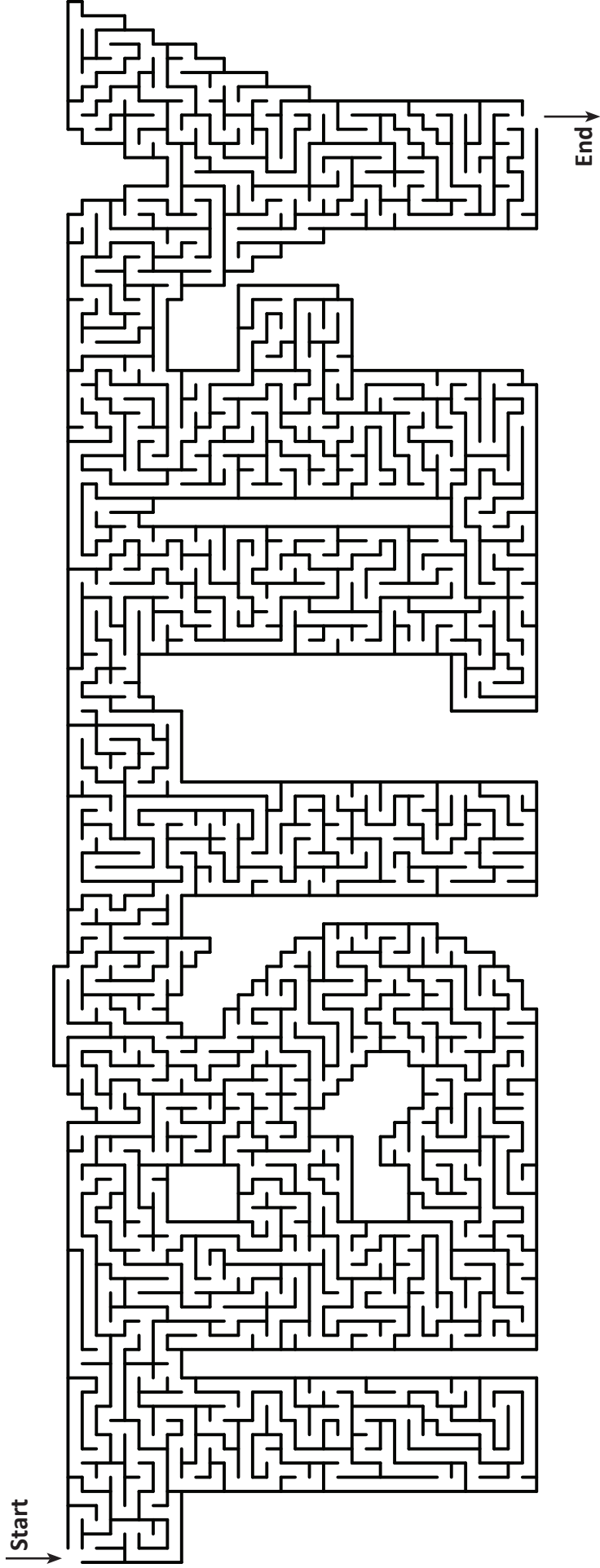

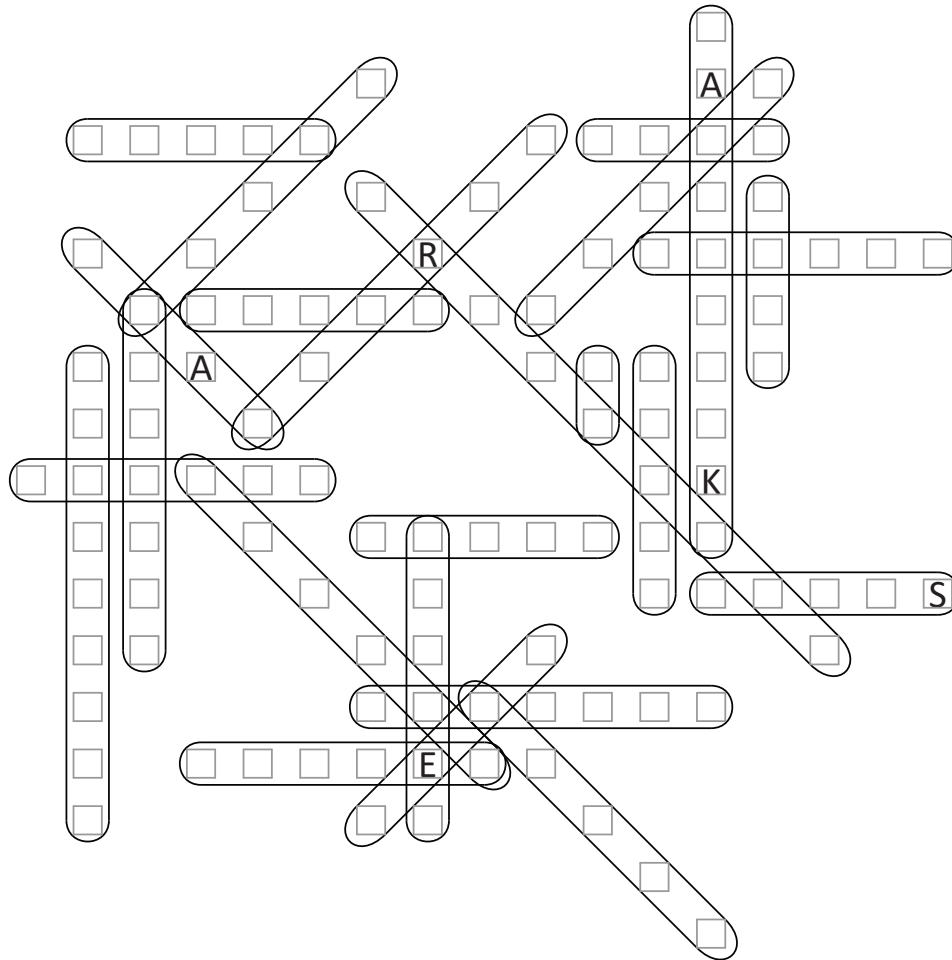
