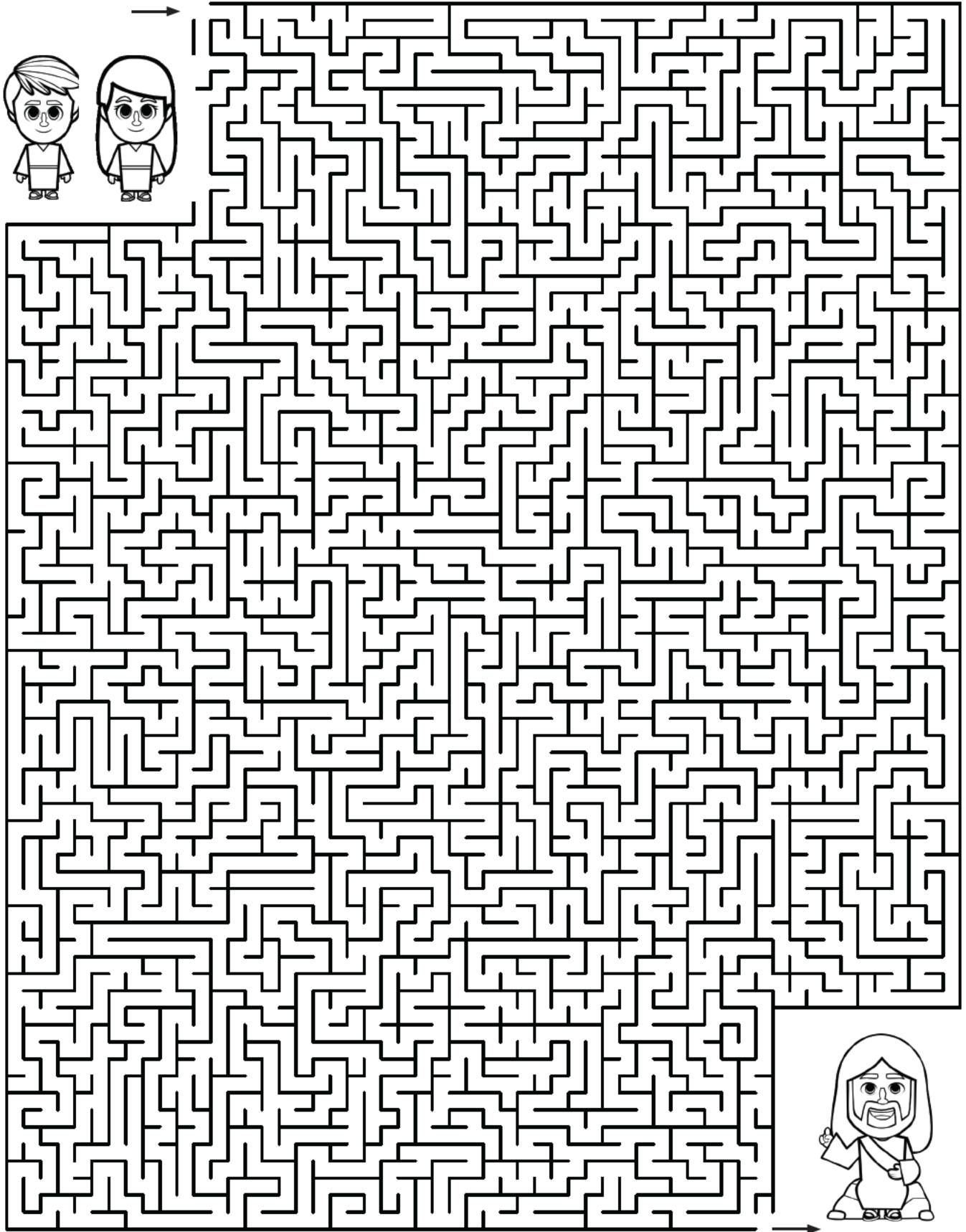
### Matthew 5:3-12

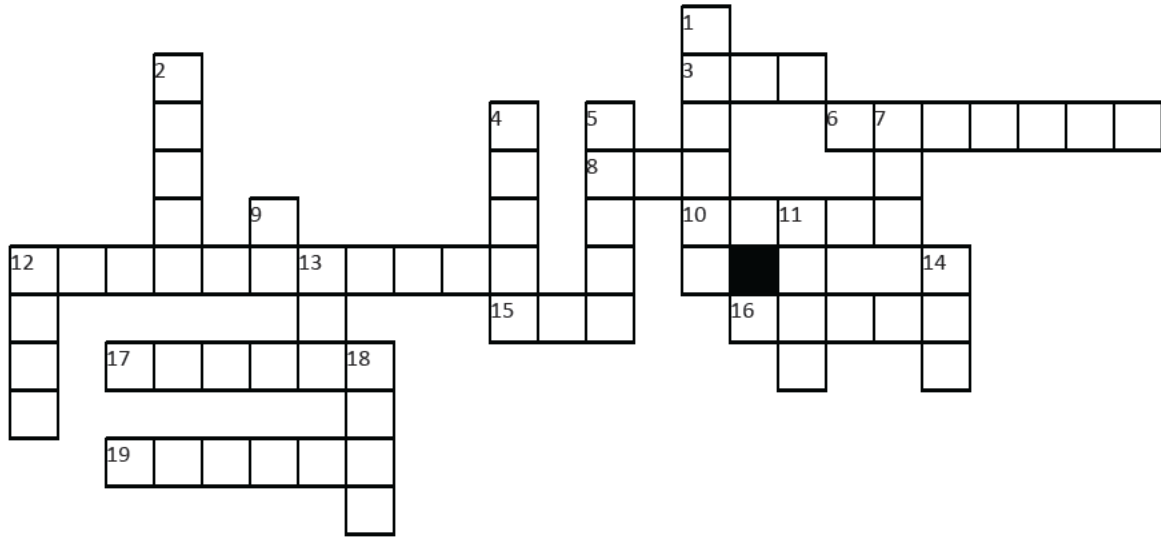
