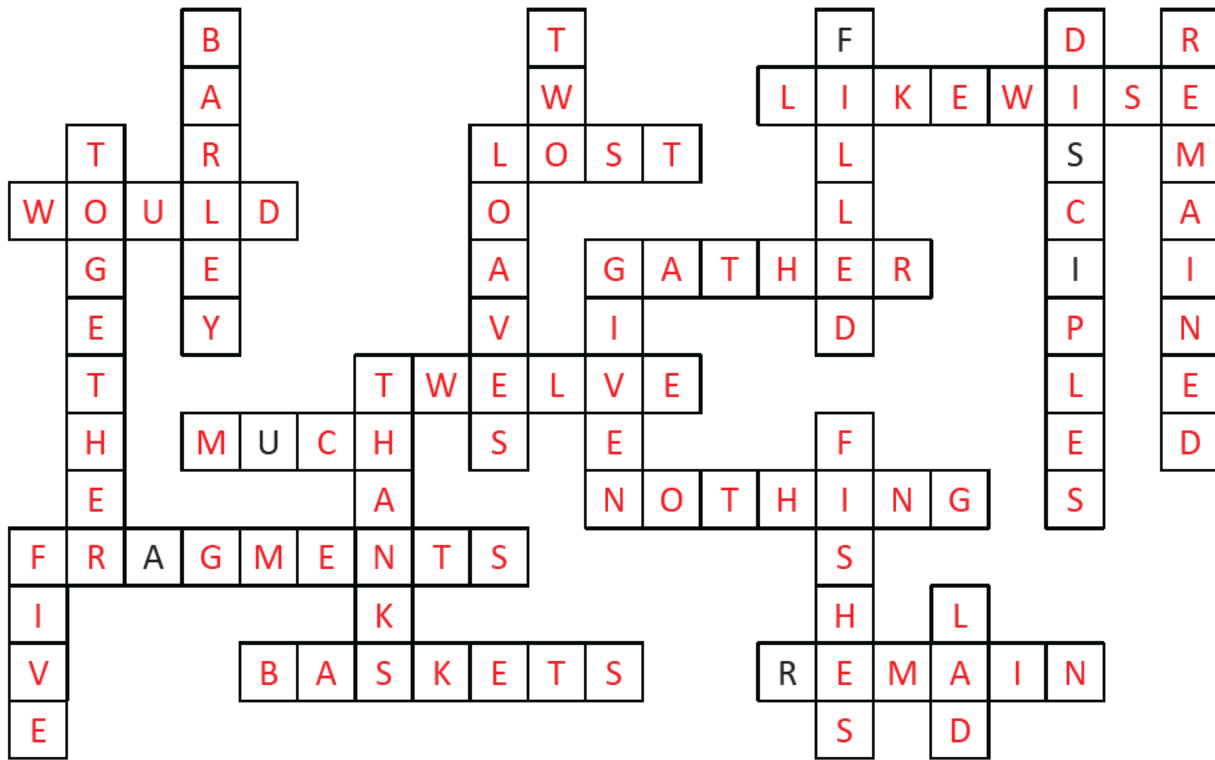
## Matthew 14; Mark 6; John 5–6
