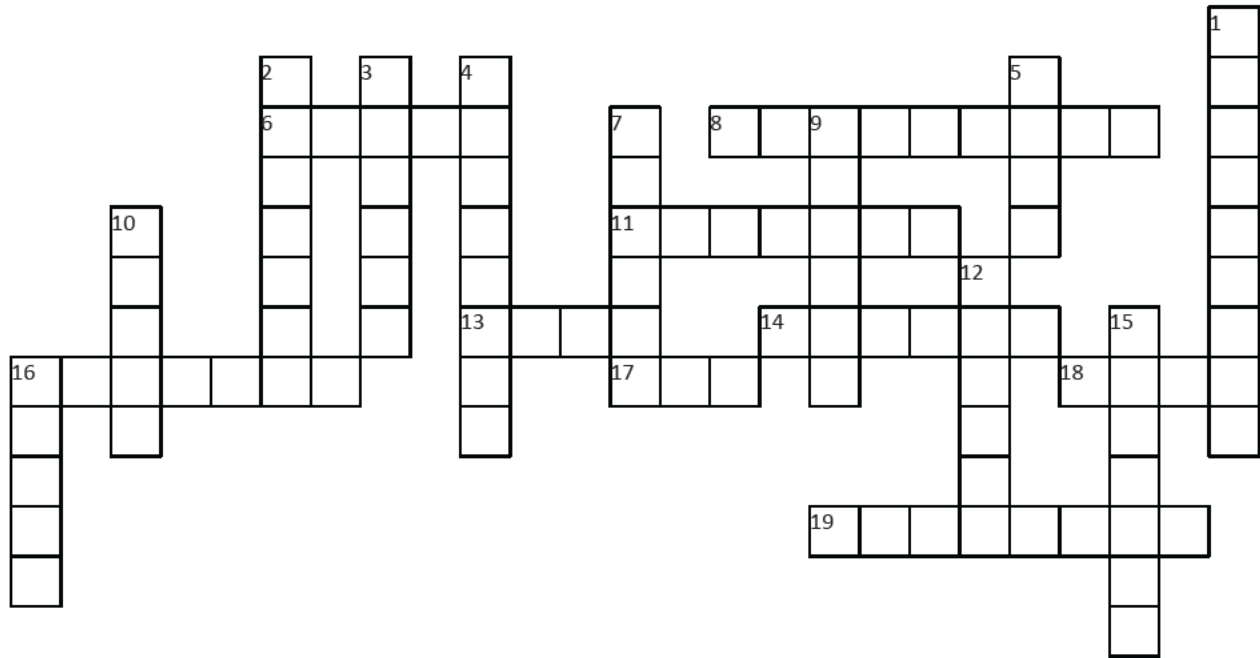

- When someone is immersed in water to begin their covenant path back to Heavenly Father.

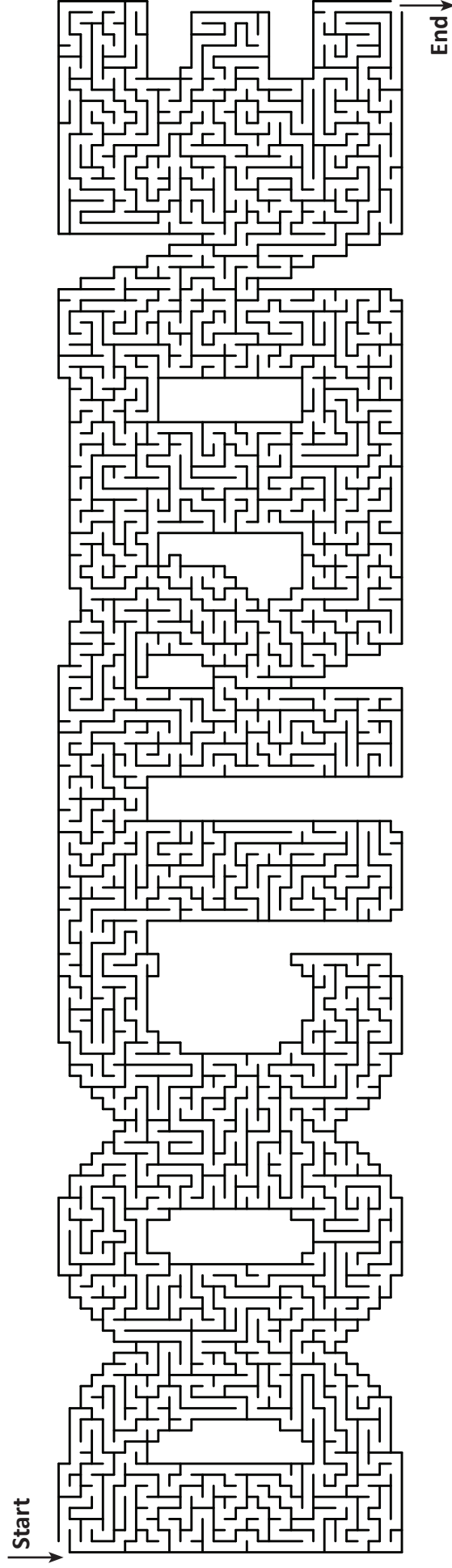
#### DOWN

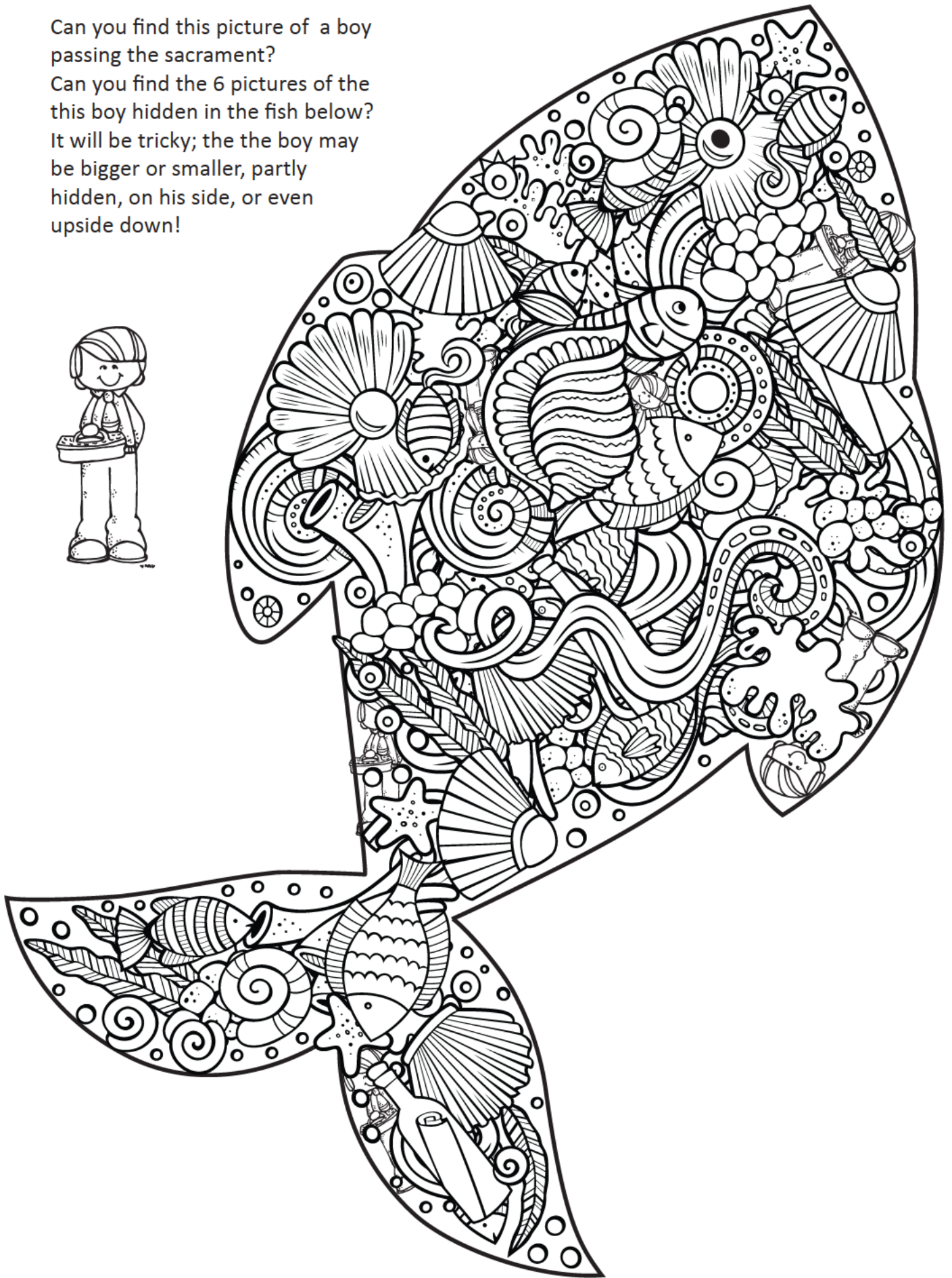


# Hidden Picture
