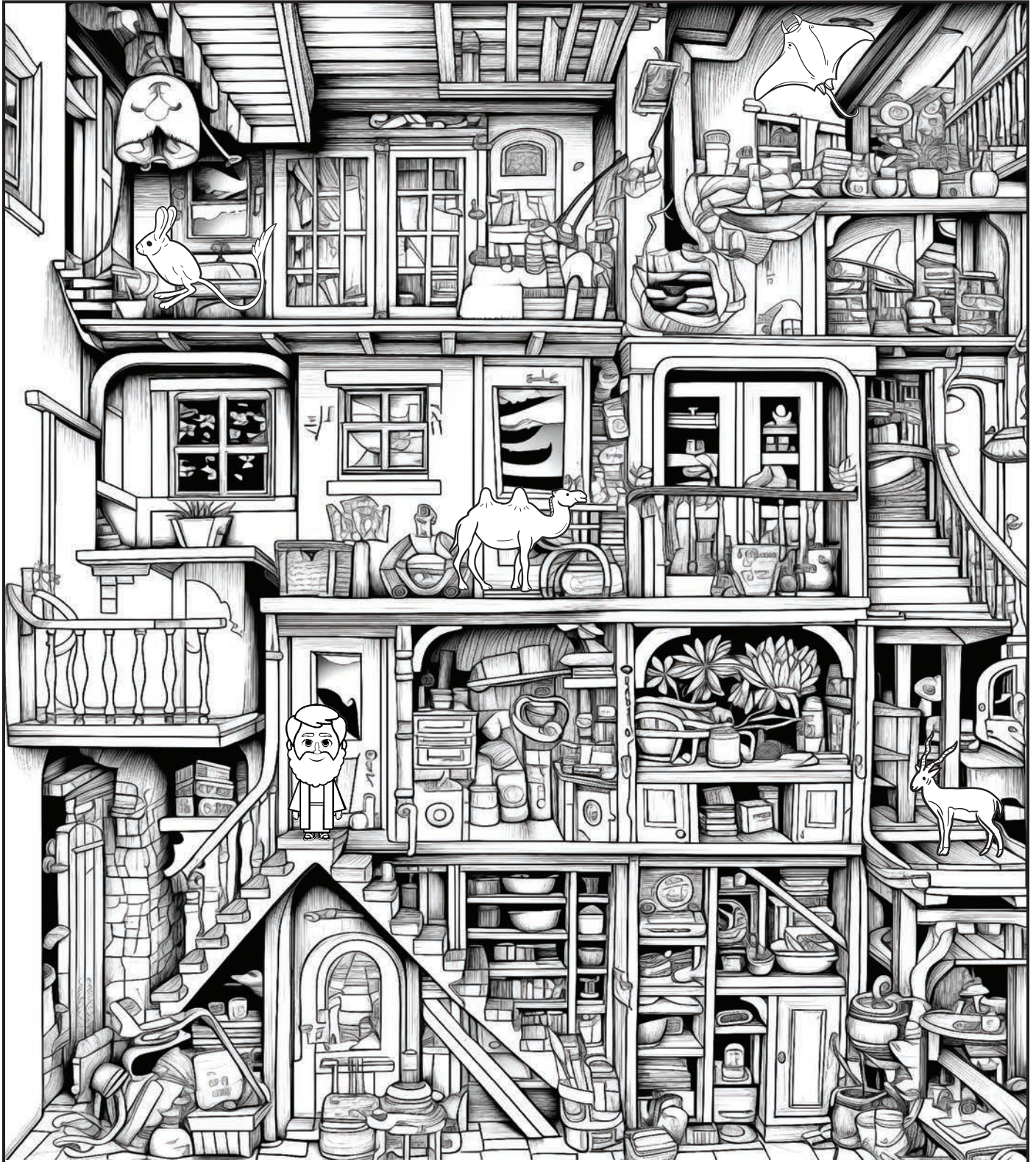
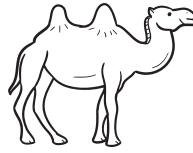
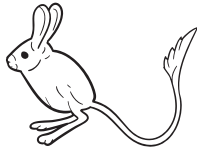
Instructions: Finish this picture of Jacob preaching to Korihor by tracing the gray lines below. Then, color the picture.
