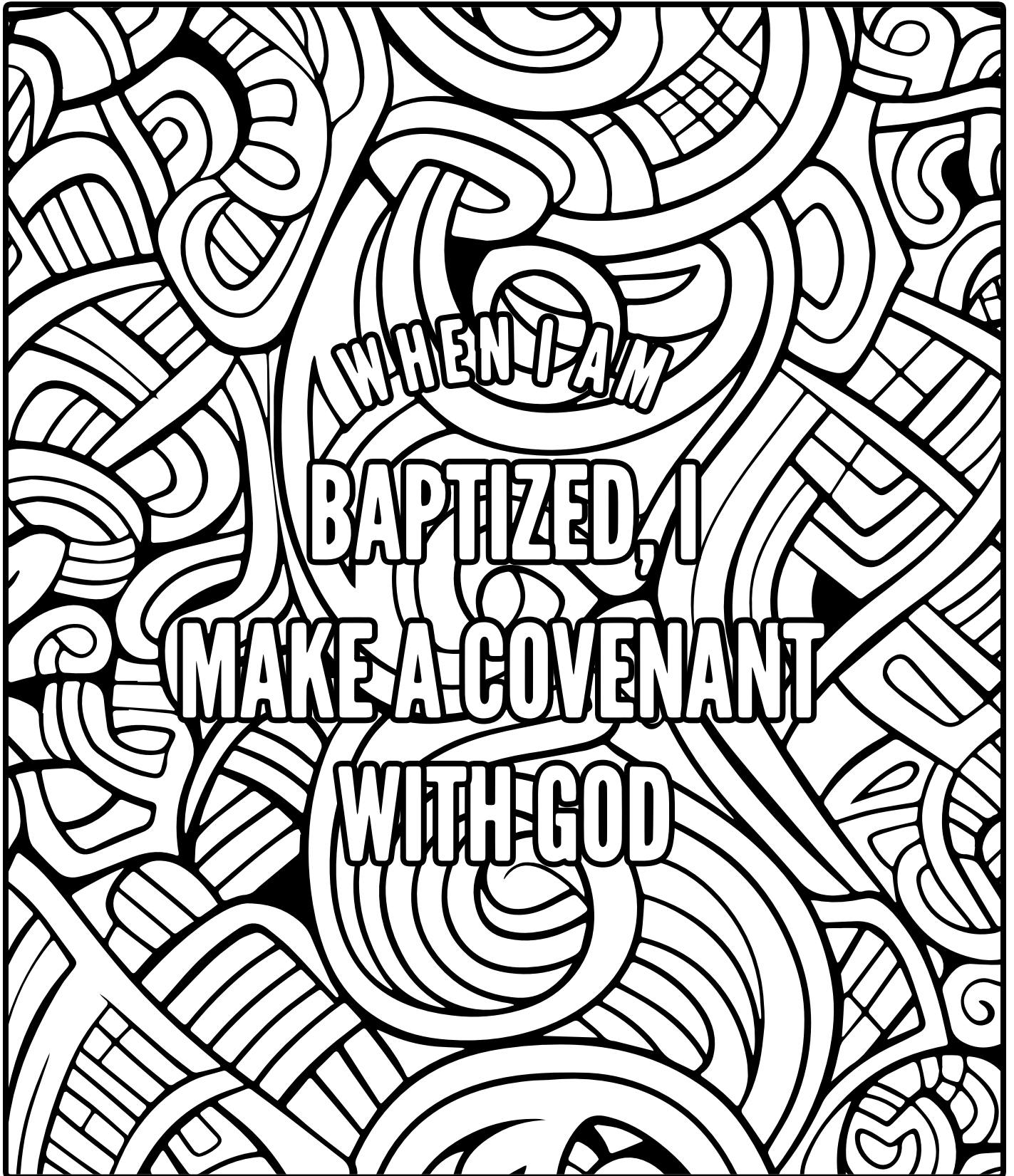

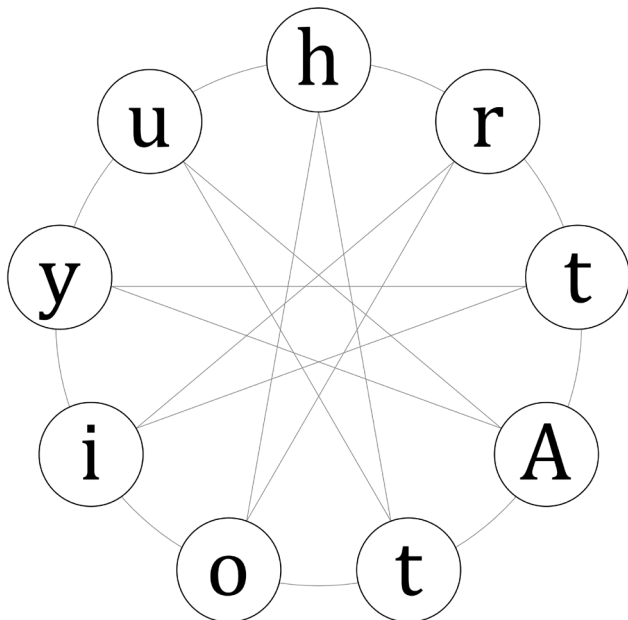
Mosiah 24:13-14

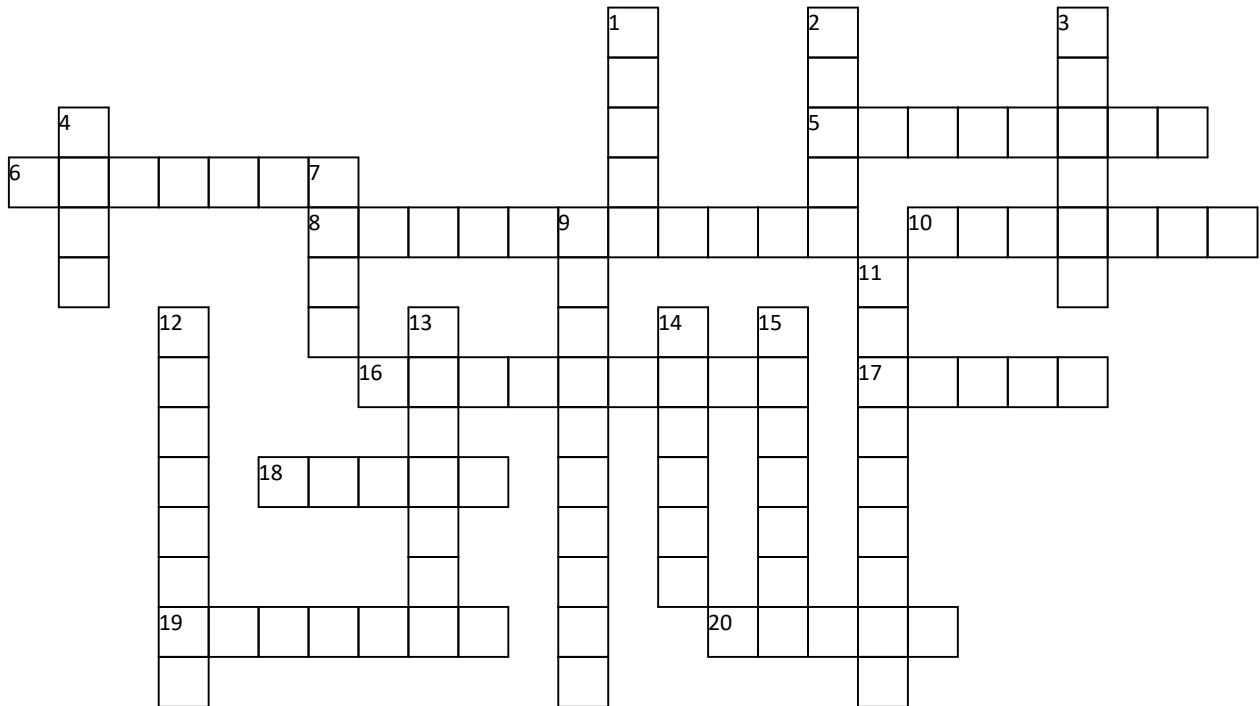
