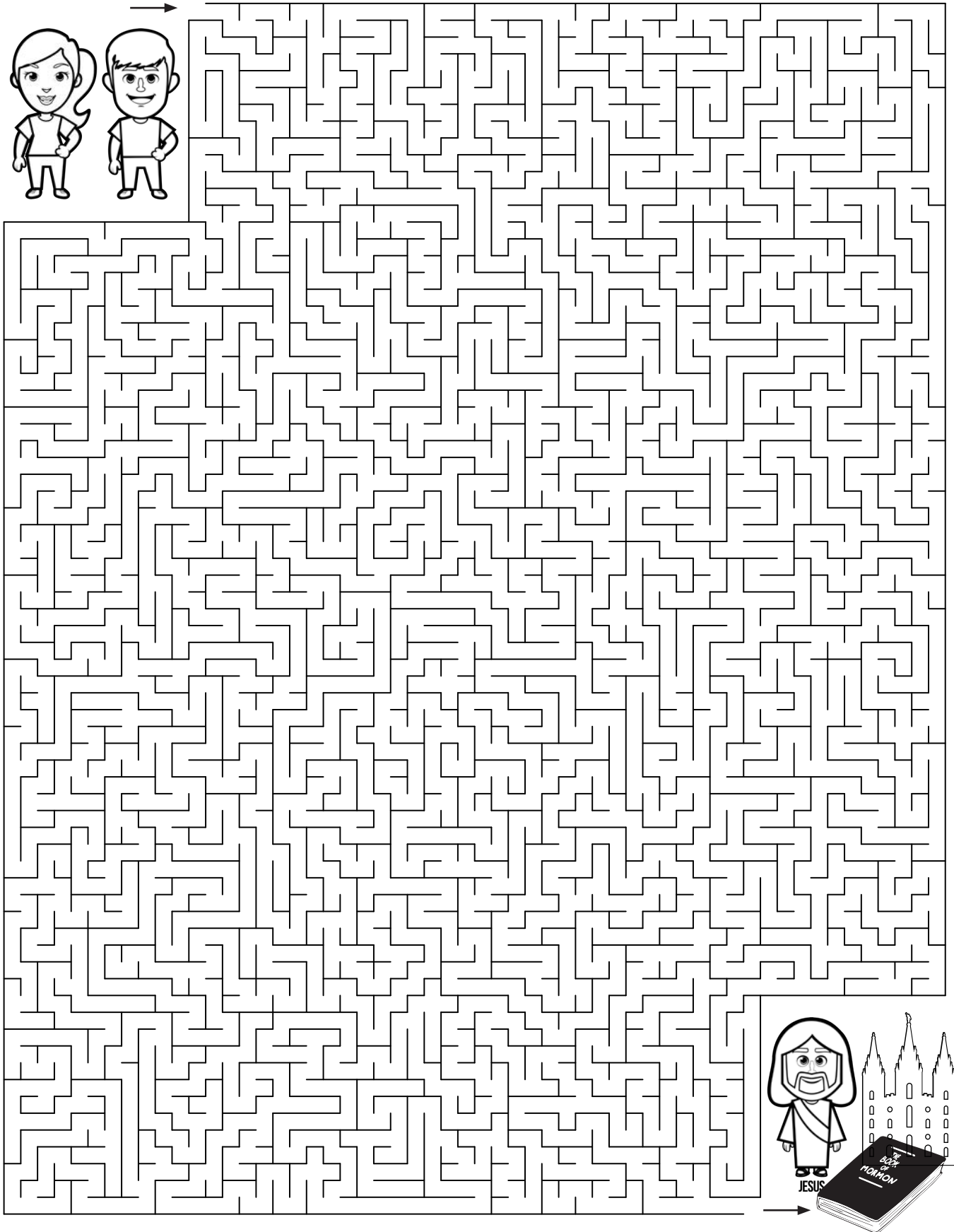

Instructions: Find the bold words from the scripture in the word search puzzle. Each word could be hidden forwards, backwards, up, down, or diagonally.

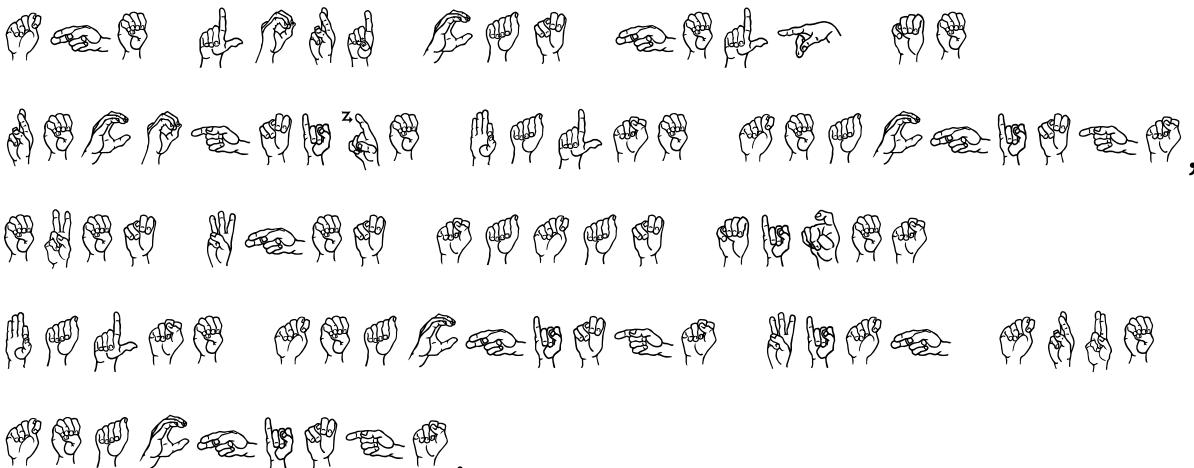
Alma 1:2–4

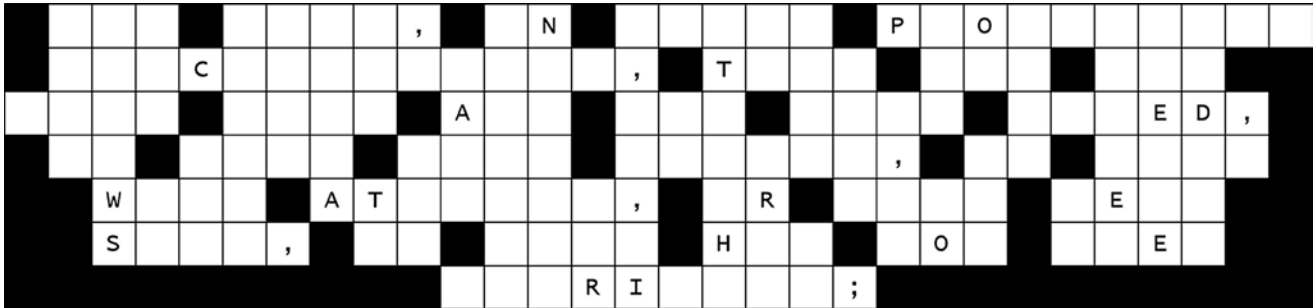
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Fallen Phrase
