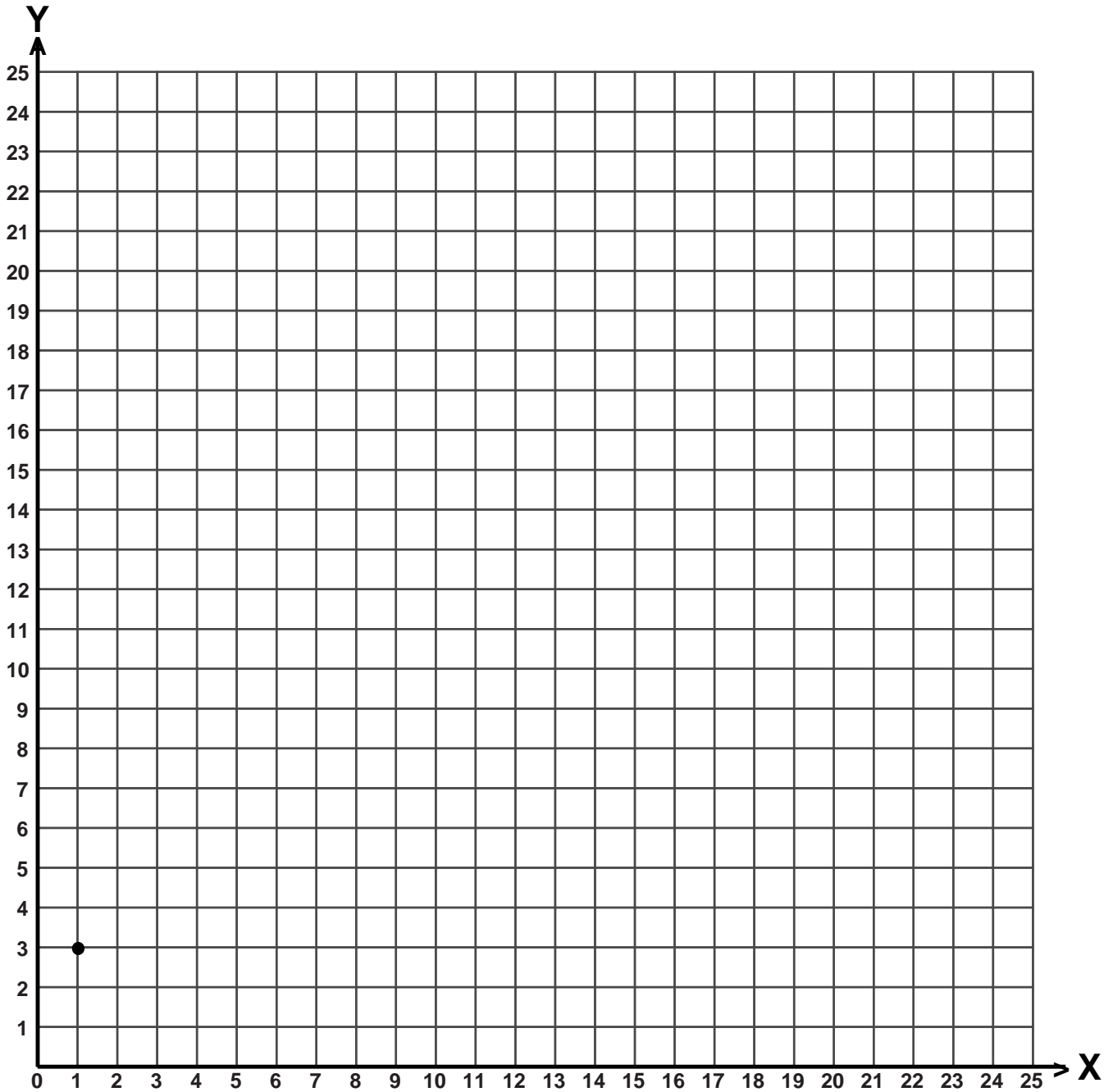

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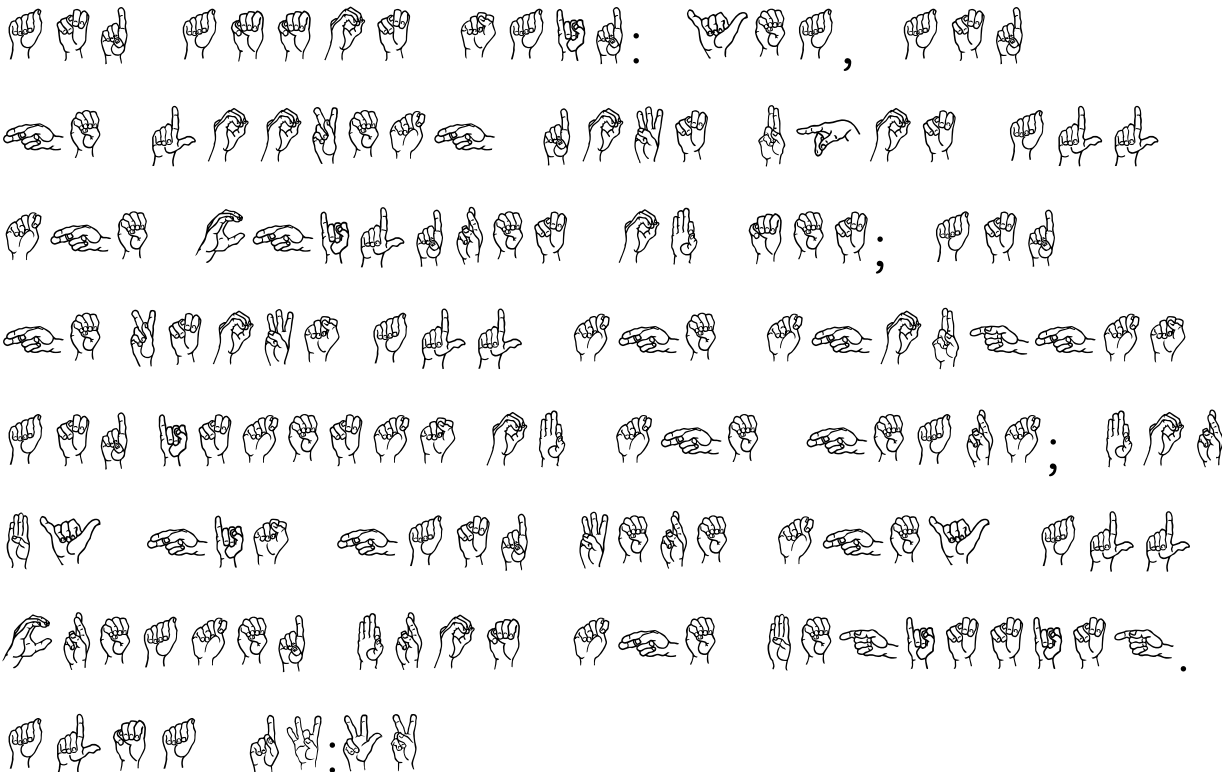

Instructions: Translate the sign language letters below into English to discover the hidden message. Write the alphabet letter beneath each hand sign. Use the key at the back of the book to help you.



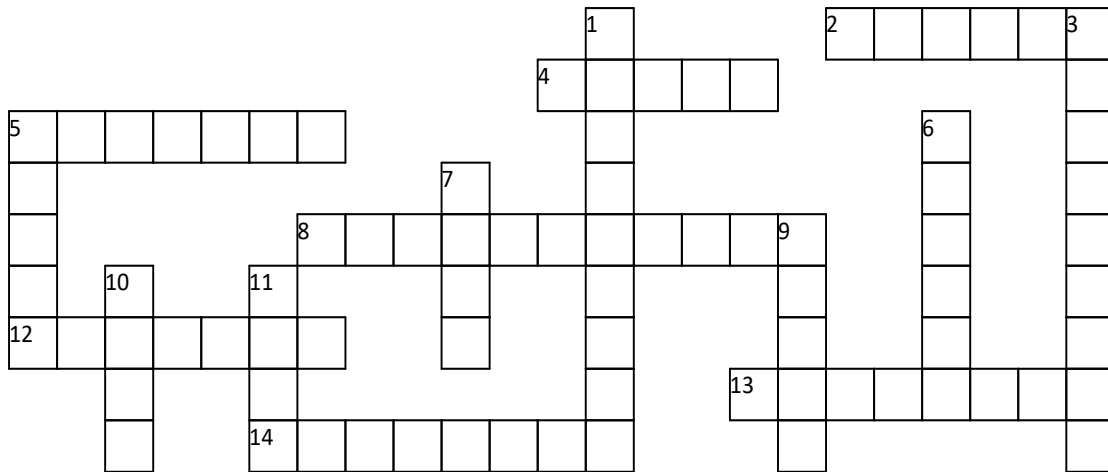

11. To cry or shed tears, especially in sorrow or distress.

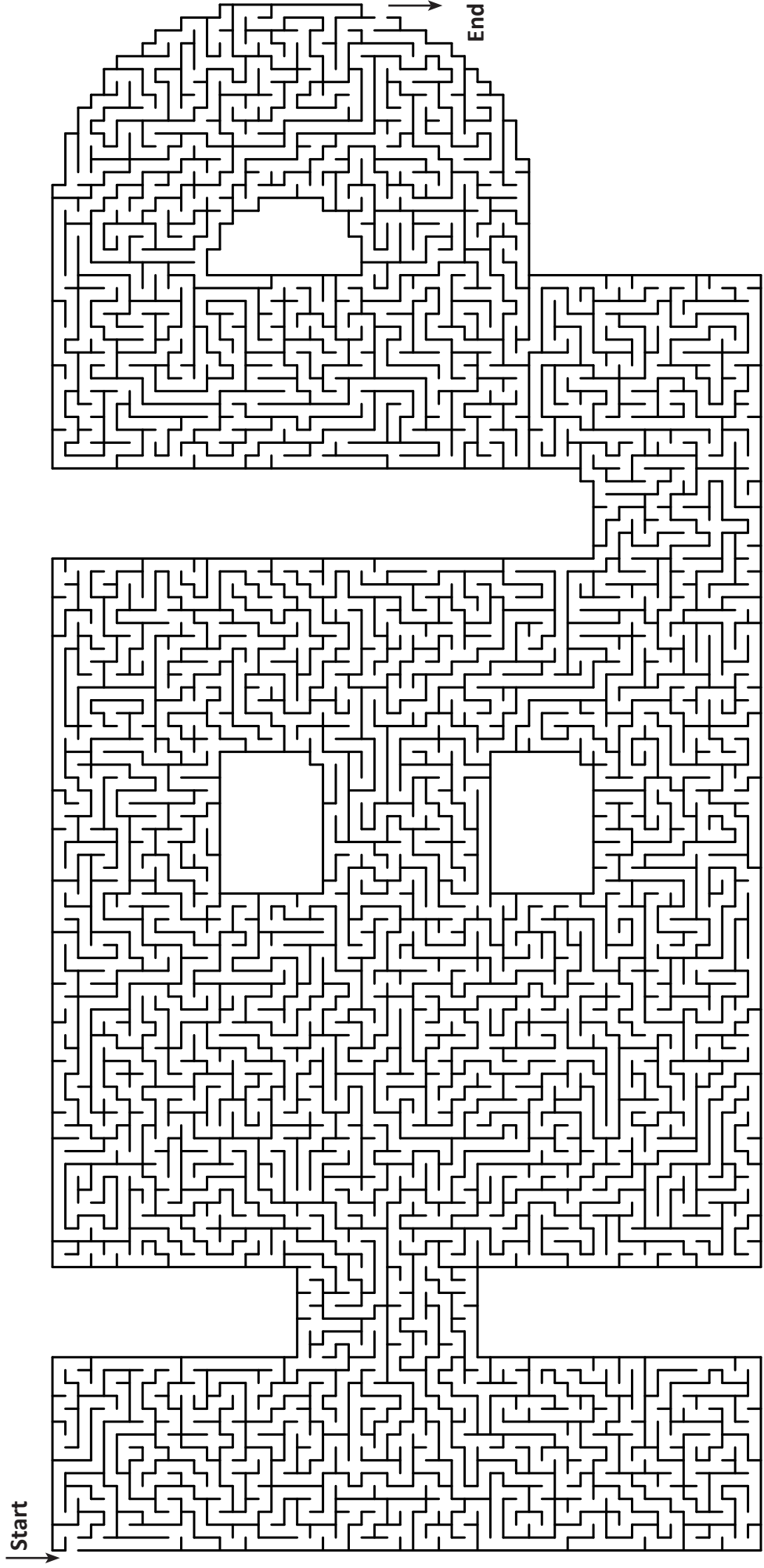

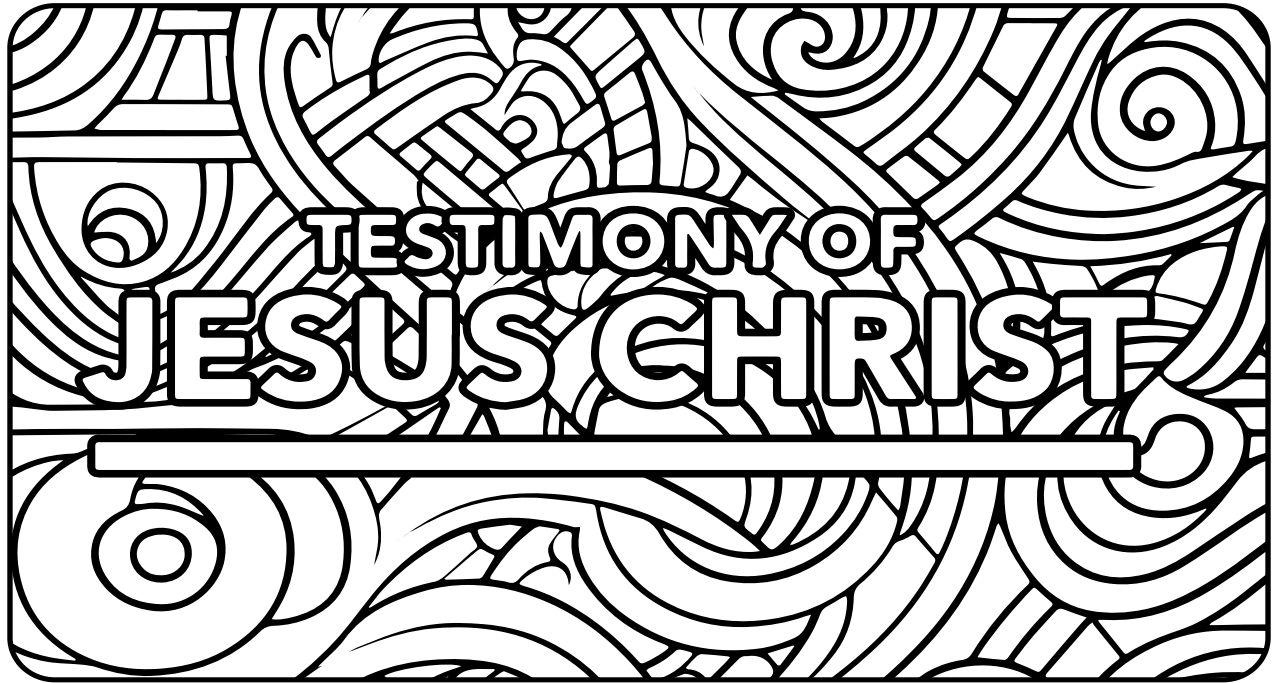
