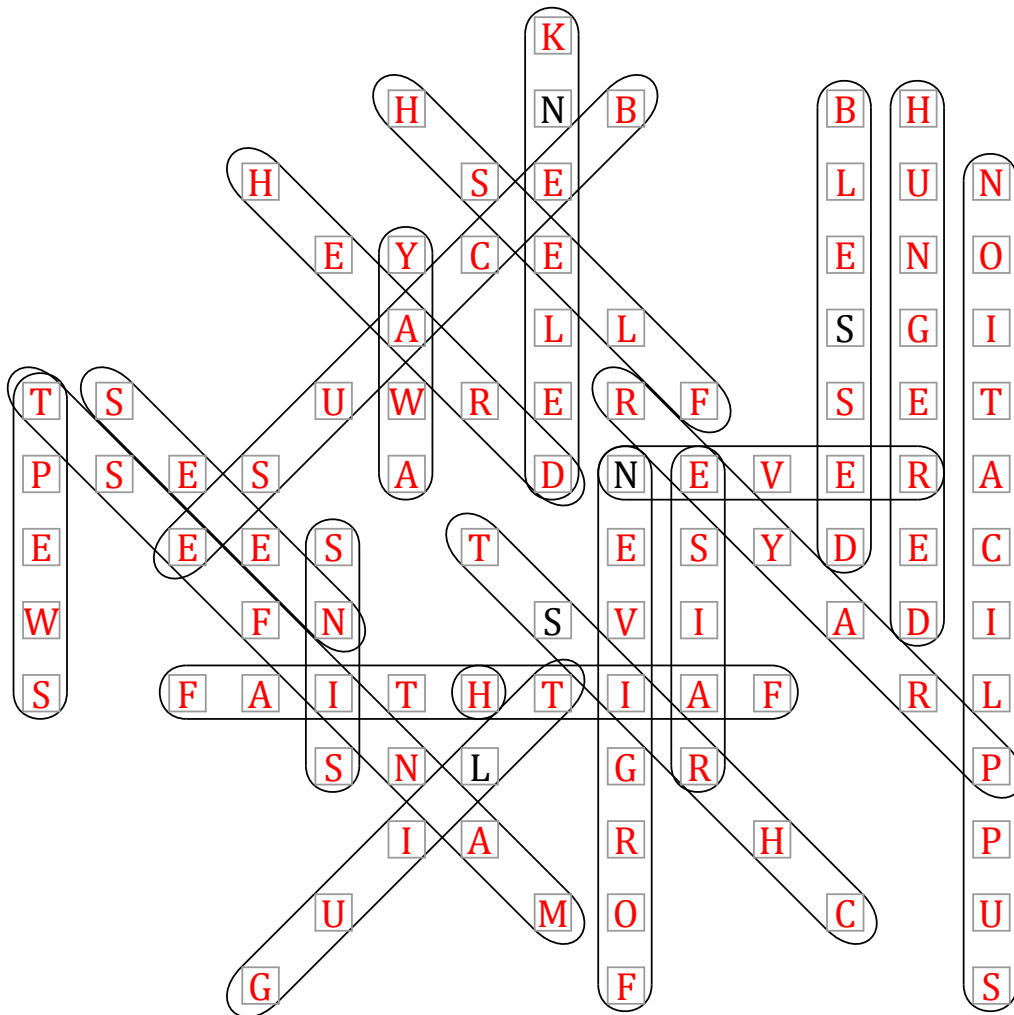
## Easter

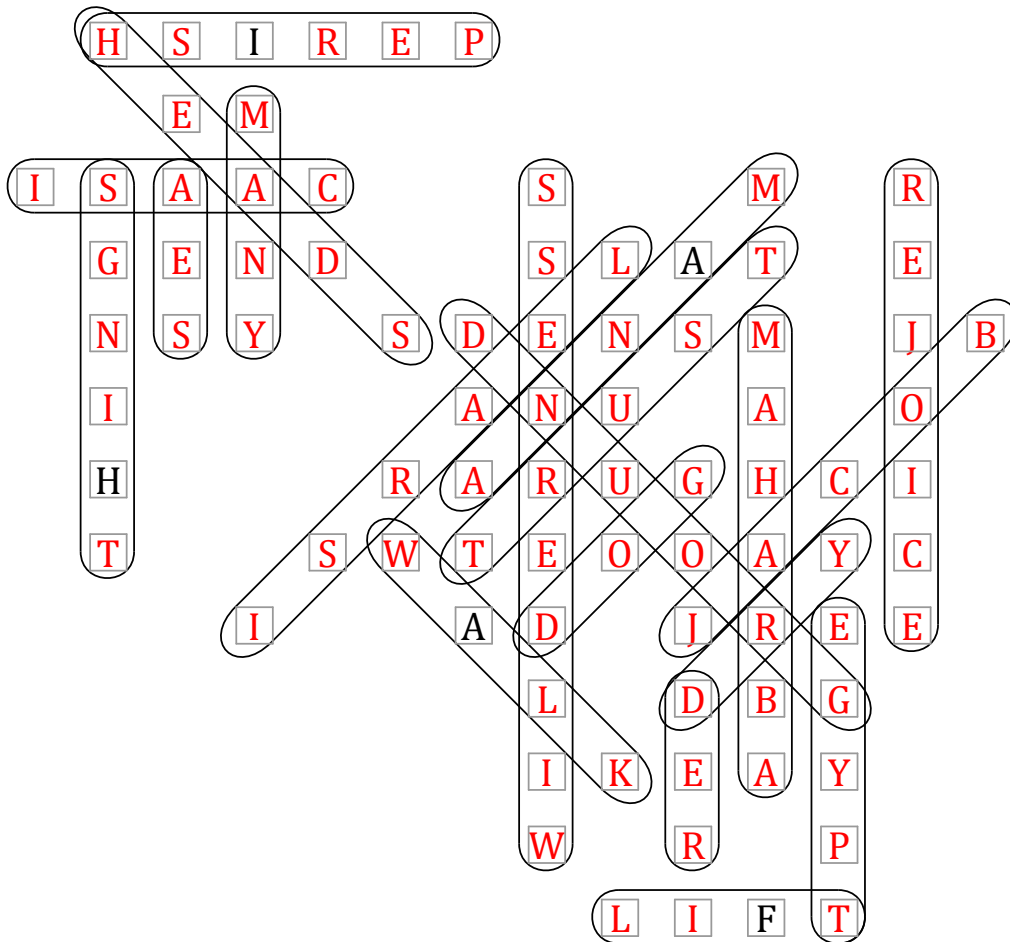
## Mosiah 7–10

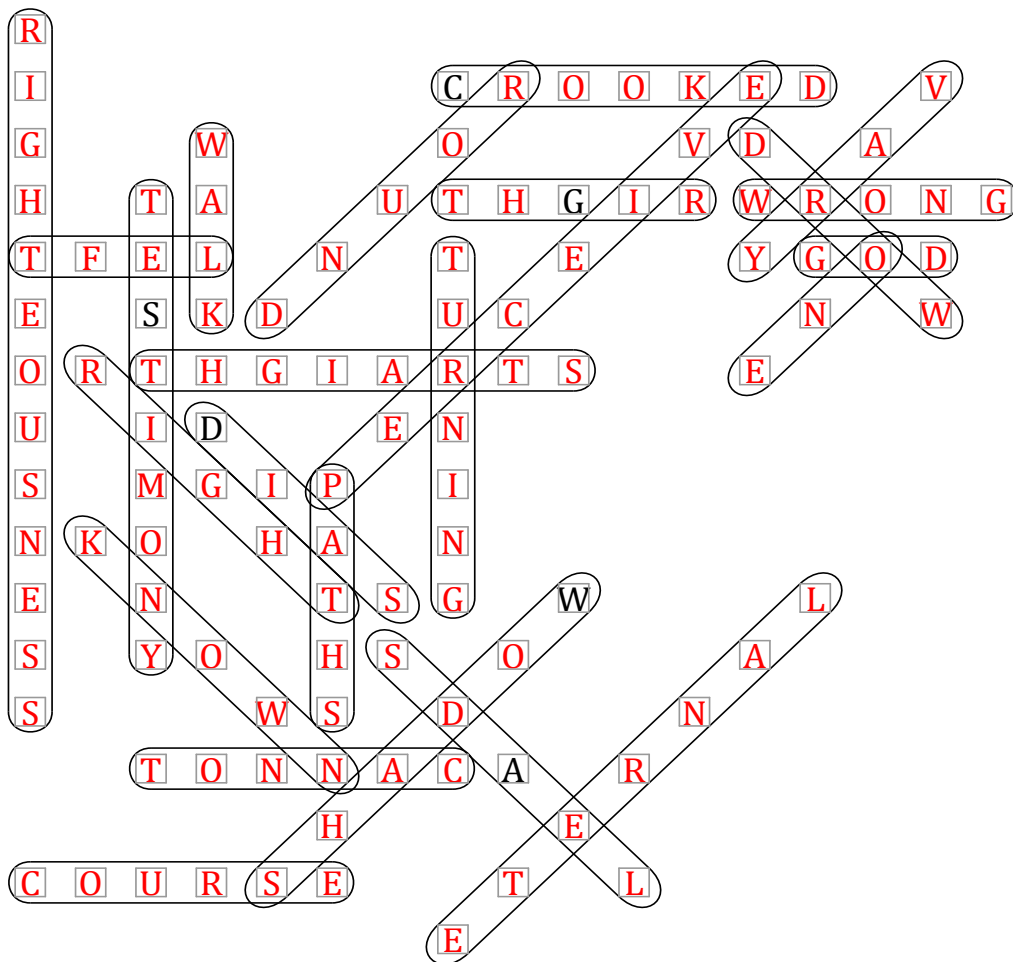
## Alma 5–7

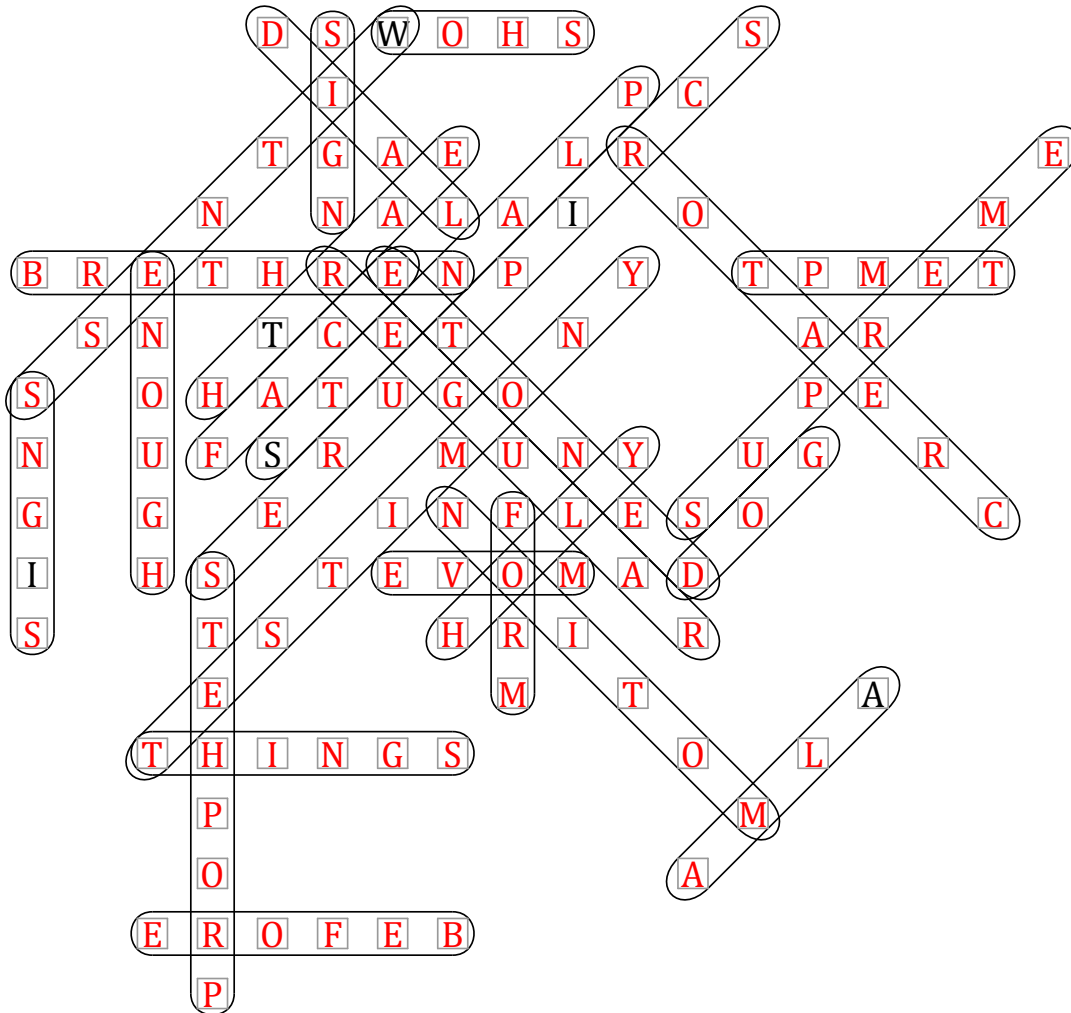
## Alma 30–31
